You have been assigned a GRID (schedule) for the next academic year.\* Now it is time to rank sites for each clerkship. Sites selection, like grid selection, involves ranking your choices from 1-to-however many sites are offered for all clerkships. You may enter and leave the system as many times as you wish until the Lottery closes.

### INSTRUCTIONS

Login to <http://RUSH.NETKEVA.COM> using the same login name and password as for the Grids Lottery, or enter via the Online Schedules link on the RMC Curriculum webpage. If you have forgotten your password, use the "Forgot your password?" option to obtain a new one.

In the next screen, click on "Enter 2007-2008".

Your lottery-assigned grid and corresponding courses will be displayed as shown below. \* For each core will be a list of all site options available to you. *The sites list will be unique for your grid, (i.e. your list will show only those sites that have openings on the dates for which each of your clerkships is scheduled).*

Your task now is to prioritize sites using the ORDER column at the left. As for grid selection, there is no SAVE button, just the REORDER button at the bottom, which will apply all changes you have specified.

NOTE: You will select sites for 5 clerkships only: FAM 701;PSY 701;SUR 701, NEU 701, PED 701

### **Instructions**

For OBG 703, all students rotate at Rush. For MED 701, students rotate among 3 sites within the 12 week period. The Department of Medicine will email you with your starting site and sequence, prior to the beginning of the clerkship. Meanwhile, your schedule will show RUSH as the MED 701 site.

TIP: A site may be legitimately missing from your list for a given clerkship and date - it means that M4 students have already filled that site for that date. You can check slots availability yourself through the Course Catalog function in OASIS. Select Course Catalog from the upper menu; select Search in the department of interest. To the right of the list of courses that displays, you will see the "Availability" option, which will provide a complete list of M3 slots for each site and the number that are still open for that date.

#### Lottery Run Logic

Because you already have a grid, you are guaranteed to receive a slot somewhere for each clerkship on the grid, for the dates on your grid. This lottery is concerned only with available openings at each site for your assigned dates.

The sites lottery logic is exactly like the grids lottery logic, in that your selections are viewed by OASIS as one long list in rank order. OASIS in this situation does not differentiate between one clerkship and another, it just processes each selection as it comes. For example, let's say student X ranks sites as follows:

FAM at Rush (top choice)  
PSY at Rush  
SUR IV/RNS  
FAM at LaGrange  
FAM at West Sub  
SUR RNS/IV  
FAM at Hinsdale  
PSY at Stroger  
etc.

Let's also assume student X is the 30th student in the list of names to be processed. OASIS assigns students #1-29 to the highest selection they specified for which a slot is available, regardless of which clerkship it was for. Now it gets to student X. At this point, Family at Rush is already full, Psych at Rush is also full, but Surgery IV/RNS has an open slot, so he gets it. Now OASIS moves on and makes one assignment to all 132 other students before coming back to student X. Upon returning to student X, the system resumes looking at his selections, starting with the item after Sur IV/RNS. It doesn't find another available opening until it gets to Psy at Stroger. Later in the lottery, because many other students ranked Family sites nearer the top of their lists, student X gets his last Fam choice, which happens to be Copley.

Site Lottery results for student X:  
SUR IV/RNS  
PSY at Stroger  
FAM at Copley
