



THE DIANE CRONIN-STUBBS MEMORIAL AWARD

MAXIMUM AWARD AMOUNT: \$1,000

Applications are currently being accepted for the Diane Cronin-Stubbs Memorial Award for a PhD student completing advanced clinical research practicum hours. Diane was a brilliant researcher, a passionate teacher and an exceptional colleague.

During her 16 years at Rush, Diane worked as a practitioner-teacher, a graduate program coordinator, assistant chairperson, research coordinator, clinical nurse researcher, and research scientist. Her long career was marked by many honors including a Research Career Development Award from the National Institutes of Health, visiting fellowships at Harvard and Northwestern Universities, and induction into the American Academy of Nursing. Although she conducted seminal studies in the areas of occupational stress and geriatric mental health, and published numerous, widely-cited articles, Diane's most enduring legacy is undoubtedly the hundreds of students she taught and mentored over the course of her career, many of whom are now leaders in nursing research and education.
