Enrollment At-A-Glance Report: Fall 2023 Executive Summary

The Enrollment-At-A-Glance Report provides five-year data that include the total student headcount, headcount for newly enrolled students, student demographics, and degrees awarded. The report is updated each term.

Enrollment data are obtained from the Student Information System and are based on the official Census Date established by the Registrar. The Census Date is the date on which enrollment counts are frozen for purposes of internal and external reporting. Students not registered in the Student Information System by the Census Date cut-off may not be included in the count for that term. This report also includes the fall 2023 budgeted vs. actual enrollments obtained from the University Finance Team.

Total Student Headcount by College and Program

- Fall 2023 total headcount decreased by approximately 3% over Fall 2022, from 2870 to 2782.
 - Greatest % increases occurred in the Imaging Sciences, BS (38%, +14 students);
 M4, MD (9%, +12 students); Health Sciences, PhD (8%, +4 students); and
 Physician Assistant Studies, MS (7%, +6 students) programs.
 - Greatest % decreases occurred in the Post-Graduate Nursing, Cert (-36%, -5 students); Speech-Language Pathology, MS (-33%, -36 students); Clinical Research, MS (-16%, -7 students); Medical Laboratory Science, MS (-15%, -7 students); and Vascular Ultrasound, BS (-14%, -3 students) programs.
 - The College of Nursing accounts for 42% of the total enrollments, followed by the College of Health Sciences (29%), Rush Medical College (21%), The Graduate College (5%), and Non-Degree Seeking (2%).
 - Undergraduates comprise 4% of the total student population; MS/MSN programs 32%; professional doctorates 56%; research doctorates 5%; certificates 1%; and Non-Degree Seeking or Students-at-Large 2%.
- Enrollment had a slight decrease in 2022 and has now dropped nearly 3% in Fall 2023 when compared to Fall 2022. However, enrollment for Fall 2023 is about 1% higher than Fall 2019. When compared to 2019, Fall 2023 had the greatest increase in undergraduate students (9%, +10 students) followed by research doctorates (6%, +9 students). There was a decrease in certificates (-53%, -19 students) and in professional doctorate programs (<-1%, -7 students).

Total Student Headcount by Demographics

- Gender distribution and average age have remained steady since 2019, with 77% female on the average and 23% male. The average age of the student body is 29 years.
- The proportion of all known minority students has steadily increased since 2019.
 - Underrepresented minorities account for approximately 25% of the total student population.
 - The Fall 2023 enrollment of Asian, Black/African American, Hispanic, and Multiracial (Two or More Races) students as a percentage of the total student population each had an increase of about 1% over Fall 2022.
 - The Fall 2023 proportion of Black/African American students has increased to about 10% of the total student population. The proportion of Hispanic students has increased from 12% (n=322) in 2019 to 15% (n=414) in 2023.
 - Approximately 43% of the student population identify as minority; with about 25% of the student population identifying as underrepresented minority.

Degrees Awarded


The University awarded 931 degrees during the 2022-2023 academic year, an <1% decrease over the 2021-2022 academic year. An increase of 14% (from 815 to 931) occurred between Fall 2021 and Fall 2023; some of this increase is believed to be delayed graduation a result of the COVID-19 pandemic.


