

Getting Around Rush University Medical Center DURING CITY ROADWORK

The City of Chicago is replacing the water main lines on Harrison Street between Ashland and Damen Avenues. During this work, Harrison Street will be reduced to two lanes of traffic — one going east and one going west. The construction begins at the end of May and continues through September.

We anticipate delays around our main campus throughout the roadwork. Please be assured that we are working diligently to minimize disruptions to our patients and visitors. This includes the use of flaggers and added signage to direct traffic.
