



RUSH Investigator-Led Project Costs

1 Tier One Requests

Tier one projects are those that require the lowest level of coordination and analyst time and effort. Tier one projects include the initial intake process, introduction to the CAPriCORN Common Data Model, query development, piloting and review. The final query output is shared with the study team, along with a report summarizing the results.

Tier one projects cost approximately \$1000 - \$3000.

2 Tier Two Requests

Tier two projects encompass some complex aspects, which require increased coordination and/or analyst effort to produce the desired query and data output. These projects diverge from tier one as they may require additional meetings or revisions throughout the query development and report generation processes. Projects that require multiple query outputs may be assigned to this tier.

Tier two projects cost approximately \$3000 - \$5000.

3 Tier Three Requests

Tier three projects are highly complex and call for innovative methods and approaches to study design and query development. Tier three projects require additional effort for query development, revisions, and report generation by the CAPriCORN coordinator, analyst, principal investigator and/or lead analyst. Several meetings with the study team are often necessary to refine the query output and analysis. Projects that require multiple query outputs may be assigned to this tier.

The rate for tier three projects starts at \$5000 and is subject to increase based on project complexity.

Tier assignments are determined through evaluating multiple factors relating to the complexity of the request. Therefore, tier assignment is to the discretion of the CAPriCORN at Rush team.
