


4.1 Enrollment by Race/Ethnicity, AY2324

4.2 Enrollment by Program Modality, AY2324




















9.5 Rush University Cohort Default Rate for Most Recent 3 Years




Total Debt Borrowed, AY2122 - AY2324


12.3 Total Industry Sponsored* Research Cash Receipts (in thousands): FY18 - FY24




