

# OnCore Course: OnCore 101

## *What is it?*

The OnCore – Clinical Trial Management System (CTMS) is a system used in research to manage and track study protocols and their subjects. The **OnCore 101 course** provides basic information that will allow study team members to manage their clinical research studies.

## *Who should take OnCore 101?*

Research staff involved in human subjects' research that will manage data in OnCore.
