

### 3.1 Rush University Enrollment, Fall 2013-Fall 2017

On the average, annual enrollment increased by 3 percent with an overall increase of 13 percent since fall 2013.



### Of the 2569 students enrolled in fall 2017,

- 833 were new students.
- 44 percent were enrolled in College of Nursing.
- 54 percent were enrolled in professional doctorate programs.
- 62 percent were full-time.







### 4.1 Ethnicity Chart, Fall 2017




### 4.2 Enrollment by Program Modality, Fall 2017



### **5.2** Degrees Awarded by College, AY1314-AY1718





### **6.1** Graduation Rates: AY1011 - AY1718








### 6.2 Year-to-Year Retention Rate: Fall 2011 - Fall 2016















### 8.4 College of Nursing Programs, Employment Rates

- 57% of the Rush faculty are female.







### **10.3 Loans Borrowed: 2017-2018**


- Federal student loans provide the majority of student financial support at Rush.



### 10.5 Rush University Cohort Default Rate for Most Recent 3 Years


















