MAXIMUM AWARD AMOUNT: \$1,000

Each year the Golden Lamp Society presents this award to a DNP student with an approved project proposal within the Rush University College of Nursing (CON). Dorothy and Luther Christman were dedicated supporters of the CON. Luther Christman was the first dean of the Rush University College of Nursing from 1972 to 1987. A pioneer in the field of nursing education, Dr. Christman was one of the first advocates for advanced degrees for nurses, and he developed the practitioner-teacher model that still makes the CON unique.

The Golden Lamp Society is the premier giving society dedicated to Rush University College of Nursing. Its members provide philanthropic funds that support educational and research opportunities for Rush nursing students, faculty, and clinicians.

- DNP student with an approved project proposal
- GPA of at least 3.75

- Curriculum vitae
- Executive summary of project proposal (1-2 pages) that includes a detailed budget for use of funds.
- One letter of recommendation from faculty advisor
