announce a new program to bring innovative approaches
to the field of HIV research

This program will offer grant funding for 1-2 years with support of up to US\$150,000 (direct) per year.

- Scientists who have never been HIV/AIDS investigators encouraged to apply. Researchers who have had any previous grant or contract in HIV/AIDS research are not eligible.
- Applicants may be located at one of the CFAR sites or may be external to those sites.
- Applicants who are chosen to submit a full proposal and do not already have a relationship with a CFAR will be required to establish a mentor/collaborator relationship with a CFAR-affiliated investigator.
- Research topics could include any aspect of science, but should not include clinical trials of new drugs, treatments, or devices; or off-label use of licensed drug.

-  Concept proposals (2 pages) are due December 22, 2009.
-  Full proposals will be due April 22, 2010.
-  Awards will be announced at the IAS Conference July 18, 2010.
