




Table 5: Admissions Data by College and by Minority 5.1. College of Health Science: AY1516 to AY1920



New Students Enrollment by College and by Program, AY 2017-18 to AY 2019-20








- Federal student loans provide the majority of student financial support at Rush.

- The majority of Rush students participate in extensive exit counseling session prior to graduation that provides detailed information about student debt and future repayment options.







