Enrollment At-A-Glance Report: Fall 2022

Executive Summary

The Enrollment-At-A-Glance Report provides five-year data that include the total student headcount, headcount for newly enrolled students, student demographics, and degrees awarded. The report is updated each term. As indicated in this report, overall enrollment at RUSH continues to grow as seen by the highest student enrollment in Rush history in the past two years.

Enrollment data are obtained from the Student Information System and are based on the official Census Date established by the Registrar. The Census Date is the date on which enrollment counts are frozen for purposes of internal and external reporting. Students not registered in the Student Information System by the Census Date cut-off may not be included in the count for that term. This report also includes the Fall 2022 budgeted vs. actual enrollments obtained from the University Finance Team.

Total Student Headcount by College and Program

- Fall 2022 total headcount **decreased by less than 1%** over Fall 2021, from 2,889 to 2,870.
 - Greatest increases occurred in the Speech Language Pathology, MS (14%, +13 students); • Health Sciences, BS (12%, +6 students); Clinical Laboratory Management, MS (11%, +4 students); and Clinical Nutrition, MS (10%, +5 students) programs.
 - Greatest decreases occurred in the Integrated Biomedical Sciences, MS (-44%, -8 students); Specialist in Blood Bank, Cert (-36%, -5 students); Post-Graduate Nursing, Cert. (-22%, -4 students); Vascular Ultrasound, BS (-21%, -6 students); and Respiratory Care, MS (-12%, -5 students) programs.

Total Student Headcount by Demographics

- male. The average age of the student body is 29 years.
- The proportion of all known minority students has **steadily increased** since 2018.
 - Underrepresented minorities account for approximately **23%** of the total student population.
 - The Fall 2022 enrollment of Black/African American students increased by 3% over Fall 2021, from 245 to 252; Hispanic student enrollments increased by 5% from 378 to 396.
 - Between 2018 and 2022, the proportion of Black/African American students remains steady at approximately 8% of the total student population. The proportion of Hispanic students has increased from **10%** (n=274) in 2018 to **14%** (n=396) in 2022.
 - Approximately **39%** of the student population identify as minority; this includes an increase of 20% in the Asian population from 350 in Fall 2021 to 420 in Fall 2022. This increase is believed to reflect data that were available this year and may not have been available in previous years.

• The College of Nursing accounts for **43%** of the total enrollments, followed by the College of Health Sciences (30%), RUSH Medical College (20%), The Graduate College (5%), and

• Undergraduates comprise 4% of the total student population; MS/MSN programs 33%; professional doctorates 55%; research doctorates 5%; certificates 1%; and non-degree seeking or Students-at-

Enrollment had been on a steady increase since 2018 but has dropped nearly 1% in Fall 2022 when compared to Fall 2021. When compared to 2018, Fall 2022 had the greatest increase in research doctorates (13%, +17 students) followed by graduate programs (11%, +95 students). There were decreases in the non-degree

• Gender distribution and average age have remained steady since 2018, with 77% female on the average and 23%

Degrees Awarded

• The University awarded 939 degrees during the 2021-2022 academic year, an 8% increase over the 2019-2020 academic year. An increase of 15% (from 815 to 939) occurred between Fall 2021 and Fall 2022; this increase is believed to be a result of the COVID pandemic.


Budgeted vs. Actual Fall 2022 Enrollments

- The Graduate College exceeded their projected enrollments by 11%, +16 students. The College of Health Sciences, College of Nursing, and RUSH Medical college all came within **1% to 2%** of meeting their targets.
- Overall, the University was less than 1% from meeting its budgeted enrollments.


