

Are you a woman living with HIV/AIDS with a history of drug or alcohol use?



Research Description & Purpose: Researchers at Rush University Medical Center are conducting a study on attention and memory among women who are living with HIV/AIDS and have used alcohol or drugs.

Would the study be a good fit for me? This study may be a good fit for you if you meet the following criteria:

- ◆ Are a woman age 18 to 60
- ◆ Have ever used drugs and alcohol
- ◆ Are living with HIV/AIDS

What would happen if I took part in the study?

- ◆ Brief telephone interview for general information and screening
- ◆ Two, three-hour visits to 2150 W. Harrison St., Chicago

- ◆ Questionnaires and computerized tests of memory and attention
- ◆ Questions about medical history, mood and alcohol/drug use

Study participants receive **monetary compensation** for time and transportation at each visit.
