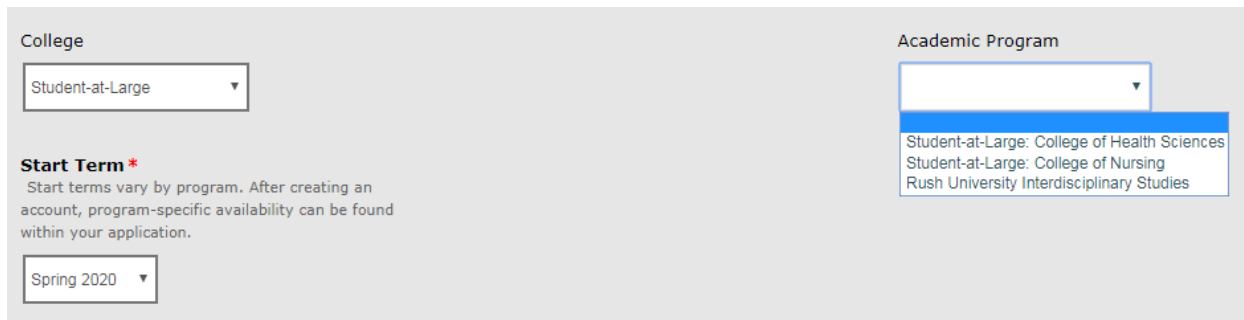

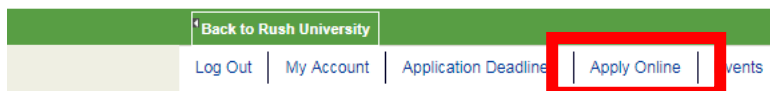


Complete the Create an Account Information.
