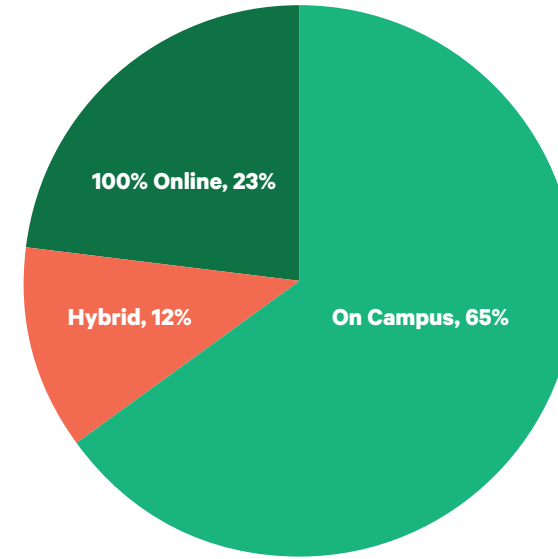

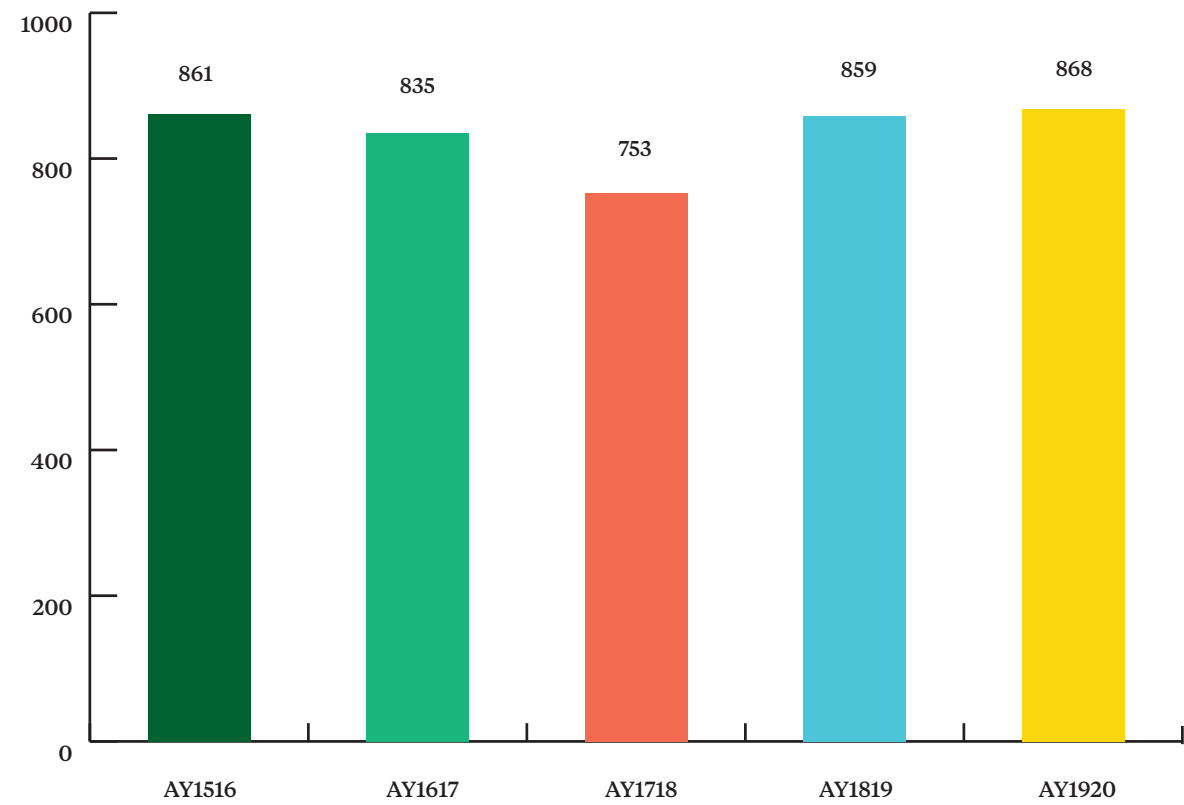

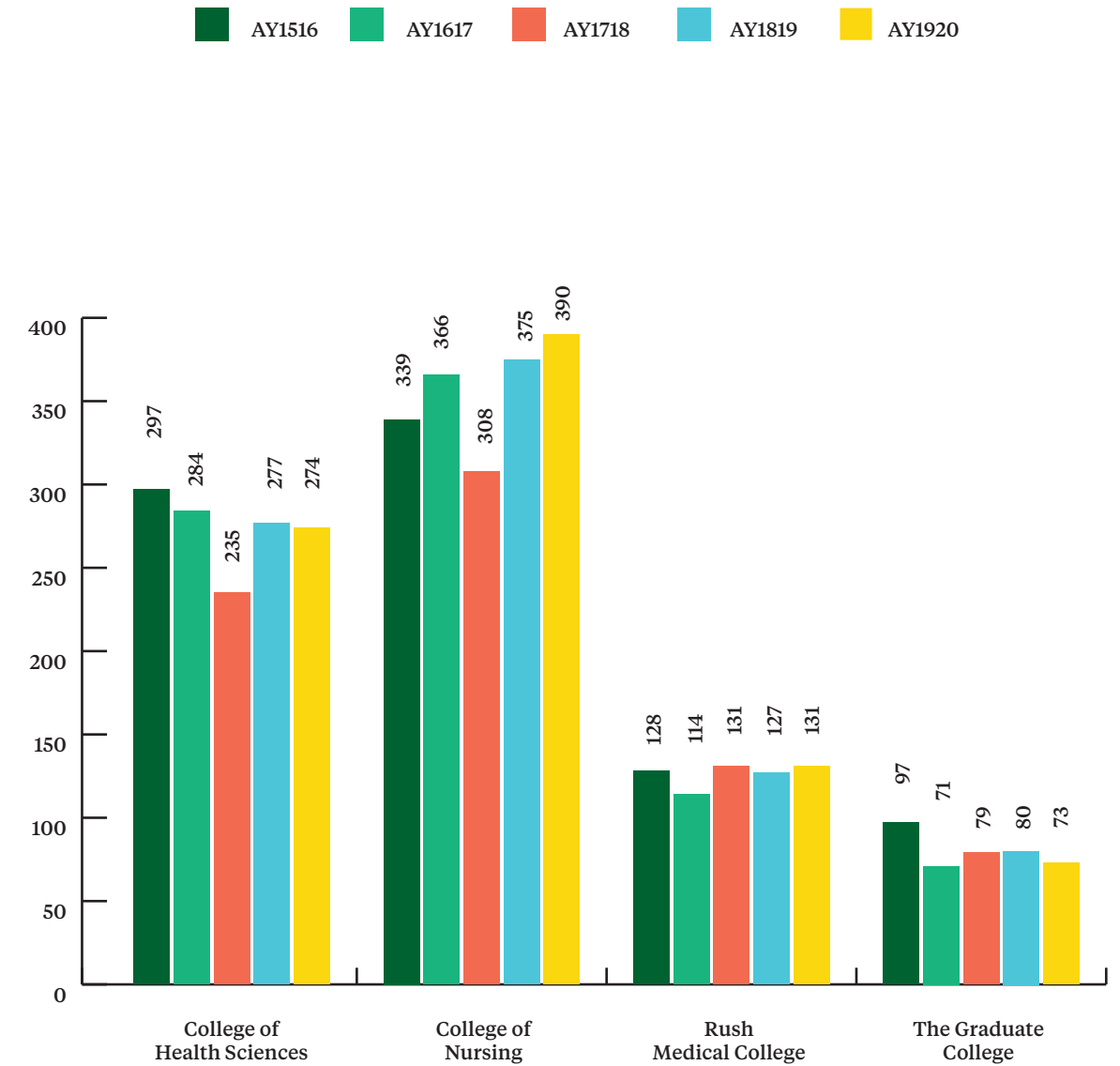

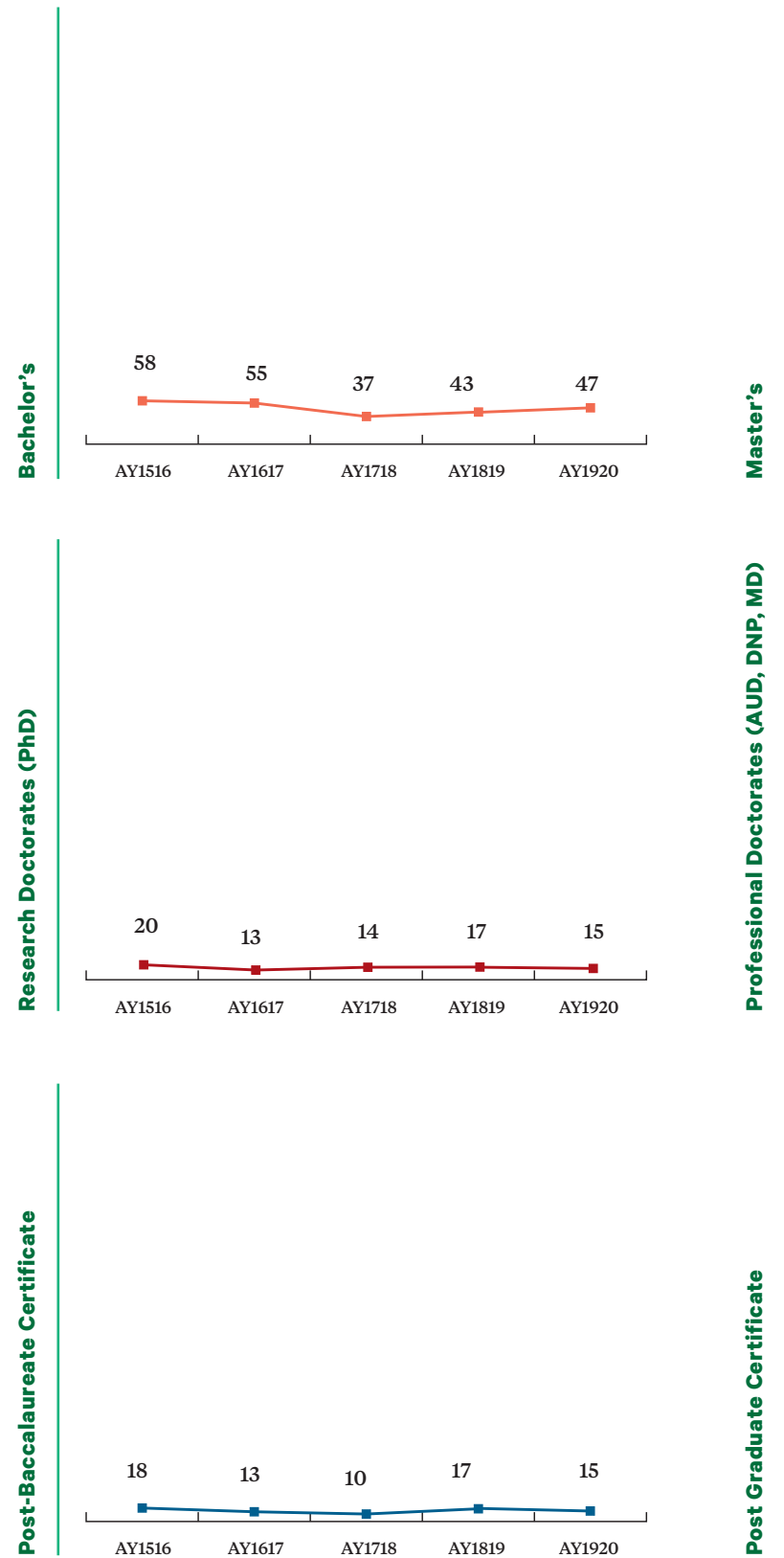

6.1 Graduation Rates: AY1112- AY1920

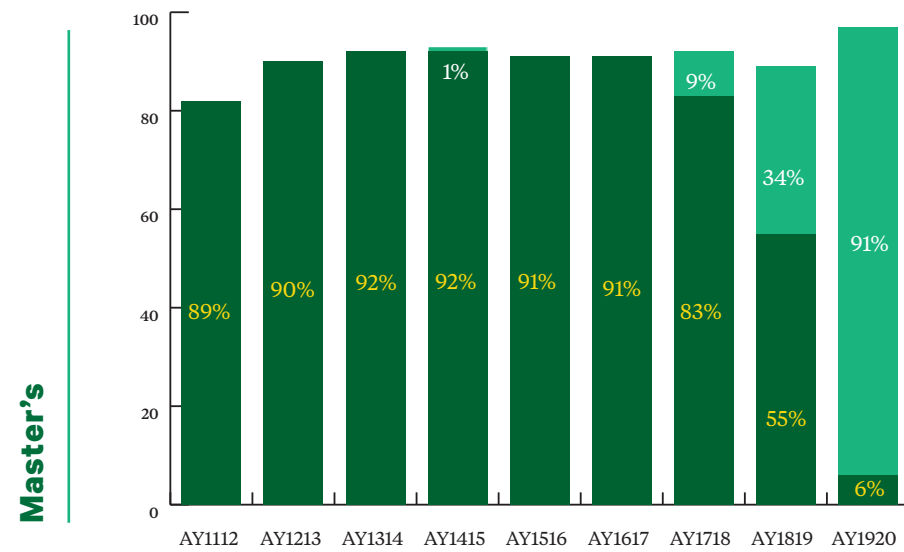

6.2 Academic Year Entry Cohort to Next Fall Retention Rate: AY1516 to AY1920

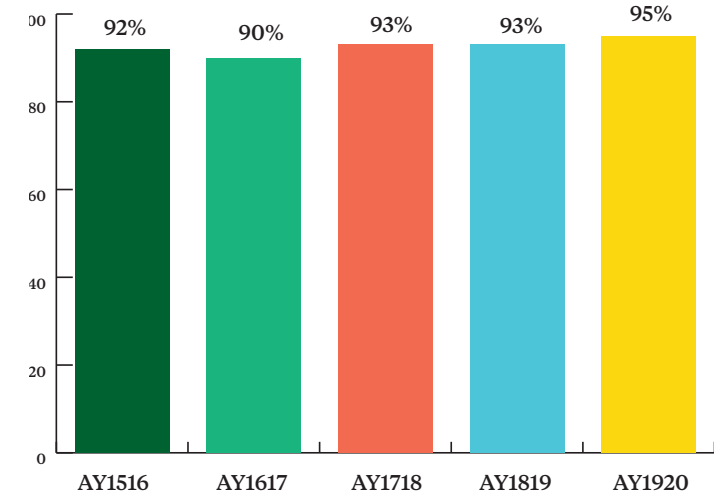

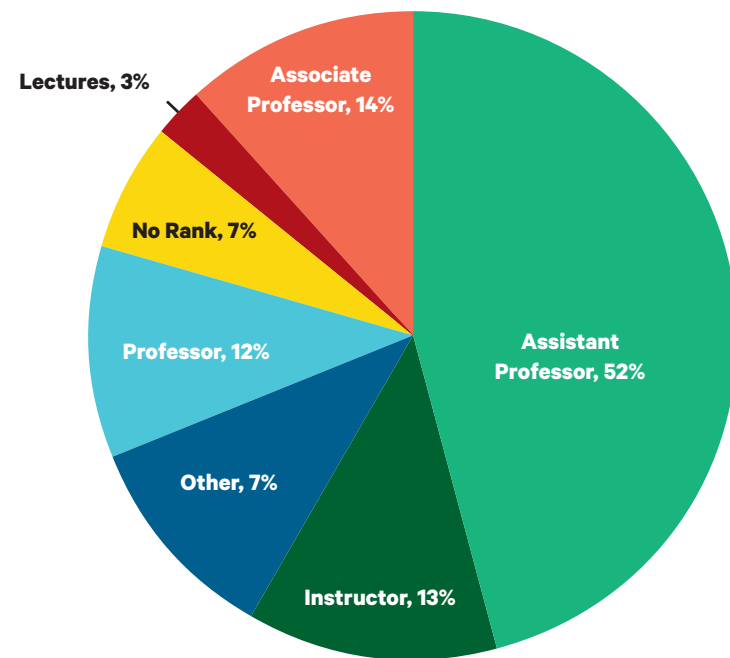

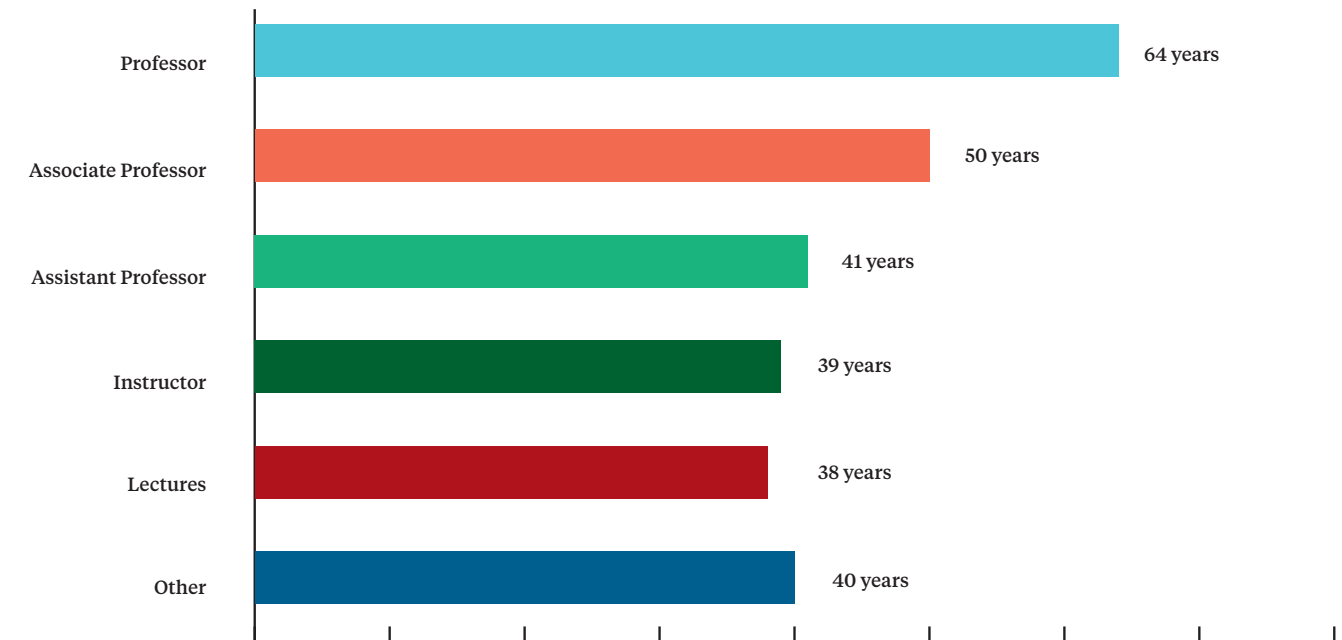

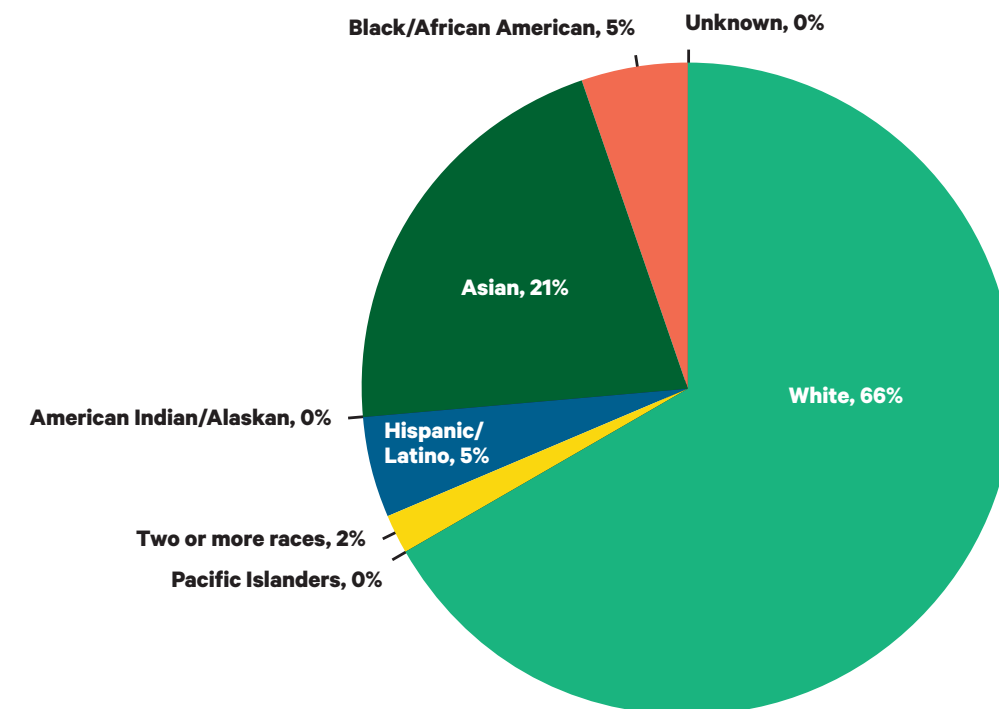

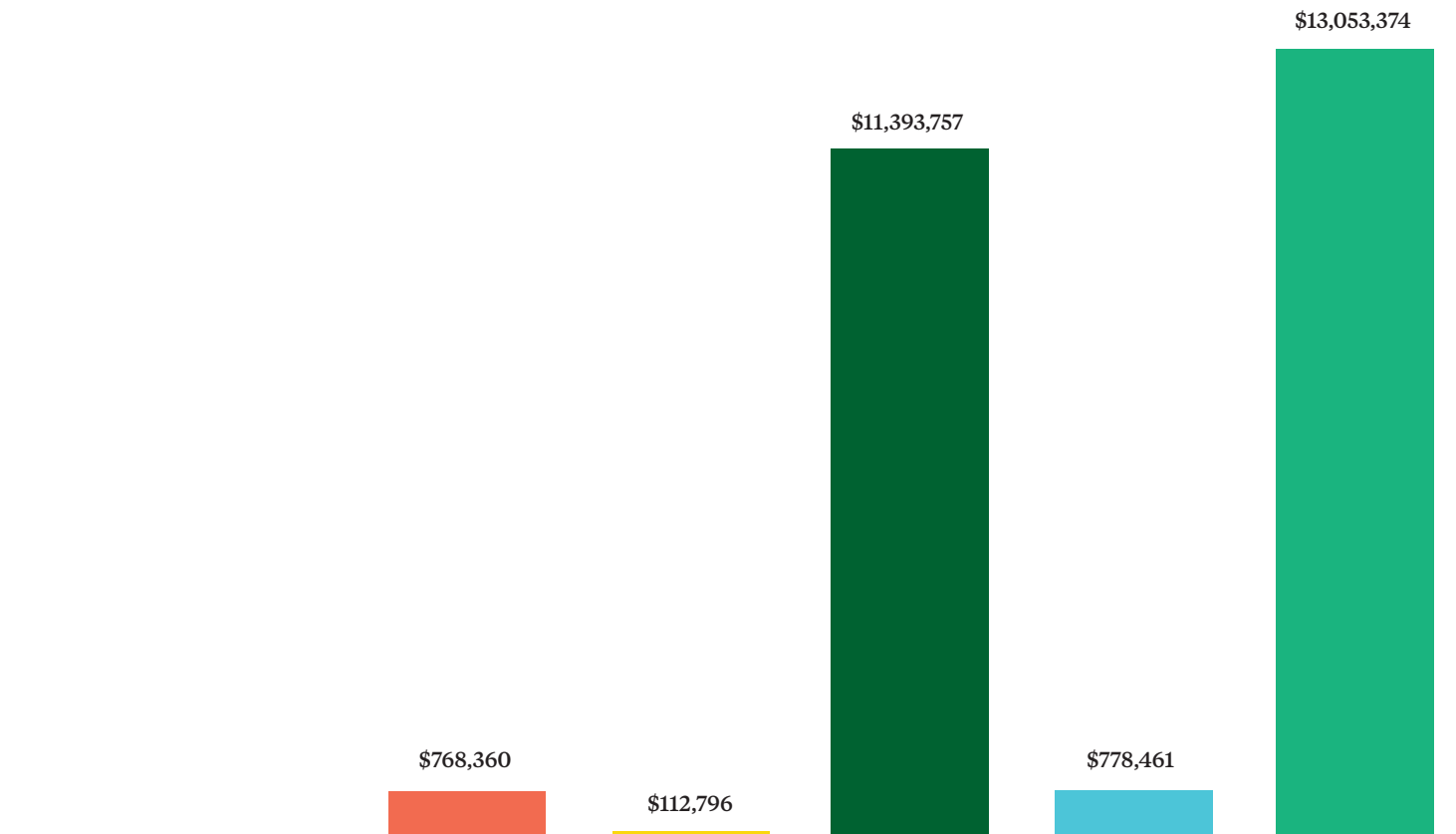

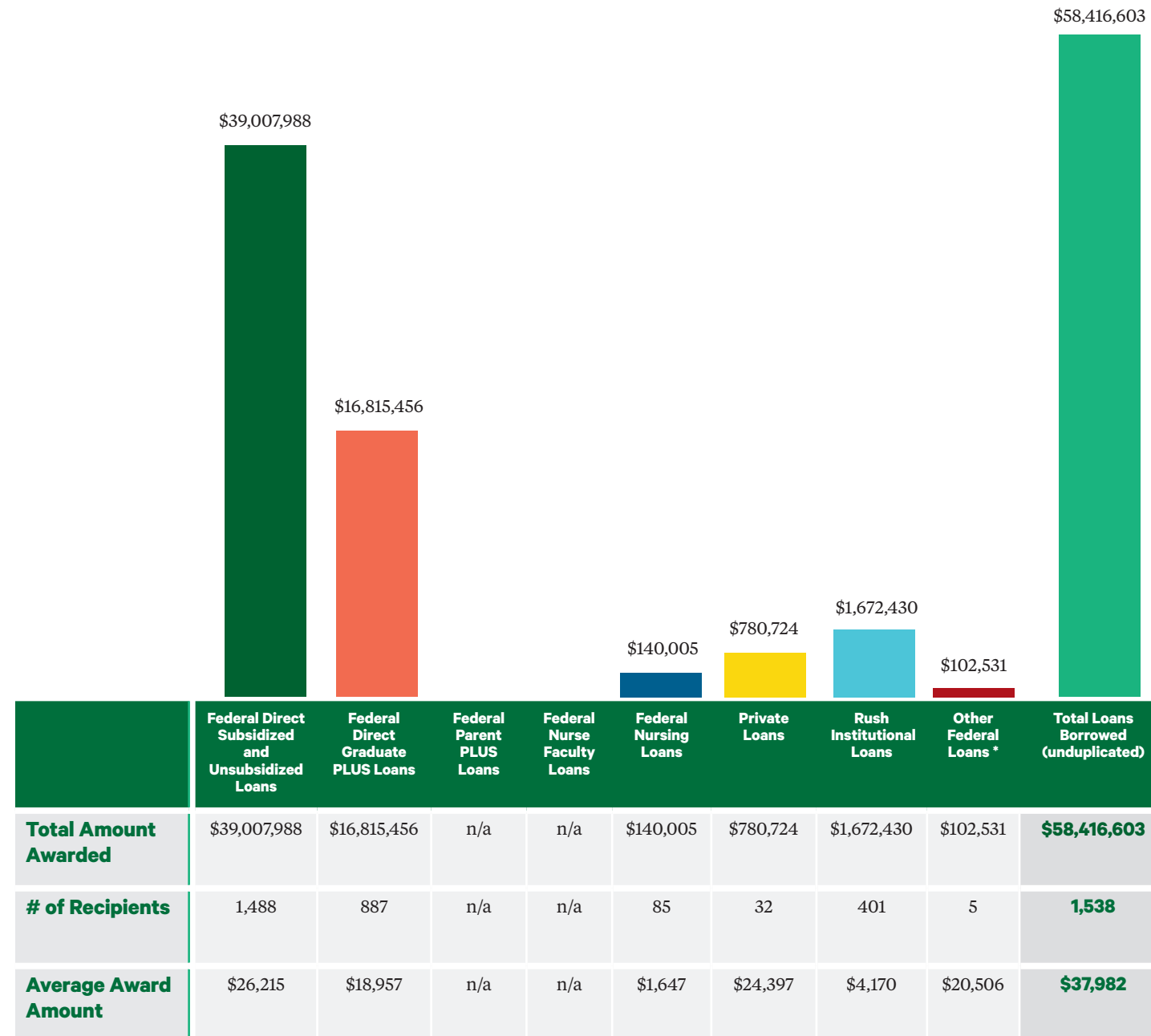

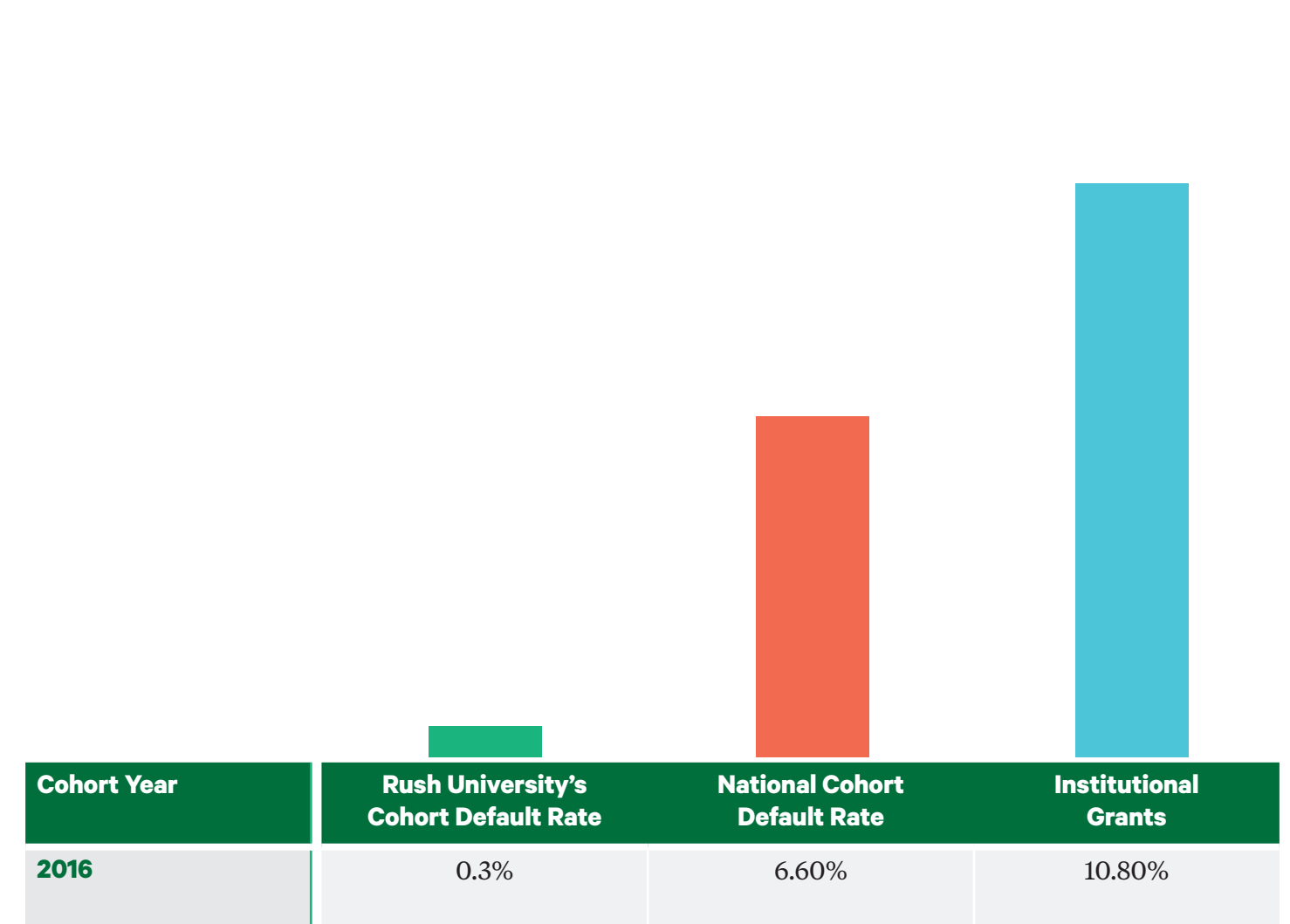

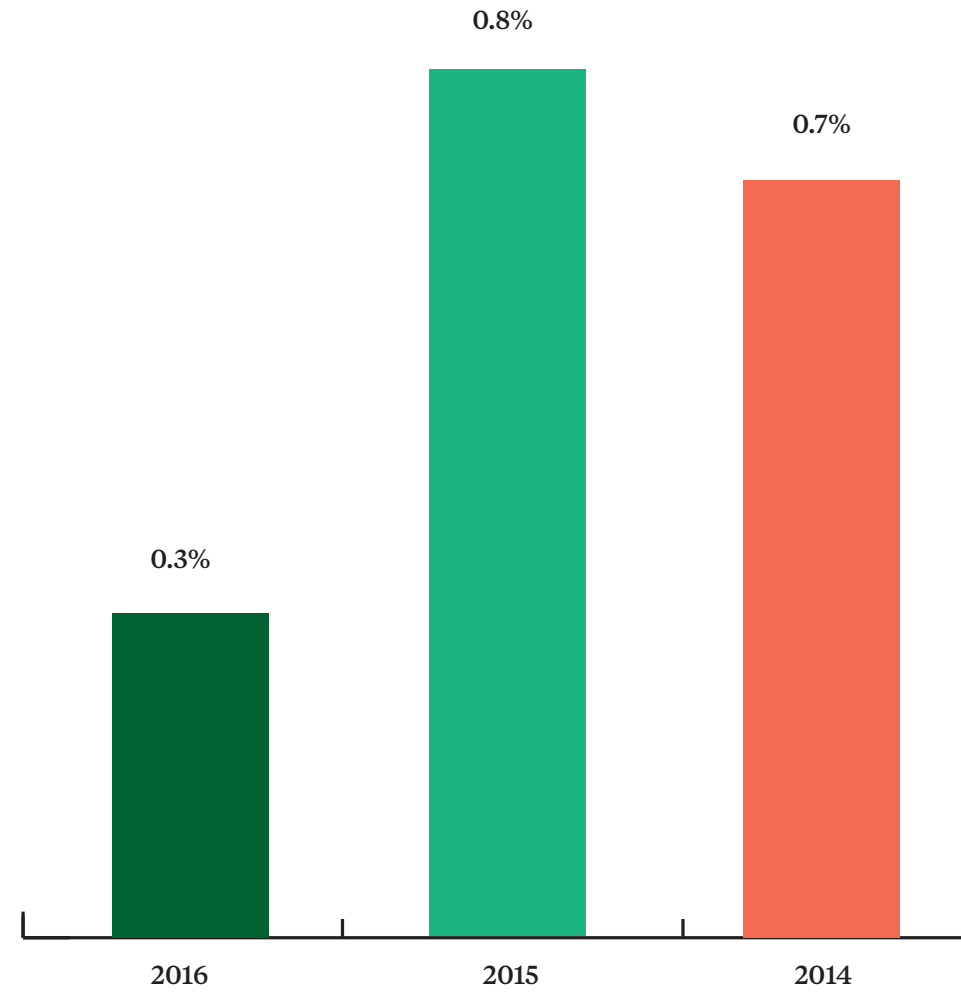

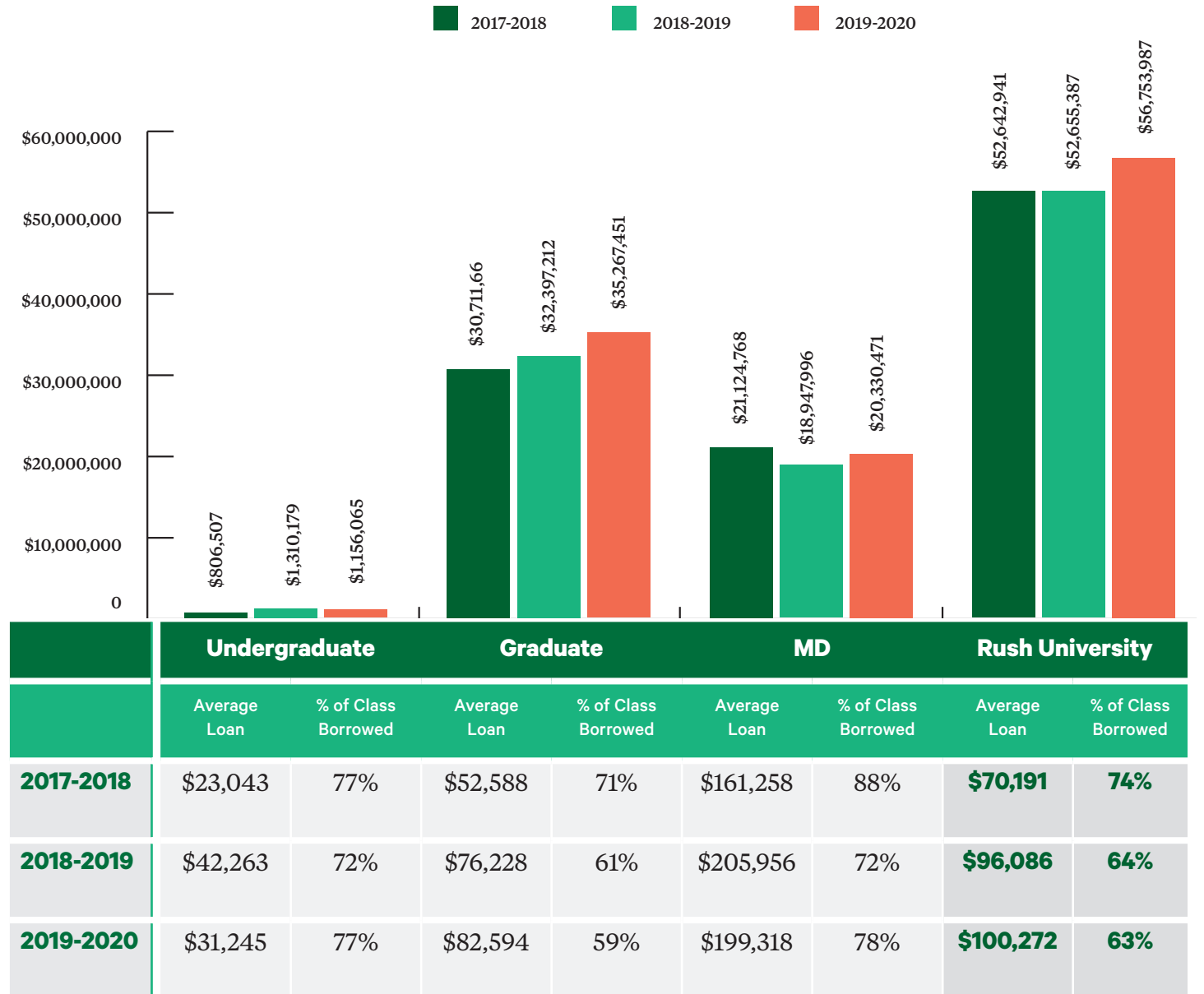

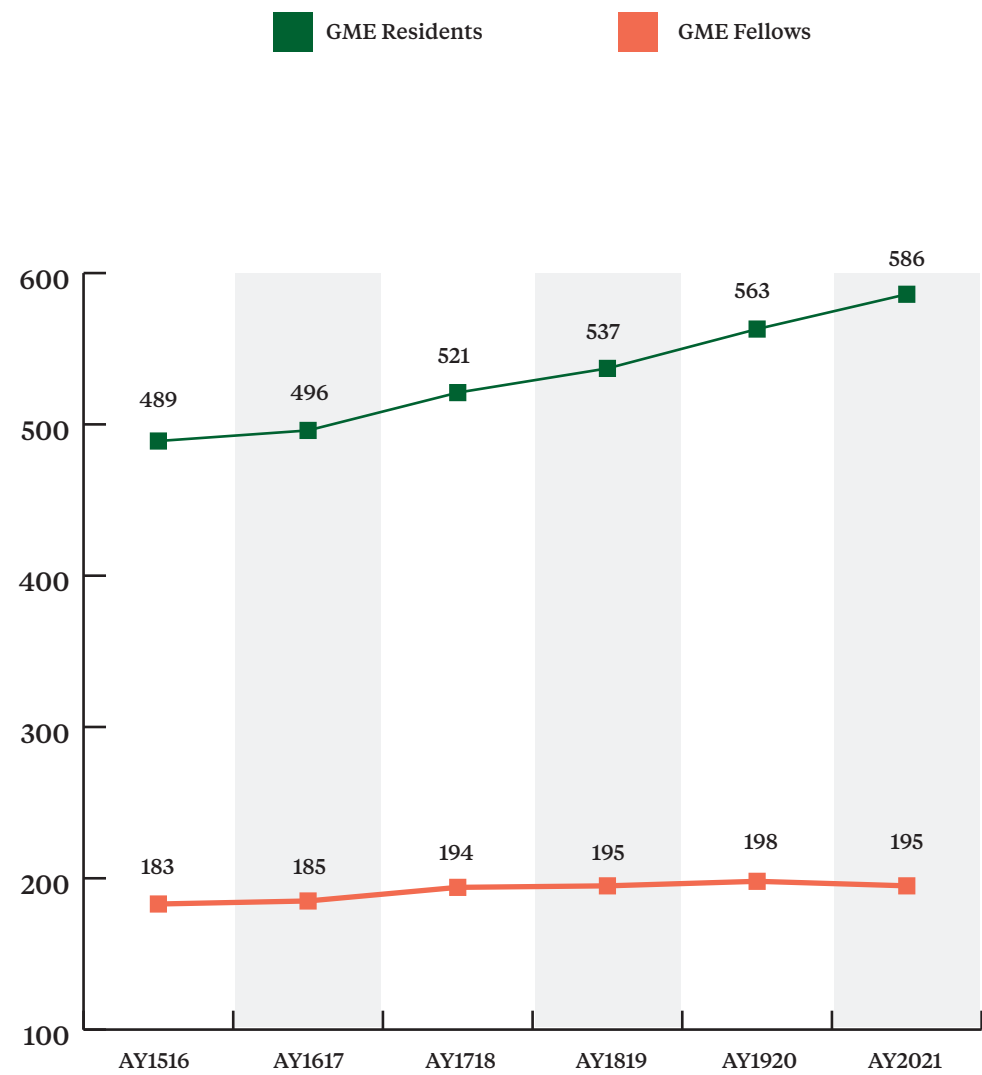

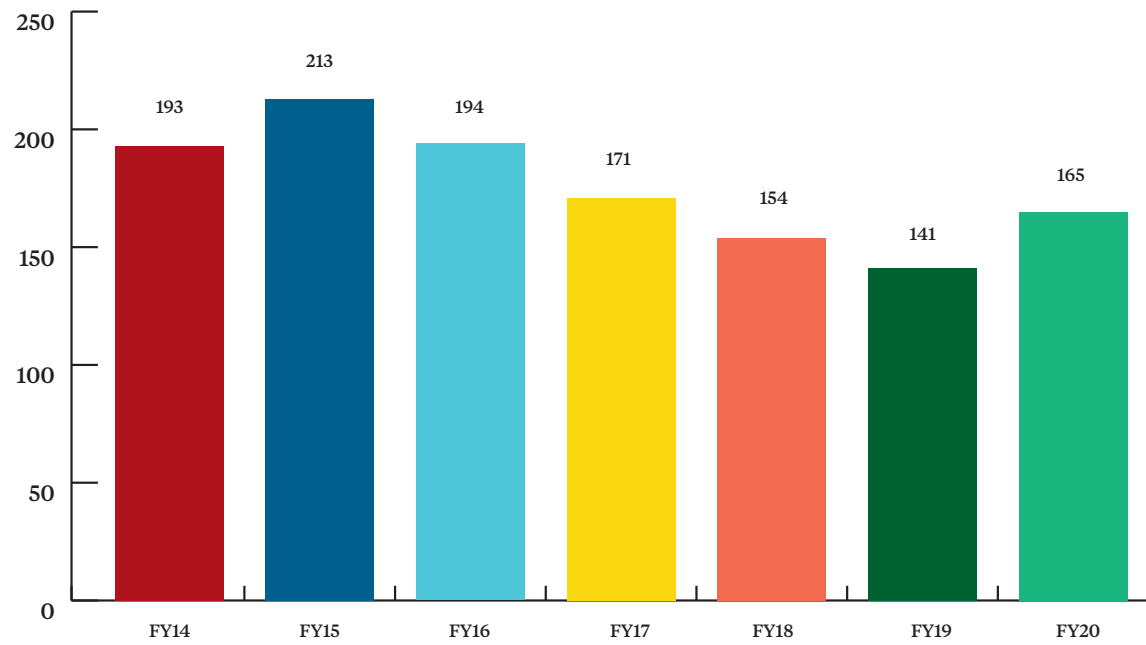

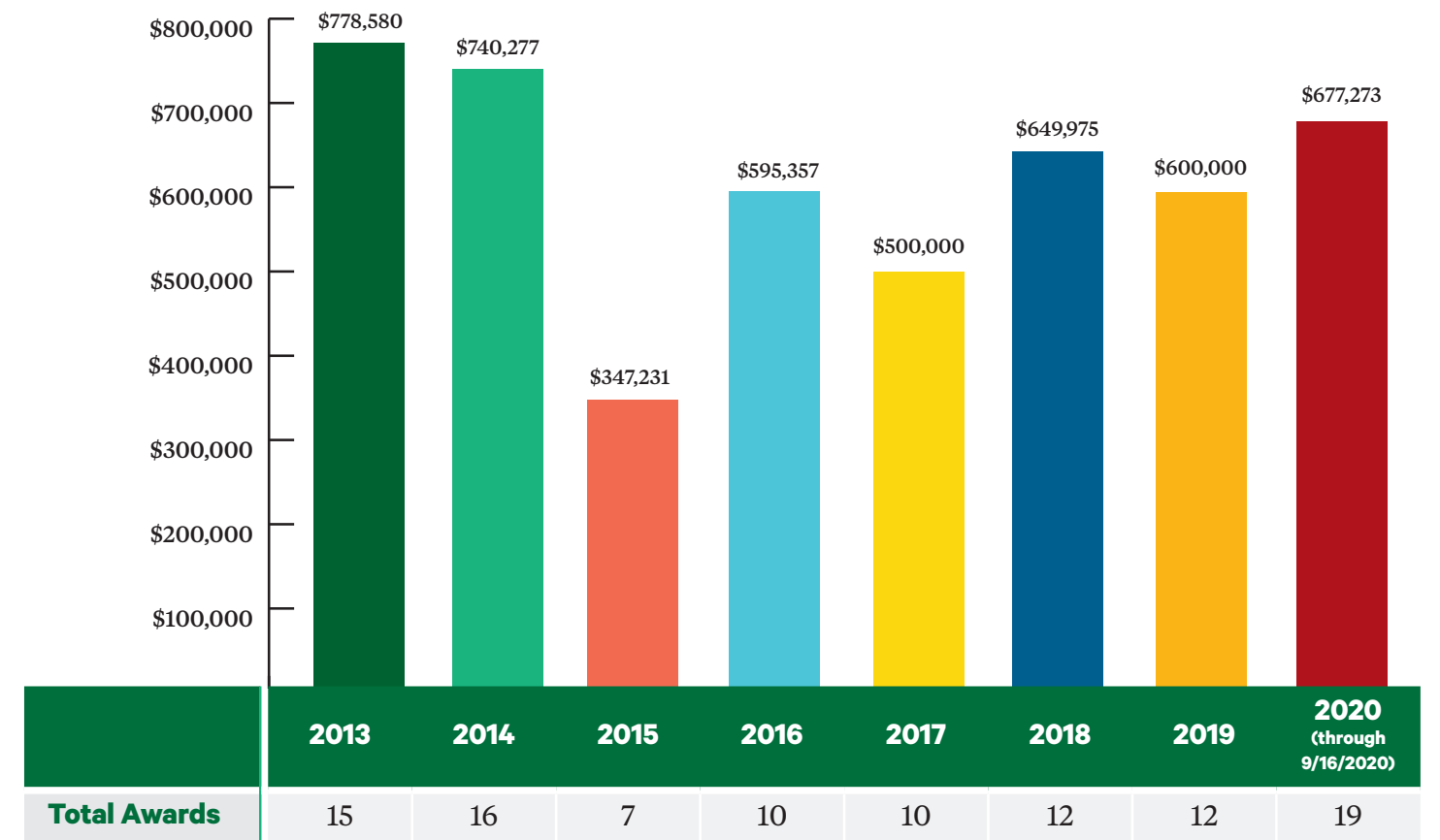

13.1 Total Number of Grant Applications* Submitted



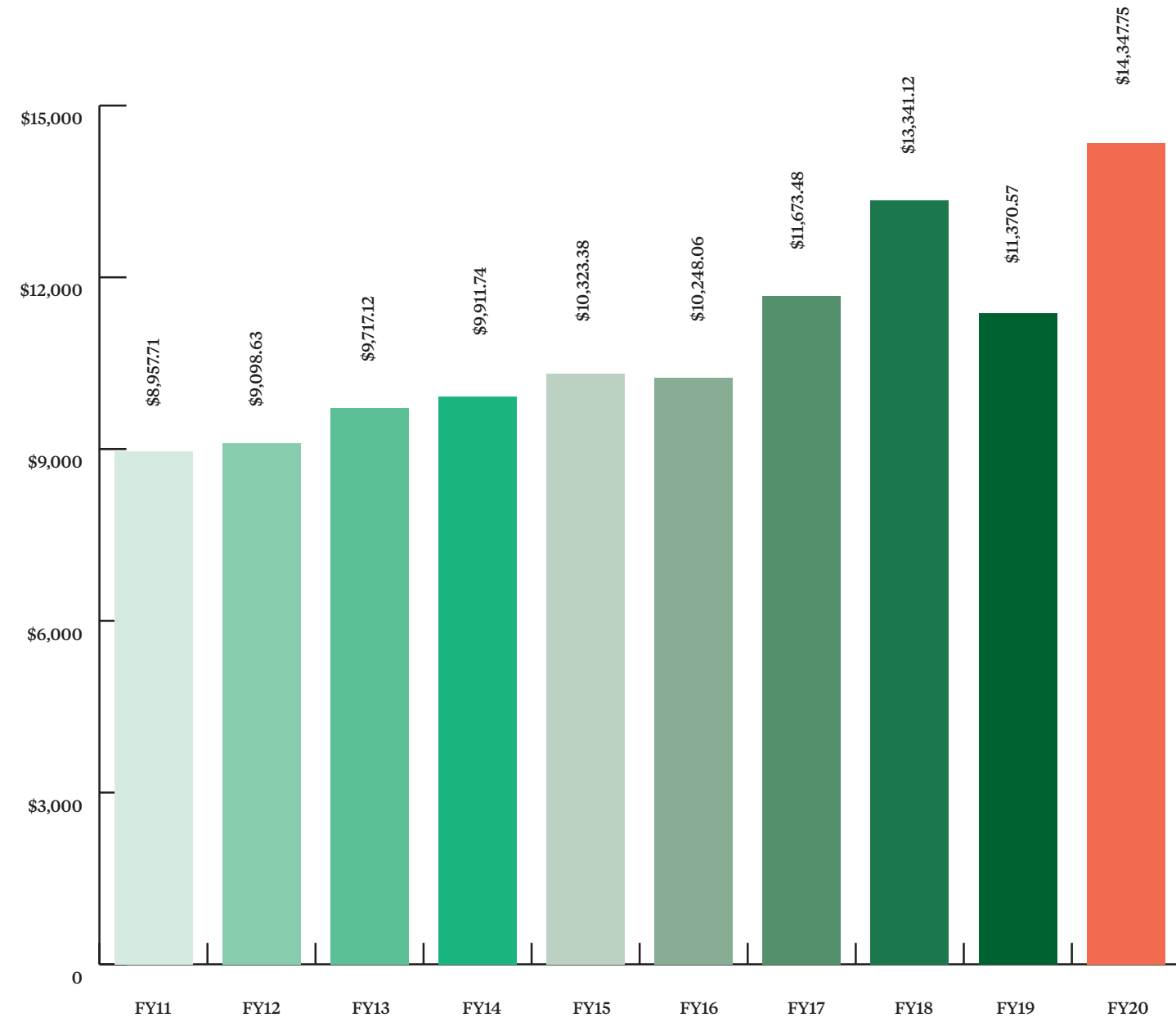

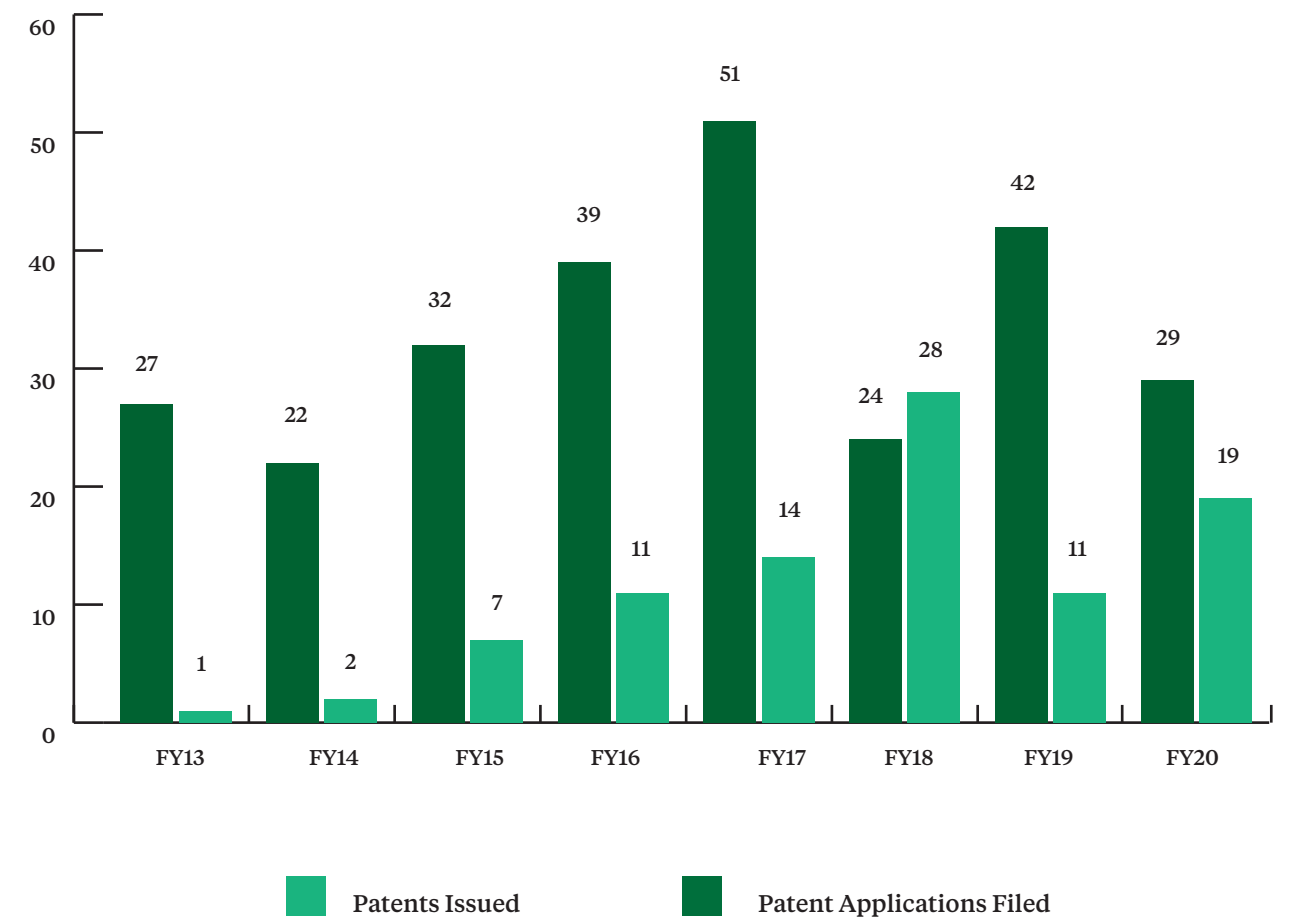

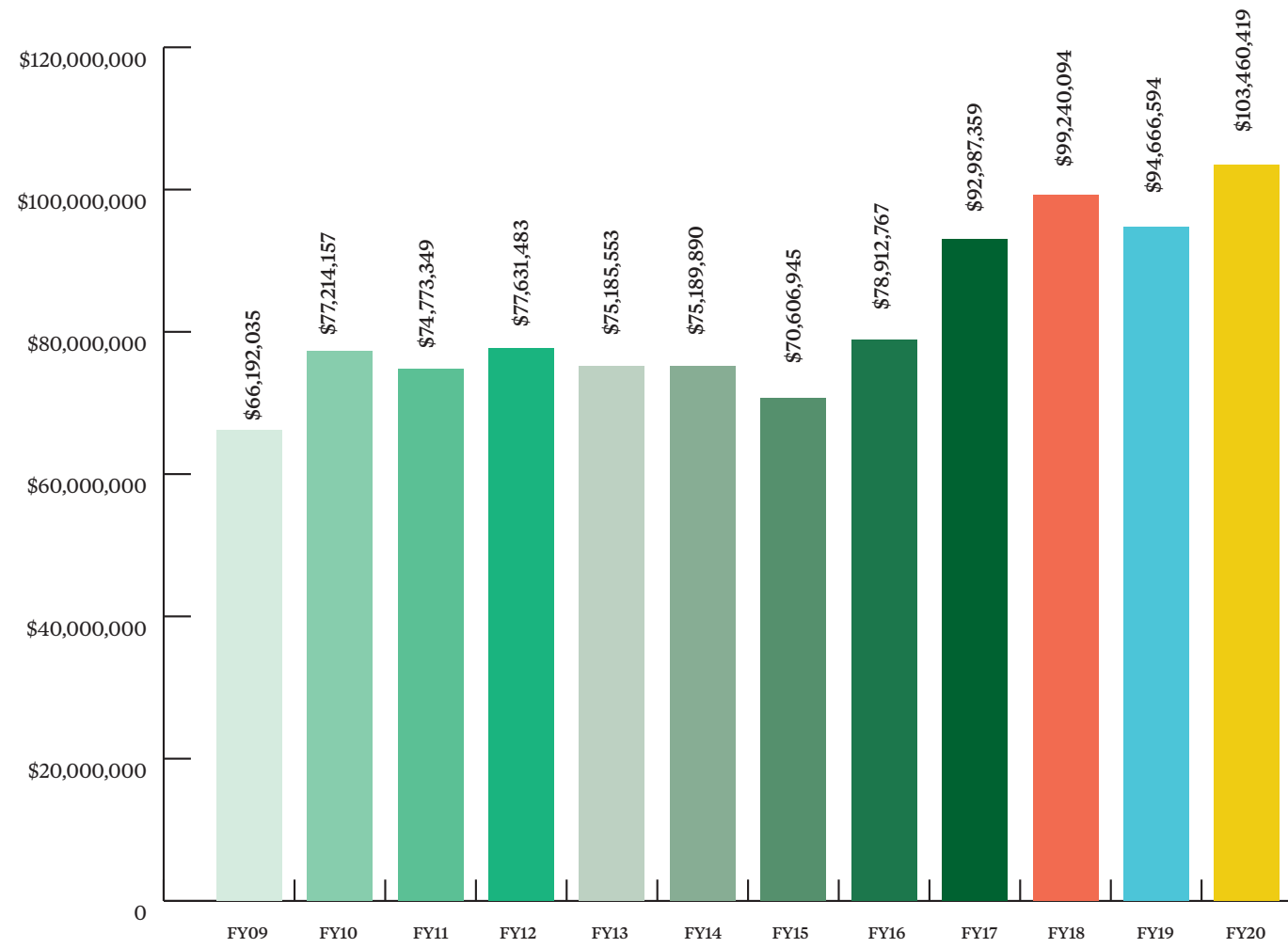
13.3 Total Industry Sponsored Research Cash Receipts (amounts in thousands)



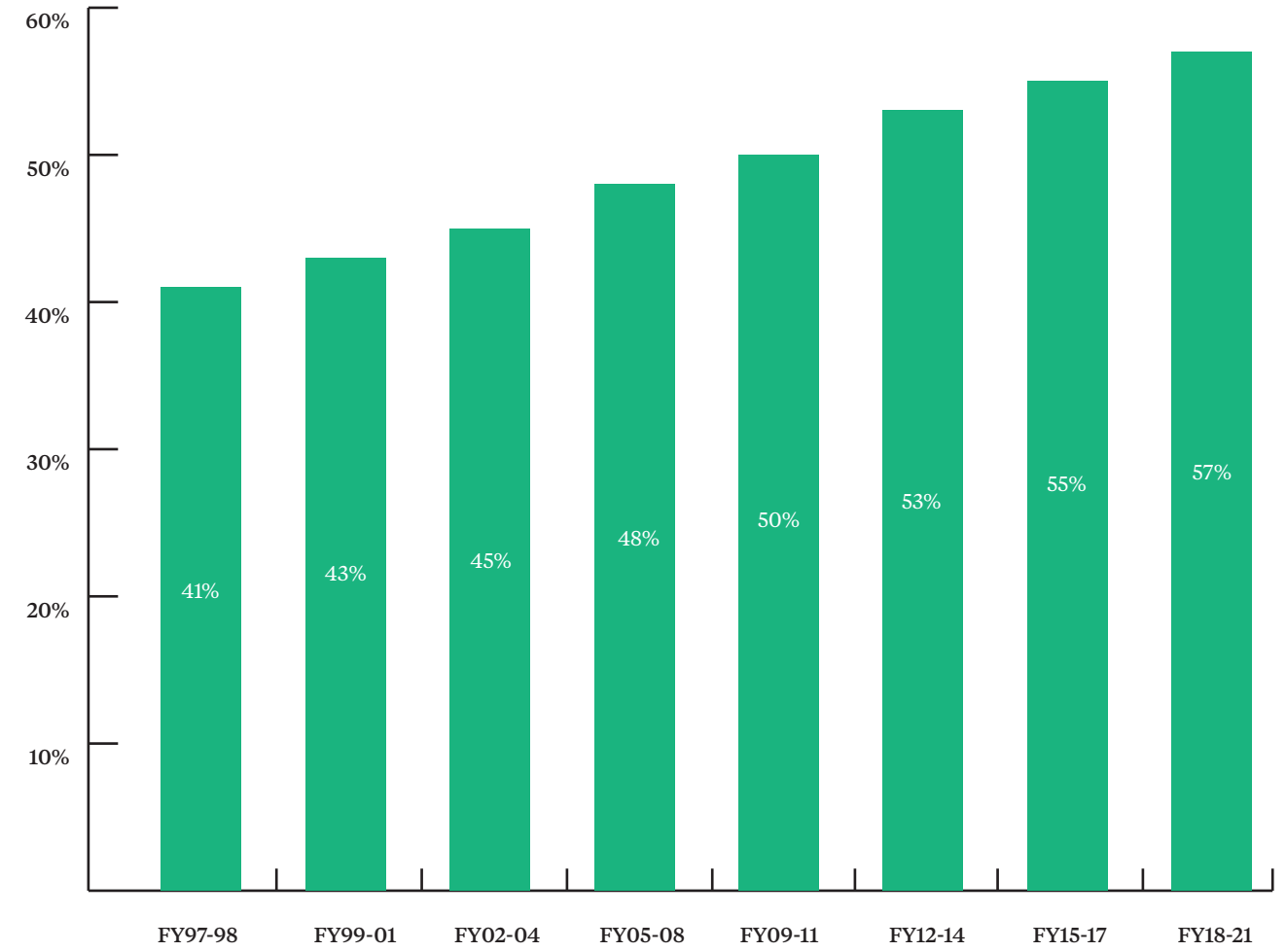
