




#### **4.1** Ethnicity Chart, Fall 2018

#### 4.2 Enrollment by Program Modality, Fall 2018




9.2 Faculty Median Age by Rank Type





10.4 Default Rate, Comparison with State and National Rate: Cohort Year 2014

- Federal student loans provide the majority of student financial support at Rush.
- Rush students have access to a variety of additional funding sources including institutional scholarships and employees can participate in the institutional tuition waiver program.
- The majority of Rush students participate in extensive exit counseling session prior to graduation that provides detailed information about student debt and future repayment options.

A cohort default rate is the percentage of a school's borrowers who enter repayment on certain Federal Family
Education Loan (FFEL) Program or William D. Ford Federal Direct Loan (Direct Loan) Program loans during a particular
federal fiscal year (FY), October 1 to September 30, and default or meet other specified conditions prior to the end of
the second following fiscal year.







#### 13.1 Total Number of Grant Applications\* Submitted





#### 13.4 Patent Applications Filed and Issued




