Prerequisite Courses	Kishwaukee College Course*
Two courses in communications English composition is required.	ENG-103, ENG-104, COM-100
One course in mathematics College algebra or higher-level math is required	MAT-150
Two courses in life sciences Human anatomy and physiology is required (two semesters are highly recommended). Second course may be in anatomy, biology, microbiology, pathophysiology, physiology or other life science topic.	BIO-258 and BIO-259. BIO-103 to BIO-105, BIO-201 to BIO-213.
One course in physical sciences General physics is highly recommended.	RA-220, PHY-250, CHE-110
One course in social sciences (i.e., government, history, political science, psychology, sociology)	ANT-120, ANT-220. HIS-132 or higher. PLS-140 or higher. PSY-102 to PSY-286. SOC-170 to SOC-288.
One course in humanities (i.e., philosophy, ethics, fine arts, literature)	ENG-130 to ENG-206, ENG-212 to ENG-299. HUM-119 to HUM-219. PHL-101 or higher. ART 282, 289-294.
Elective courses in communications, humanities, fine arts, philosophy, ethics, social sciences, life sciences, physical sciences or computer science to total 60 semester credit hours.
