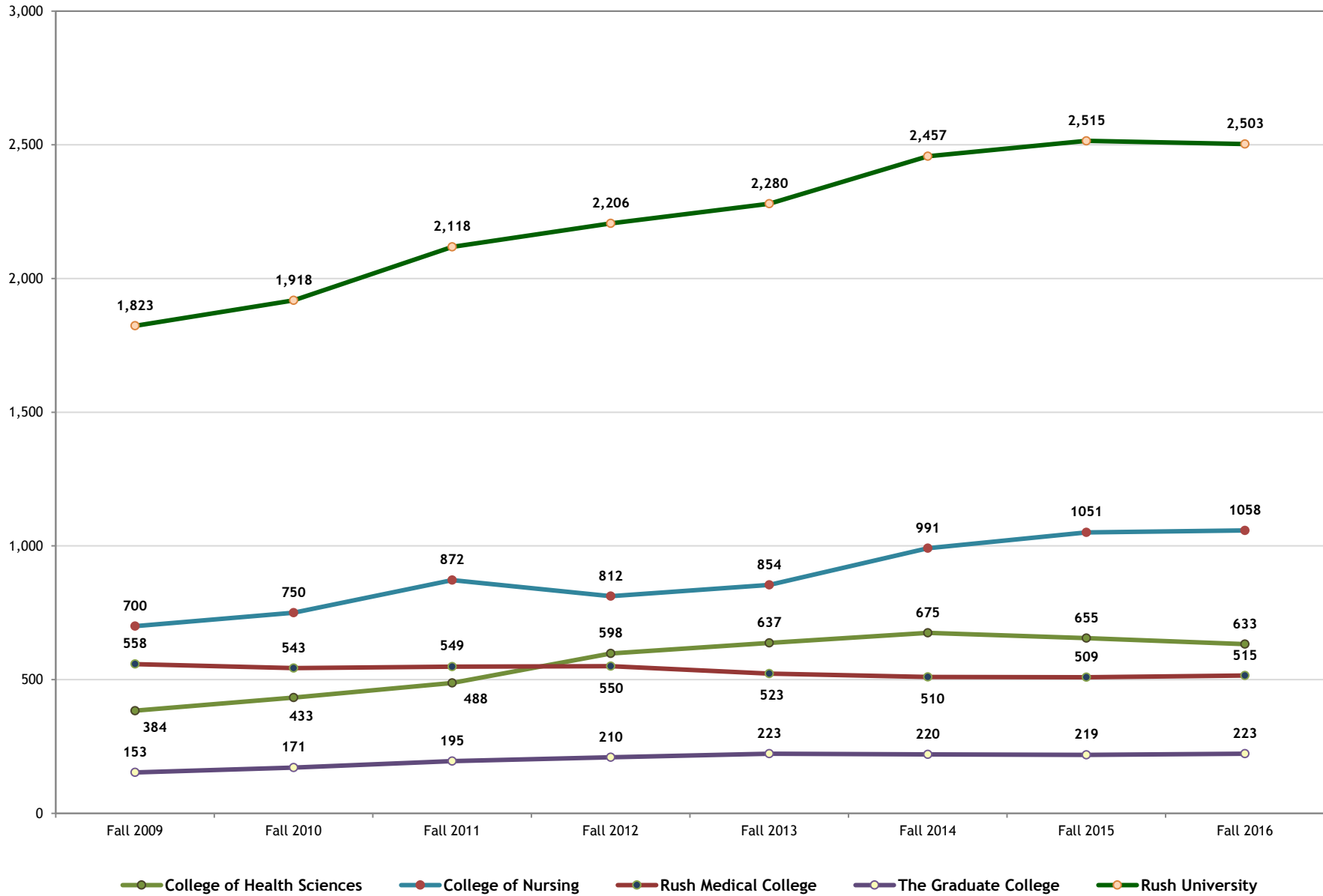

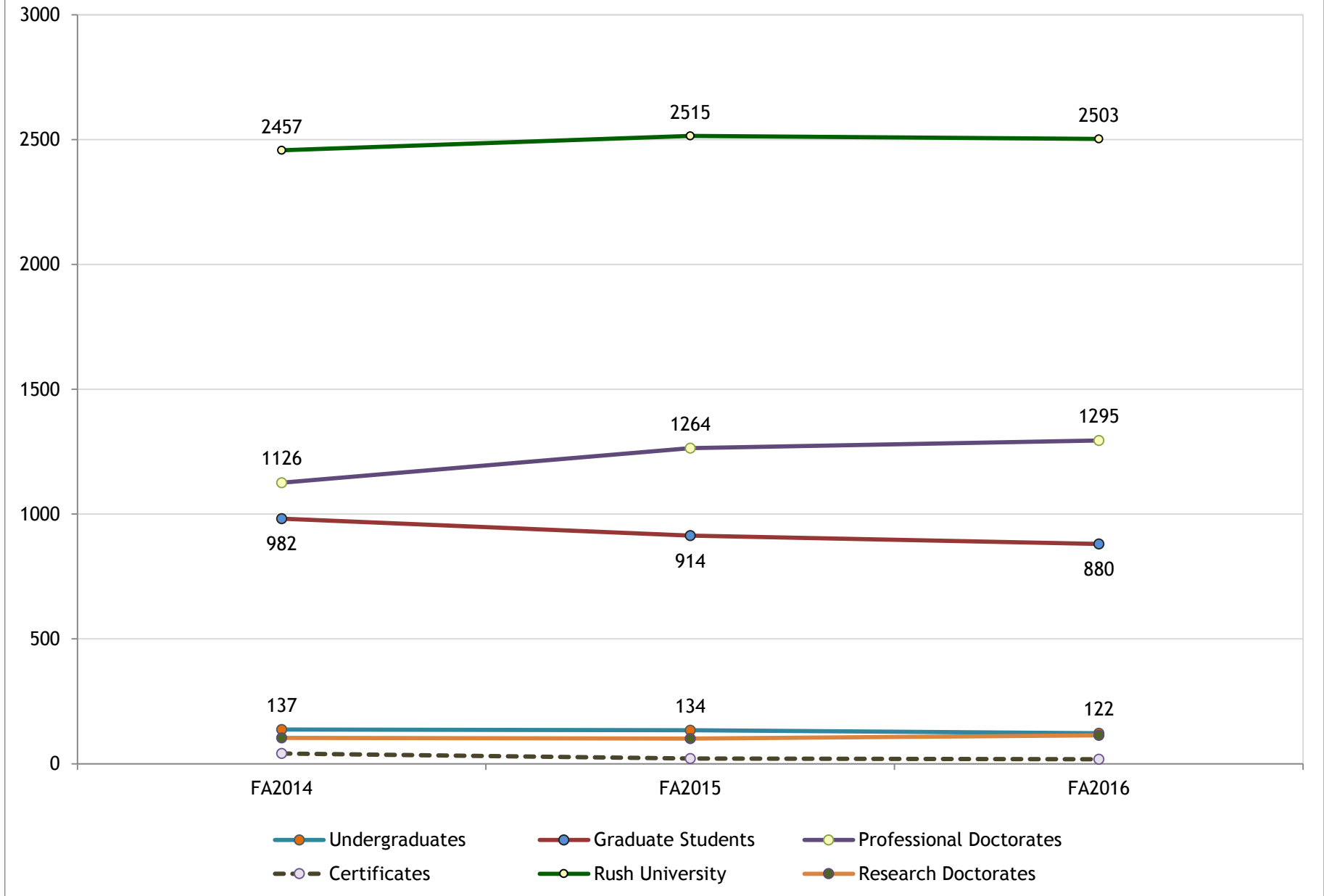

Headcount Enrollment by Degree Level, Fall 2014-Fall 2016



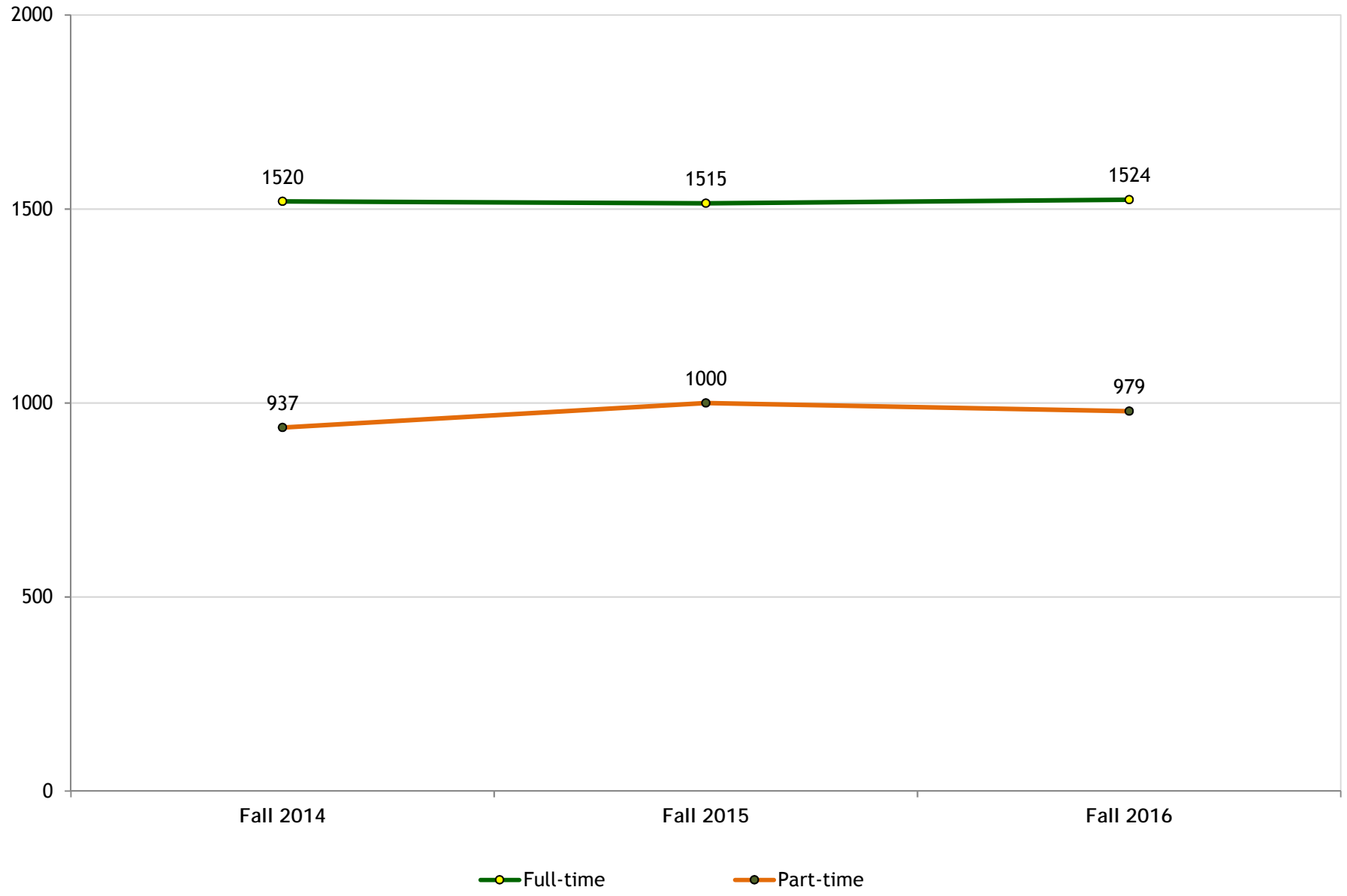

Headcount Enrollment by Full-time/Part-time, Fall 2014-Fall 2016



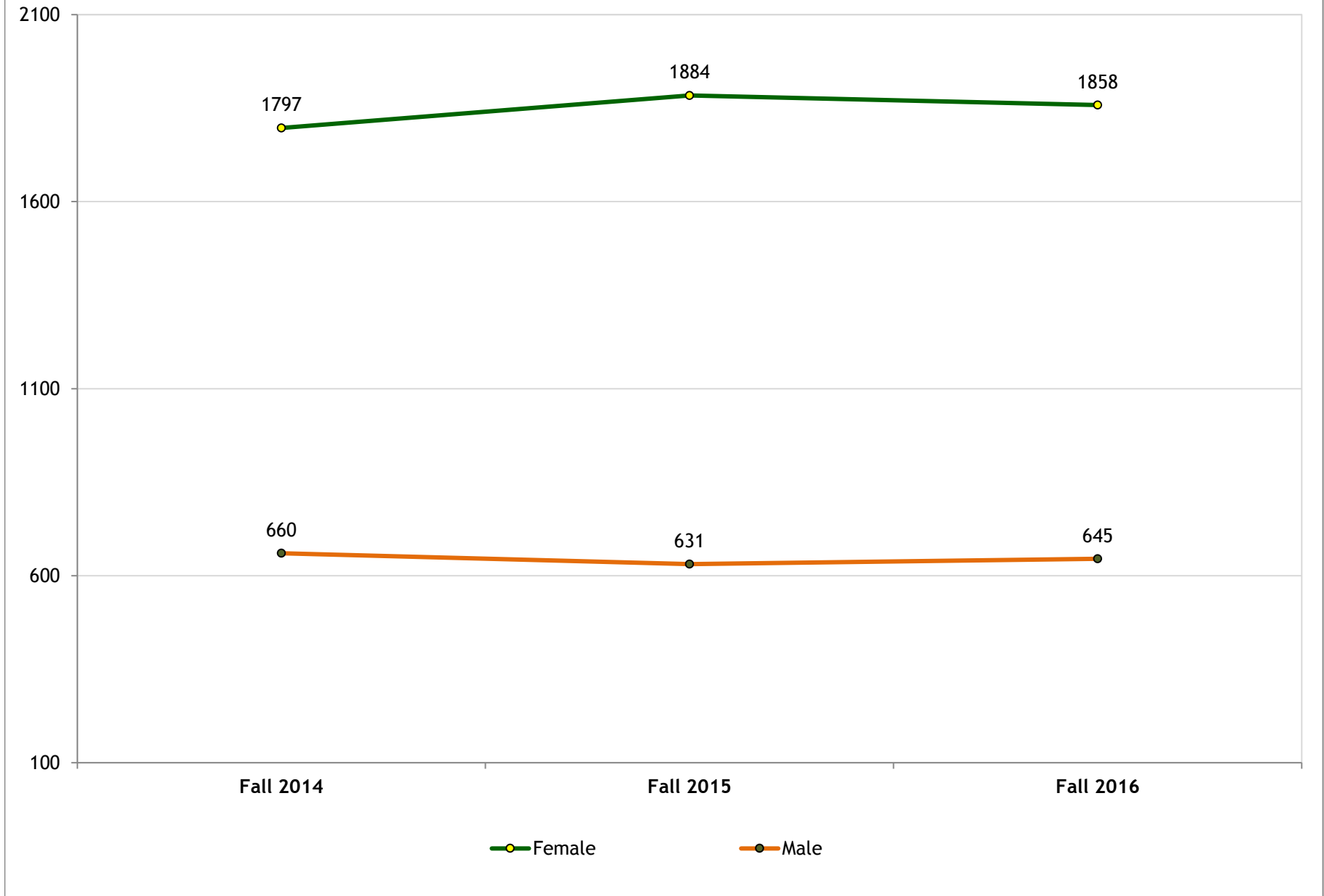

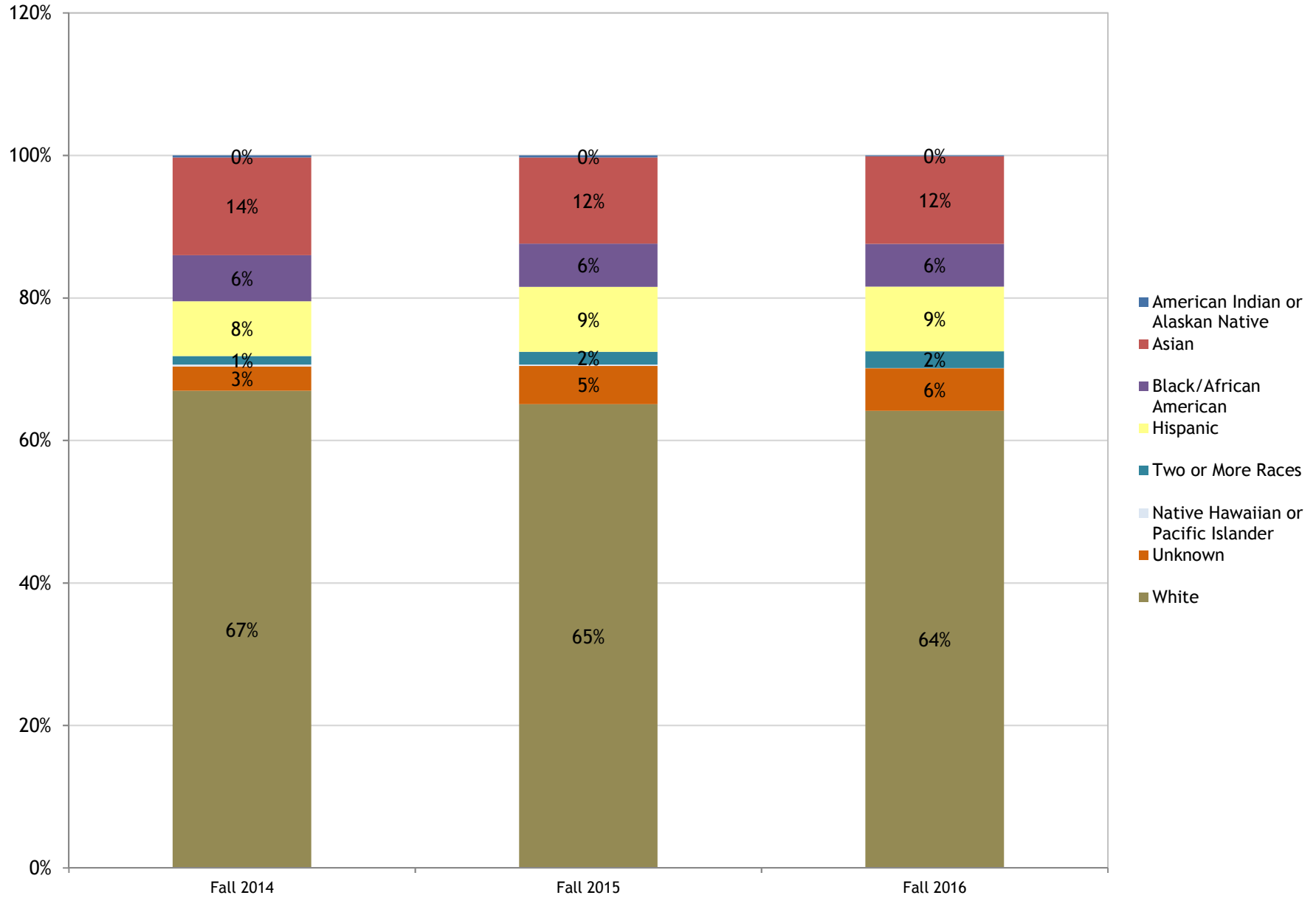

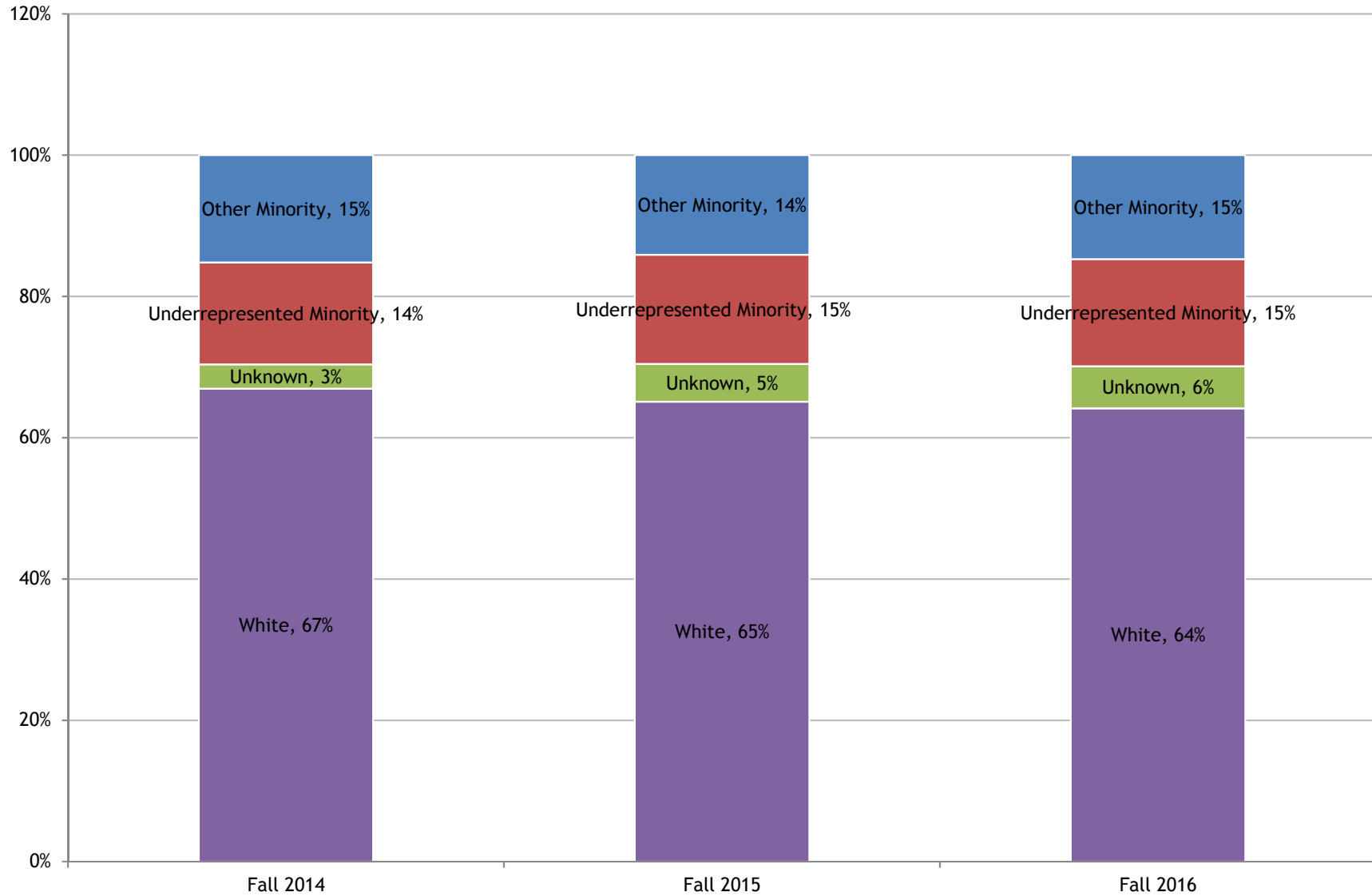

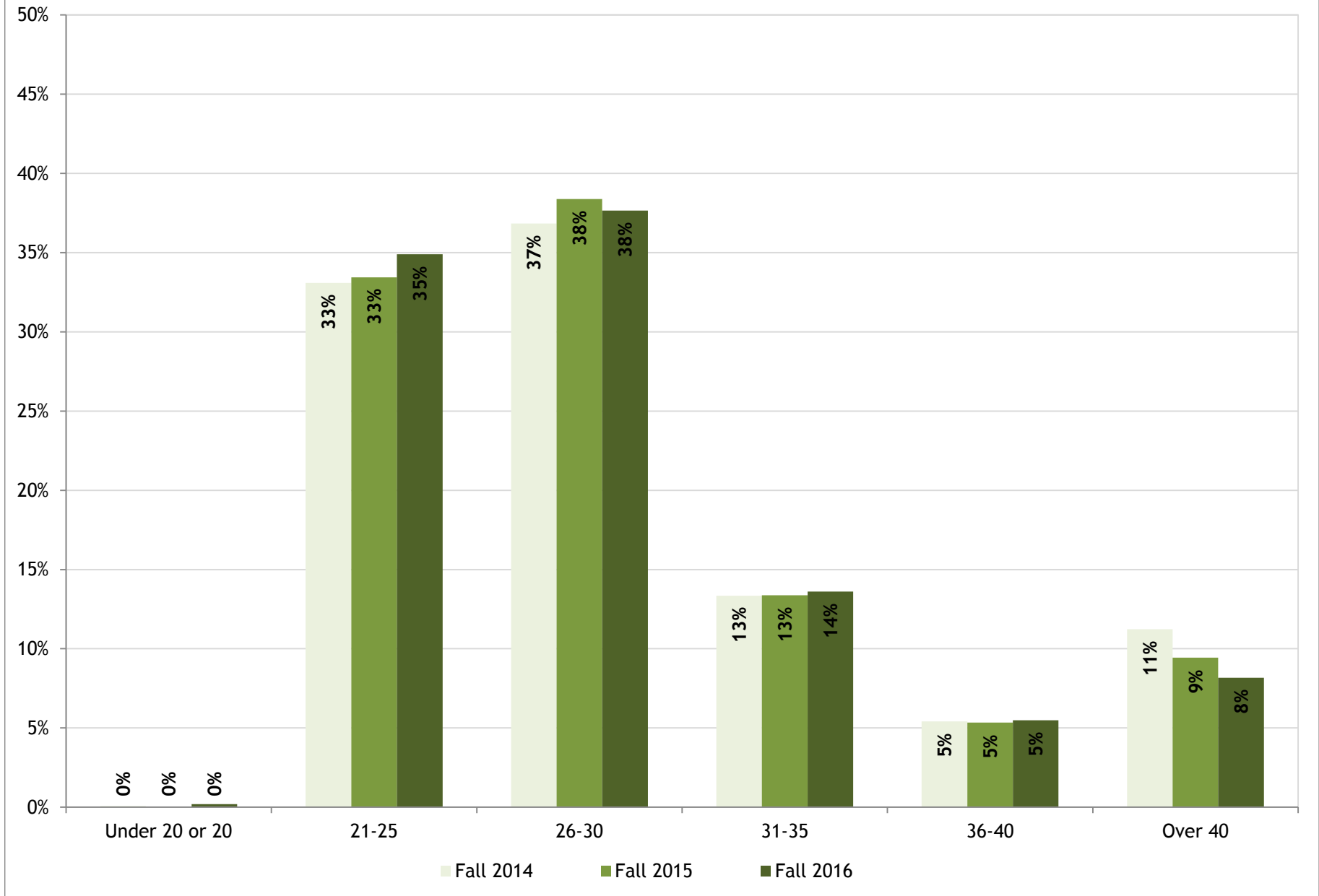

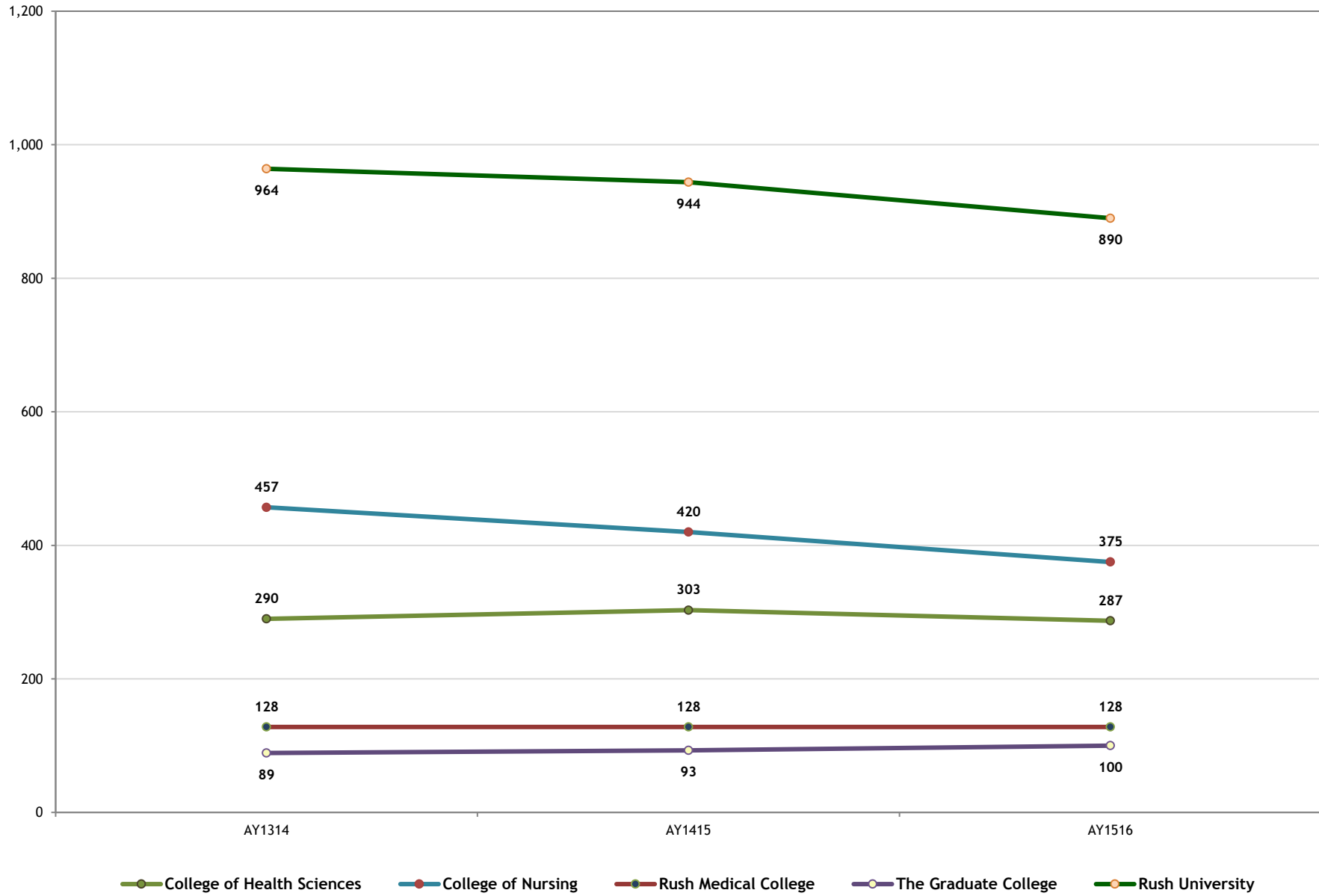

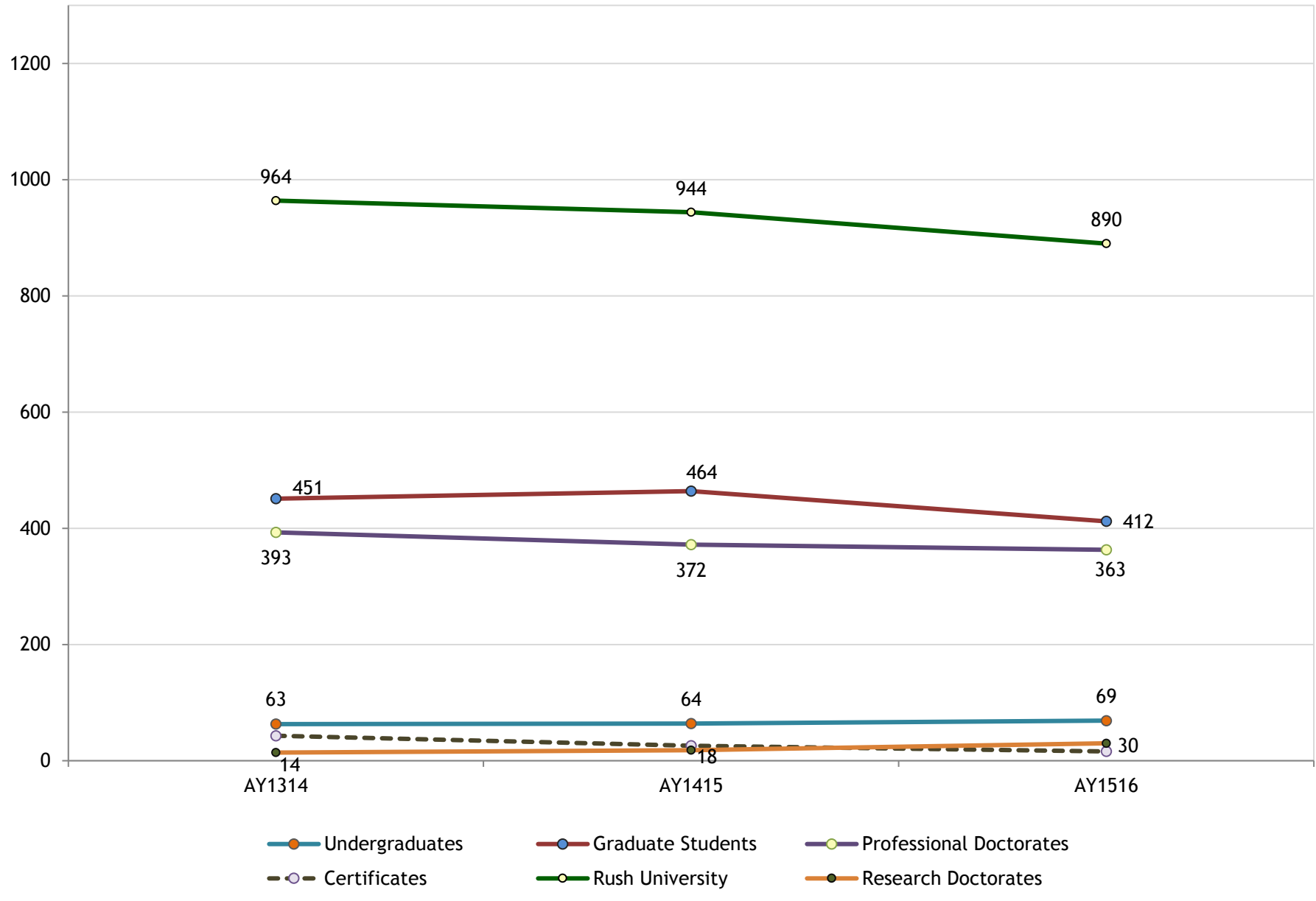

New Students Enrollment by Degree Level, AY 2013-14 to AY 2015-16



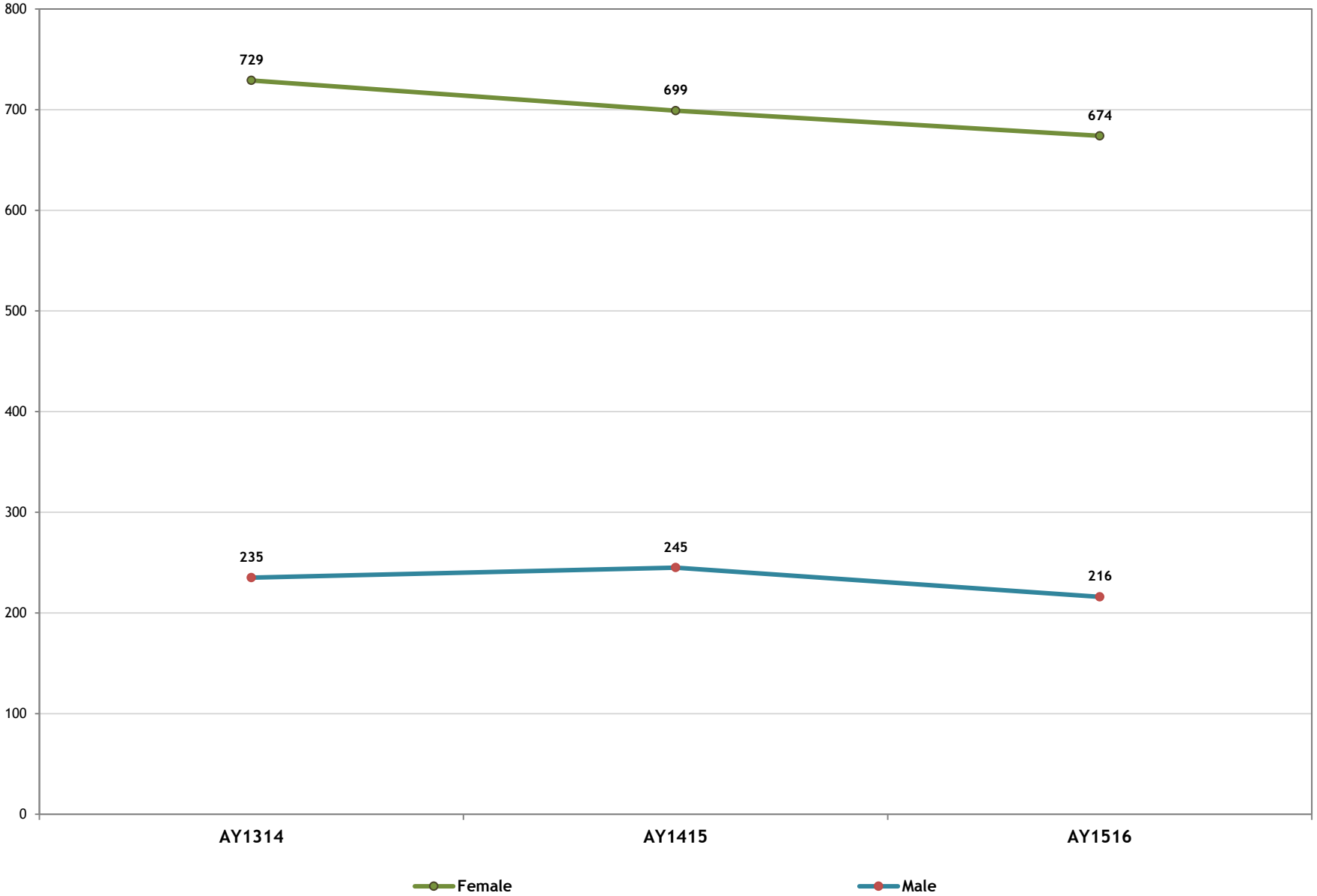

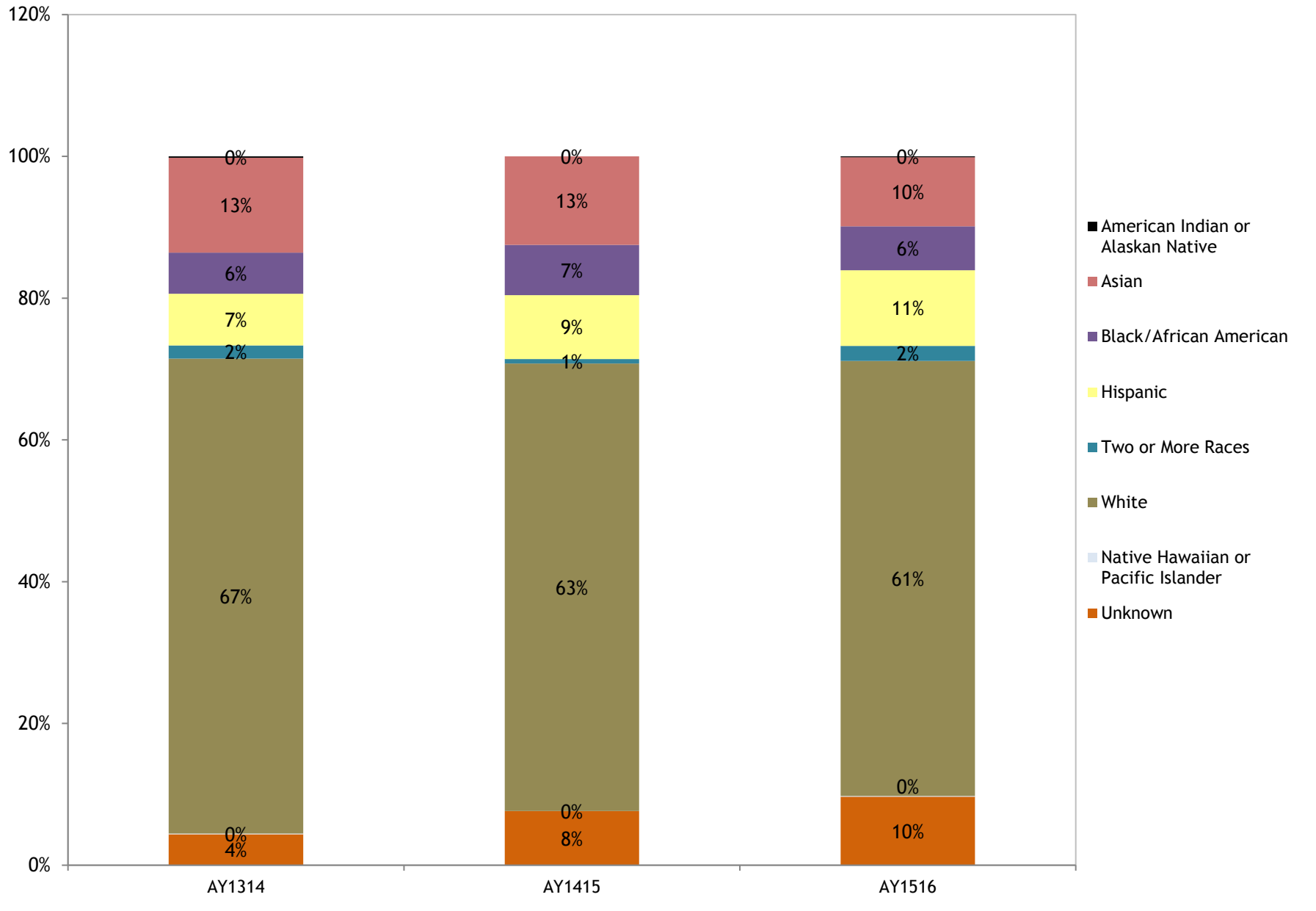

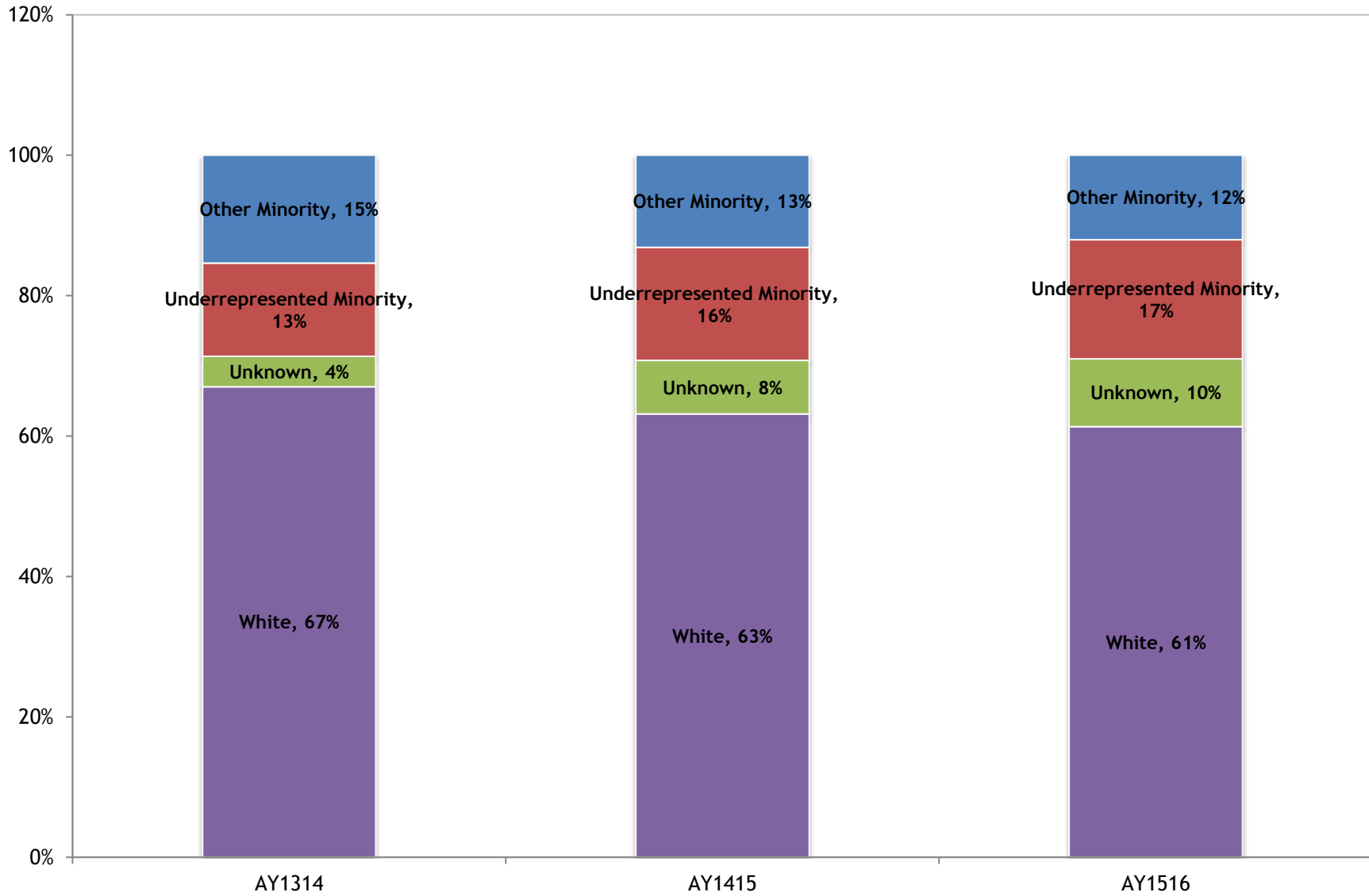

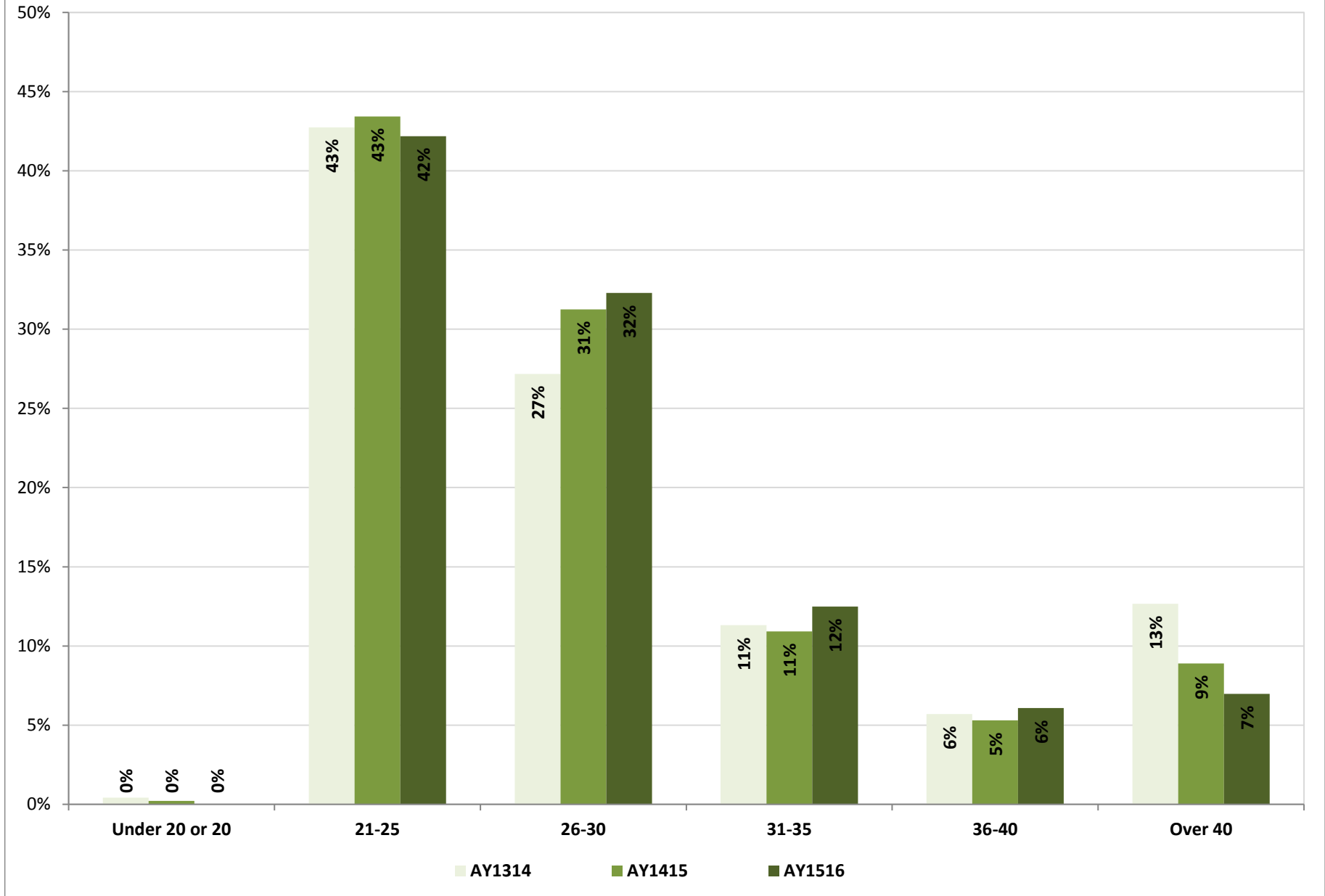

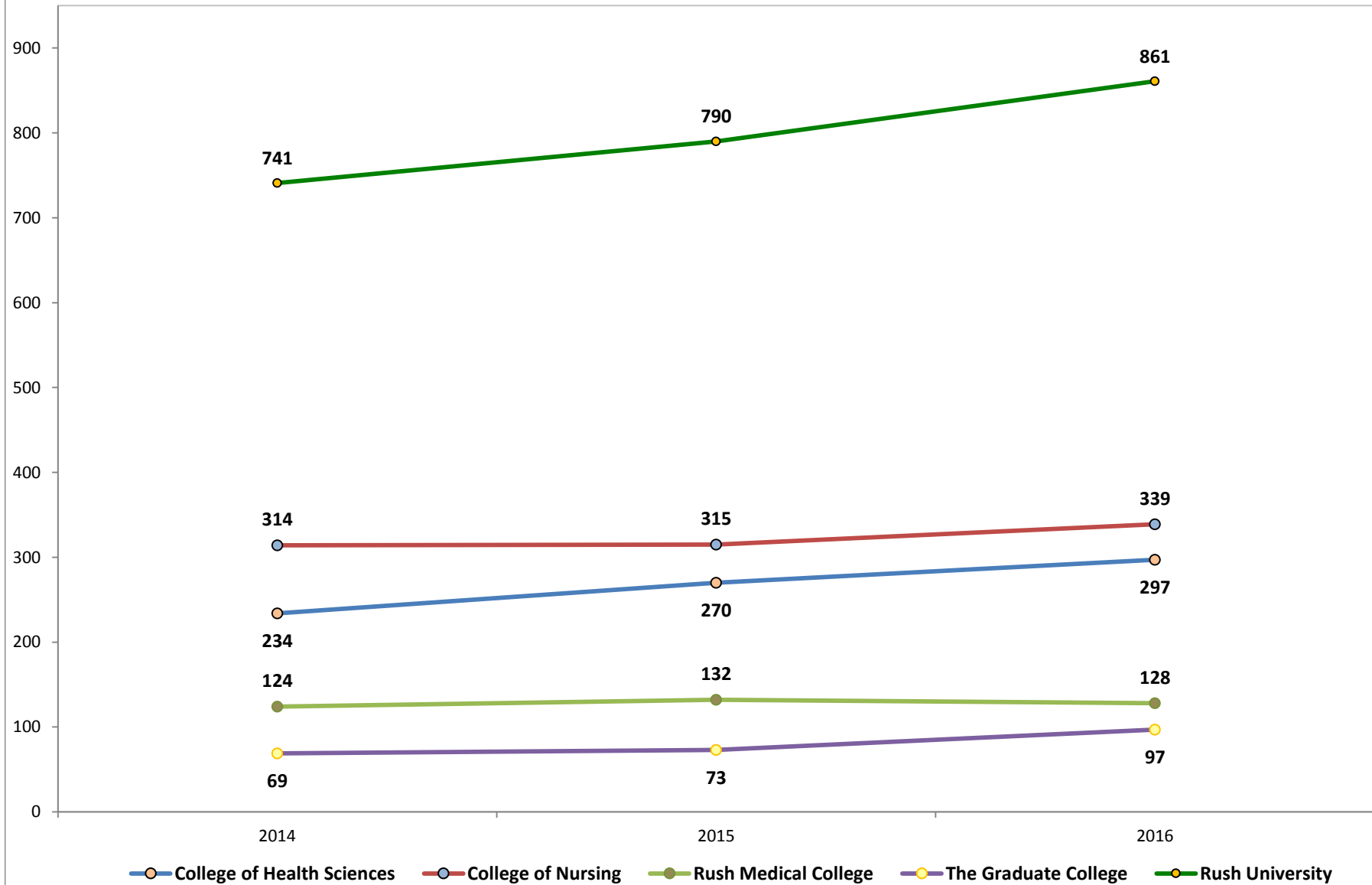
