**Comments:**

For the Class of 2022, exit interviews with students indicated that the global pandemic and lockdown situation and the resulting remote learning environment negatively impacted their desire to complete the program.

For the Class of 2023, the maximum entering class size was 30, however 3 students that matriculated with the Class of 2022 decelerated into the Class of 2023 cohort, for a total entering class size of 32, as indicated above. This was a increase due to special circumstances that was approved by the ARC-PA.

One remaining student in the Class of 2023 is projected to graduate in April 2024, at which time the final number of graduates will increase to 30, with a graduation rate of 93.75%
