The Joseph Zbilut Memorial Award is awarded to a DNP student with a specialty focus in Adult Health and Gerontological Nursing. Joseph Zbilut was a professor in the Department of Adult Health and Gerontological Nursing and a professor in the Department of Molecular Biophysics and Physiology. In his nursing career, Joseph crossed disciplinary boundaries, working closely with colleagues in physiology, biophysics and medicine to further the understanding of the body's biological signals. He was internationally recognized for his work on nonlinear dynamics. This award is generously funded by the friends, family and colleagues in loving memory of Joseph.
