Enrollment At-A-Glance Report: Fall 2021 **Executive Summary**

The Enrollment-At-A-Glance Report provides five-year data that include the total student headcount, headcount for newly enrolled students, student demographics, and degrees awarded. The report is updated each term. Enrollment data are obtained from the Student Information System and are based on the official Census Date established by the Registrar. The Census Date is the date on which enrollment counts are frozen for purposes of internal and external reporting. Students not registered in the Student Information System by the Census Date cut-off may not be included in the count for that term. This report also includes the fall 2021 budgeted vs. actual enrollments obtained from the University Finance Team.

Total Student Headcount by College and Program:

- Fall 2021 total headcount increased by 3% over fall 2020, from 2816 to 2889.
 - Nutrition, MS (23%) programs.
 - MS (-16%) programs.
 - Seeking (1%).
 - Large 1%.
- Greatest increases were in the research doctorate (26%) and professional doctorate (17%) programs.

Budgeted vs. Actual fall 2021 Enrollments

- The Colleges of Health Sciences, Nursing, and Graduate College exceeded their projected enrollments.
- Overall, the University exceeded its budged enrollments by 67 students.

Greatest increases occurred in the Health System Management, MS (51%); Vascular Ultrasound, BS (47%); Health Sciences, BS (32%); Speech Language Pathology, MS (23%); and, Clinical

• Greatest decreases occurred in the Imaging Sciences, BS (-17%) and Clinical Research,

• The College of Nursing enrollments comprise 44% of the total enrollments, followed by the College of Health Sciences (29%), Rush Medical College (20%), The Graduate College (6%), and Non-Degree

• Undergraduates comprise 4% of the total student population; MS/MSN programs 33%; professional doctorates 56%; research doctorates 5%; certificates 1%; and non-degree seeking or Students-at-

Since 2017, the overall total student headcount increased by 12%, with a 3% year over year average increase.

• Gender distribution and average age have remained fairly stable since 2017, with 75% female on the average

The proportion of all known minority students remains fairly constant at approximately 32% of an average.

Underrepresented minority students comprise approximately 22% of the fall 2021 student population.

• The fall 2021 enrollment of Black/African American students increased by 2% over fall 2020, from 240 to 245; Hispanic student enrollments increased by 9% from 347 to 378.

Between 2017 and 2021, the proportion of Black/African American students remains fairly stable at approximately 7% of the total student population. The proportion of Hispanic students has




