

Oncore 101: Learning Program

What is it?

The OnCore – Clinical Trial Management System (CTMS) is a system used in research to manage and track study protocols and their subjects. The on-demand OnCore 101: Learning Program provides basic information that will allow study team members to manage their clinical research studies.

Who should complete the OnCore 101 Learning Program?

Research staff involved in human subjects' research that will manage data in OnCore.

What will you learn?

- Understand what type of studies are required in OnCore
- How to update research staff in OnCore
- Understand required PC Console fields
- How and when to update Protocol Statuses and who is responsible
- How to view and download Coverage Analysis
- Introduce concepts of Calendar Statuses
- How to run a Protocol Search

How do I register?

- Rush employees can register on <u>Rush Learning Hub</u>, Rush's Learning Management System (LMS).
- Enter OnCore as the search keyword.
- Complete all three (3) mandatory courses:

 - 2. OnCore 101: "Webinar before taking OnCore 101"
 - 3. OnCore 101
