Responsible Conduct of Research In-House Training Program is Here!

The Office of Research Compliance (ORC) is will offer in-person *Responsible Conduct of Research (RCR) In-House Training Program*. The topics in this program will be presented by content experts and have been created to fulfill the National Institutes of Health (NIH)* requirement for formal instruction for those obtaining career development, research education, and dissertation research grants. In addition, it's an opportunity to better educate Rush research personnel on the principles of RCR.

The sessions will be presented in a case study format with a basic knowledge of RCR principles required so learners can participate and benefit from the sessions. In addition, it allows attendee interaction and a deeper understanding of the topics and strategies to apply best practices to your research.

Along with completion of the 10-series coursework, the *CITI Program (citiprogram.org) RCR must be completed as a prerequisite to receive a Certificate of Completion*. The training sessions will be from 9-10:30 a.m. via WebEx and will allow for instruction in two content areas during each session. *Registration is required and is completed in the Learning Hub.*
