Policies and Procedures-Admissions

Postdoctoral Fellows

Postdoctoral fellows come to study at the College of Nursing under the auspices of a faculty-sponsored grant. The following systems assist in tracking the progress of the fellow. It will allow fellows to enroll in courses that support their research.

1. Faculty who are sponsoring post-doctoral fellows will notify the Associate Dean for Research and the College of Nursing Admissions Committee of the number of positions to be filled each July.
2. When post-doctoral fellows enter the College, their application materials will be presented to the College of Nursing Admissions Committee.
3. Fellows will be entered into the College of Nursing and Registrar's information systems as post-master students under the faculty sponsor's name and department.
4. Fellows will be able to take courses at Rush as post-master's students. Progressions policies apply to all coursework taken by doctoral fellows.
5. Transcript will designate student as post-masters/post-doctoral fellow.
6. Coursework taken during post-doctoral training will carry the following transcript notation:
