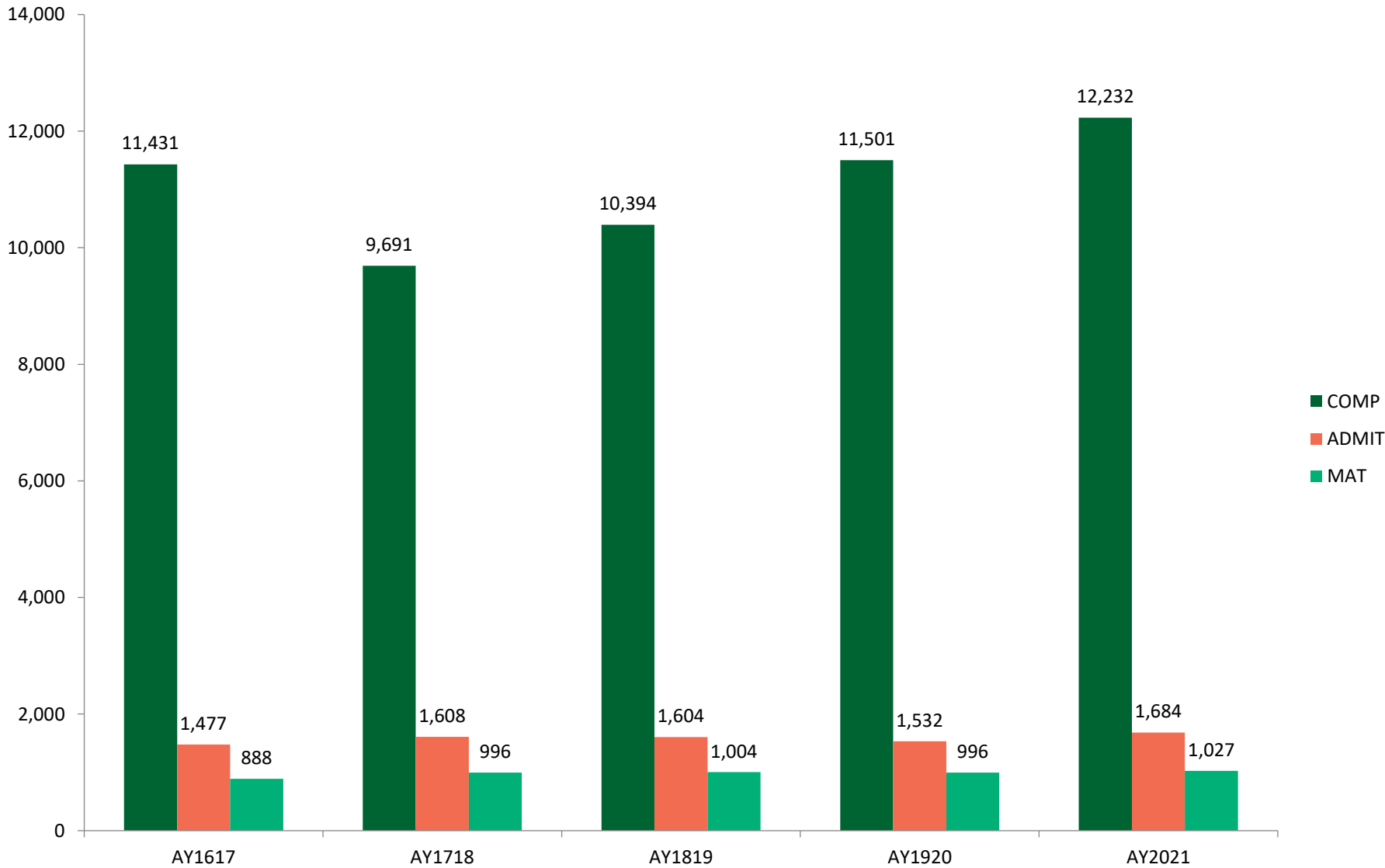

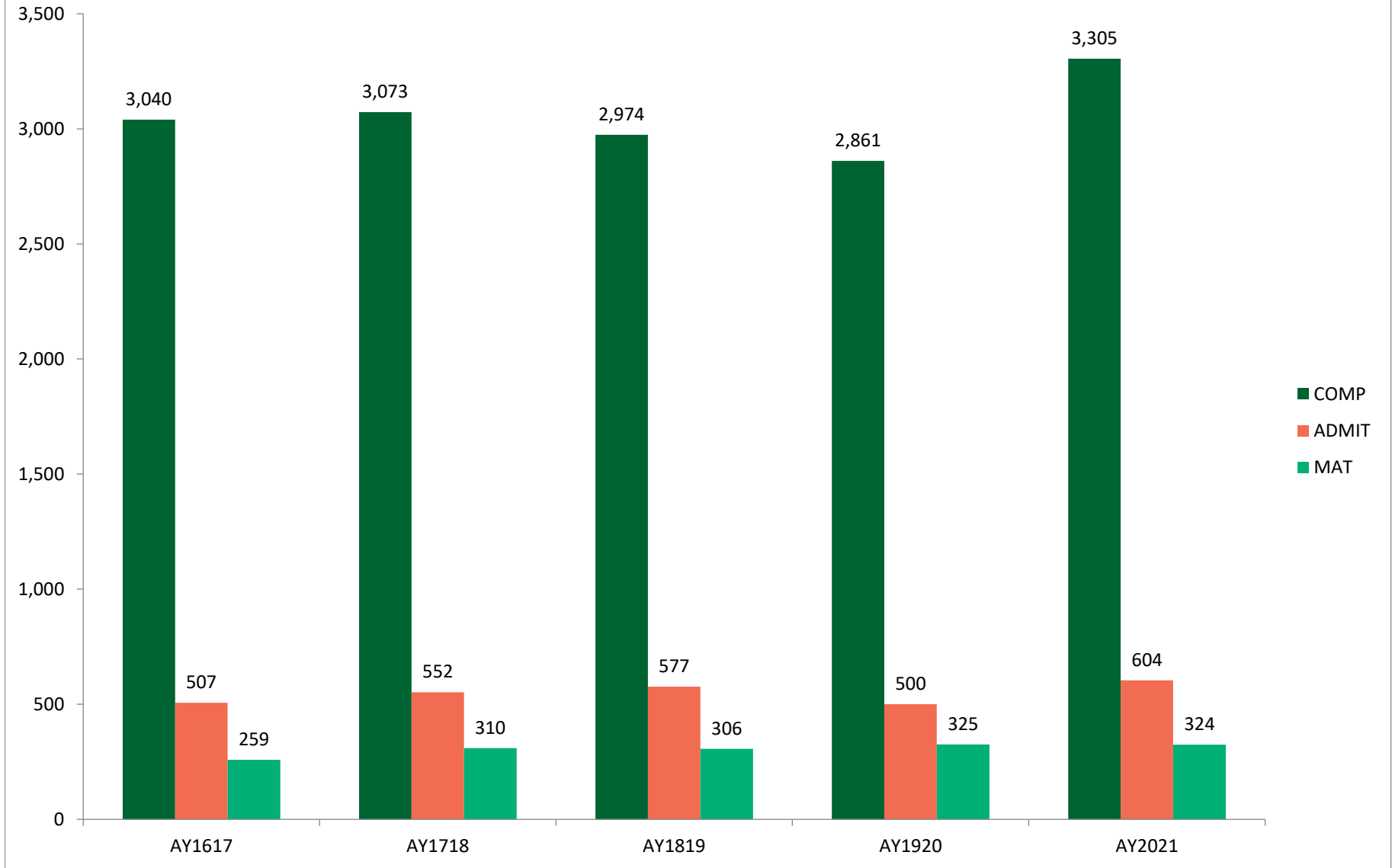

Totals by Status & Academic Year

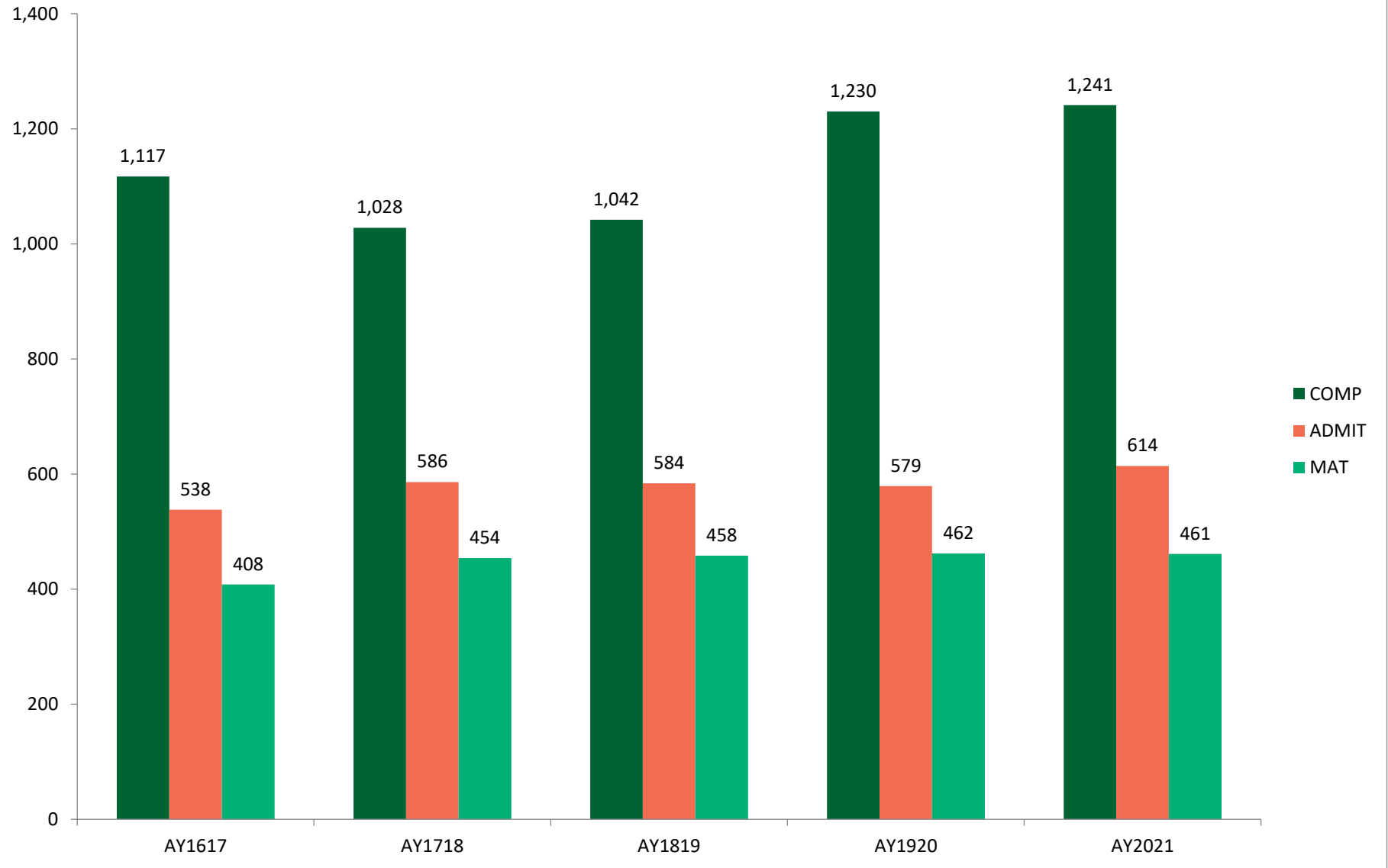

Totals by Status & Academic Year

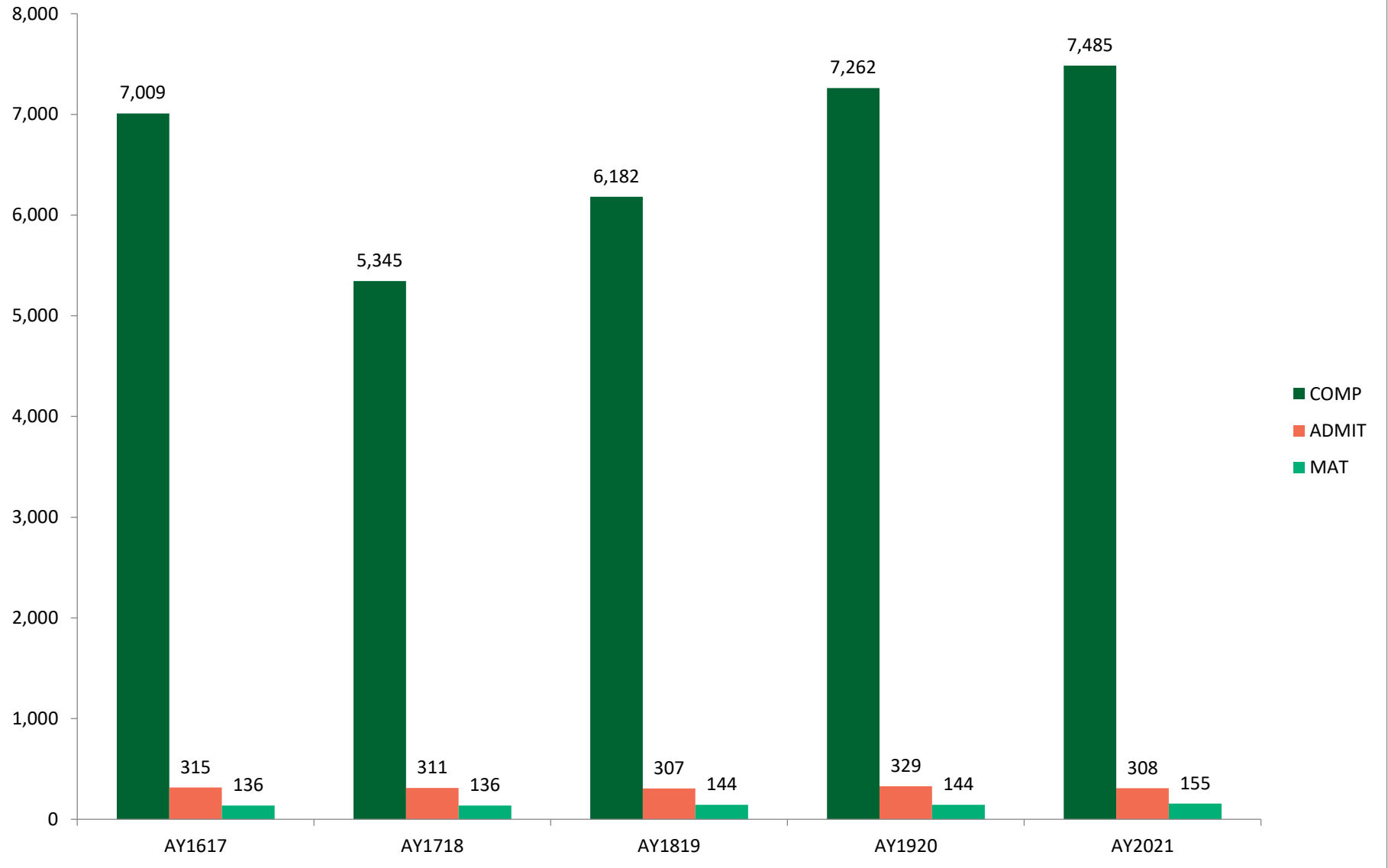

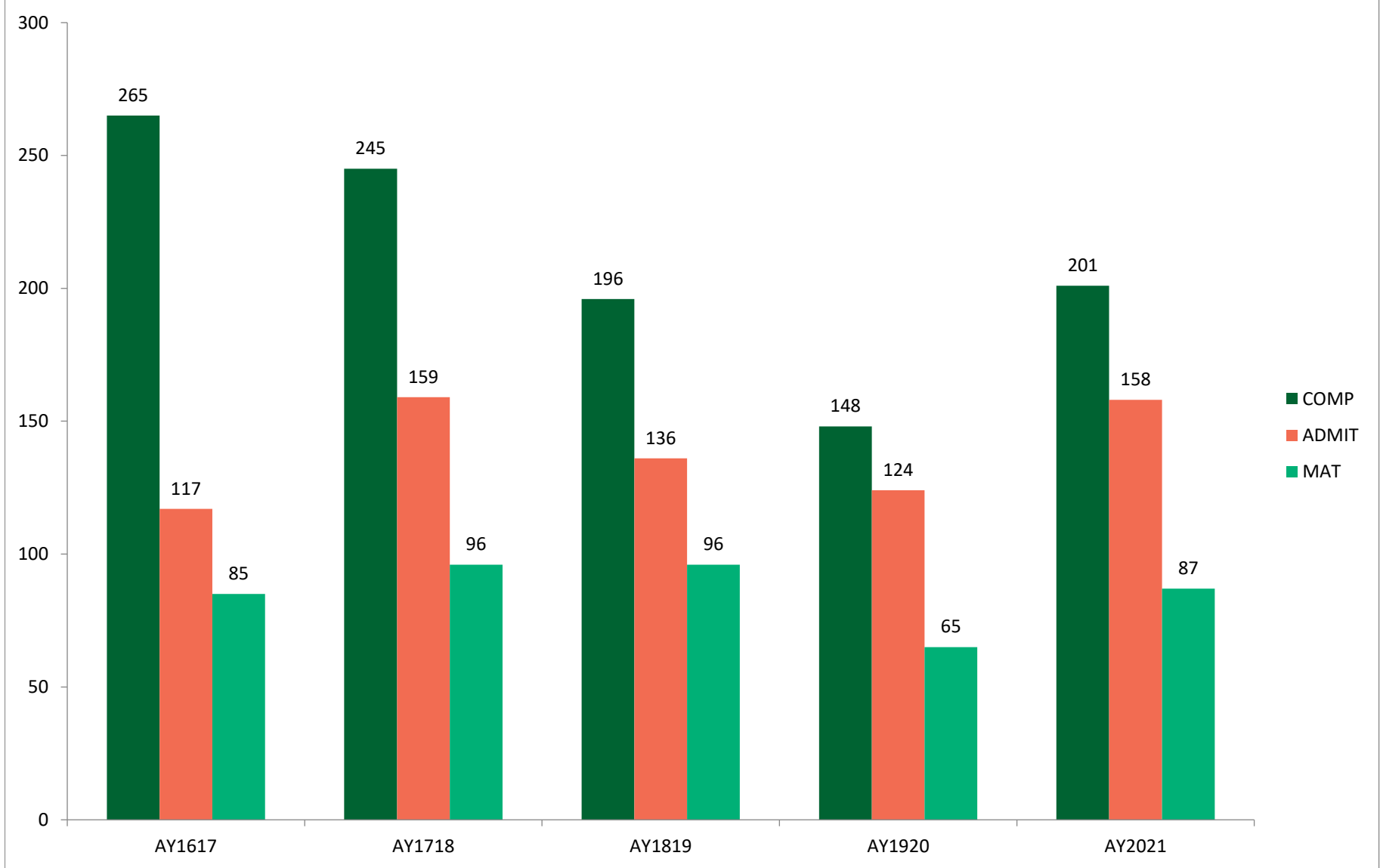

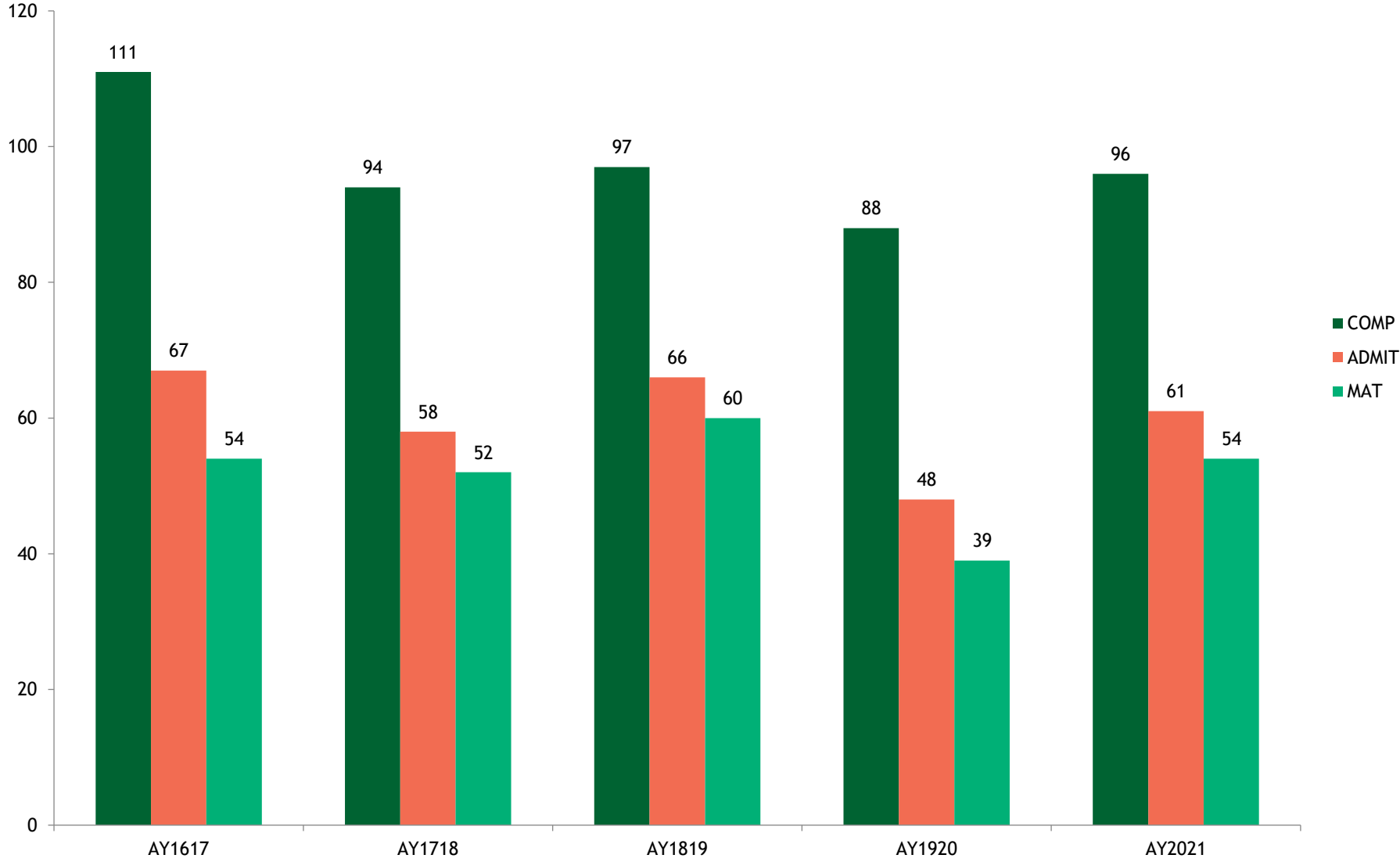

Totals by Status & Academic Year

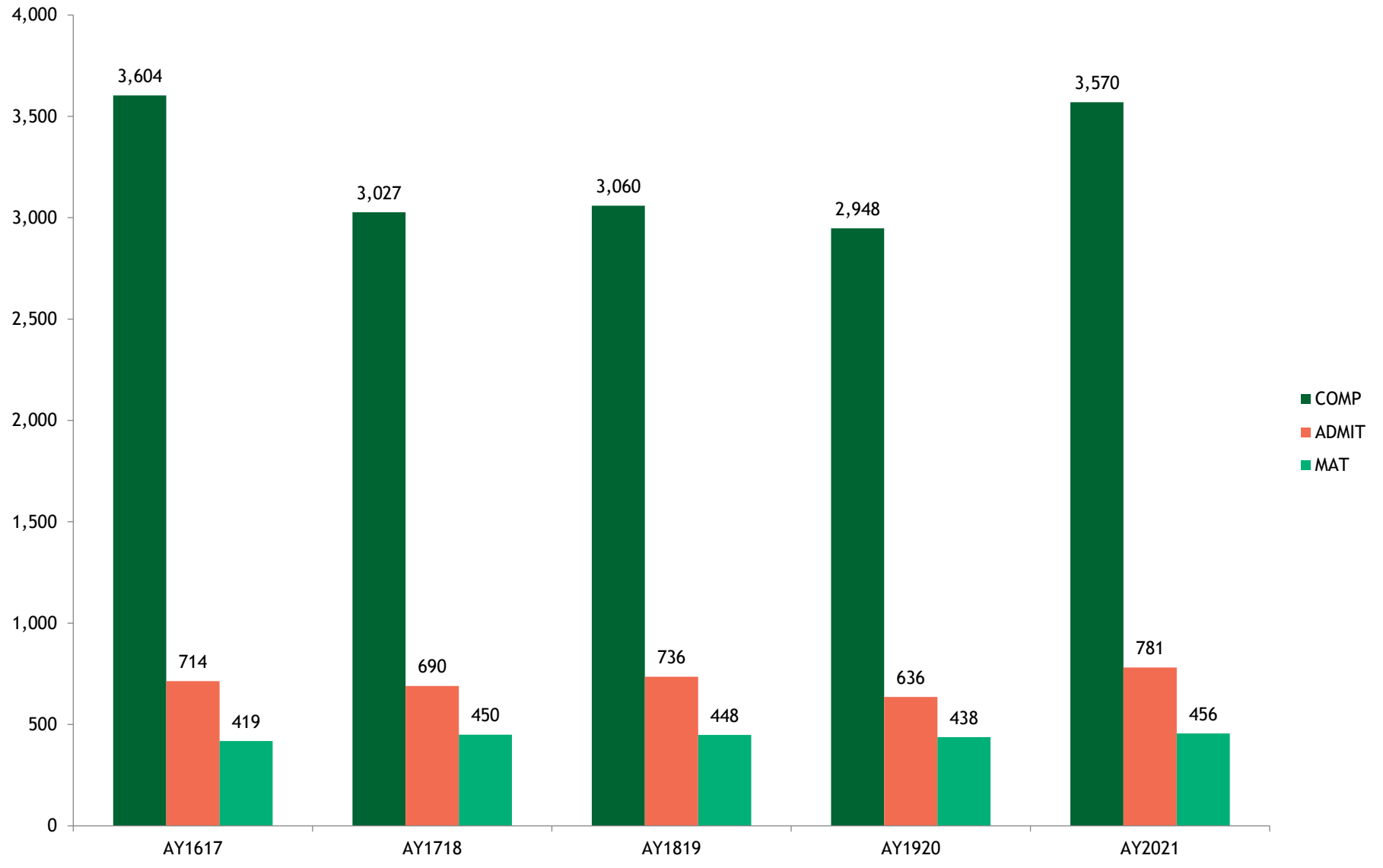

Totals by Status & Academic Year

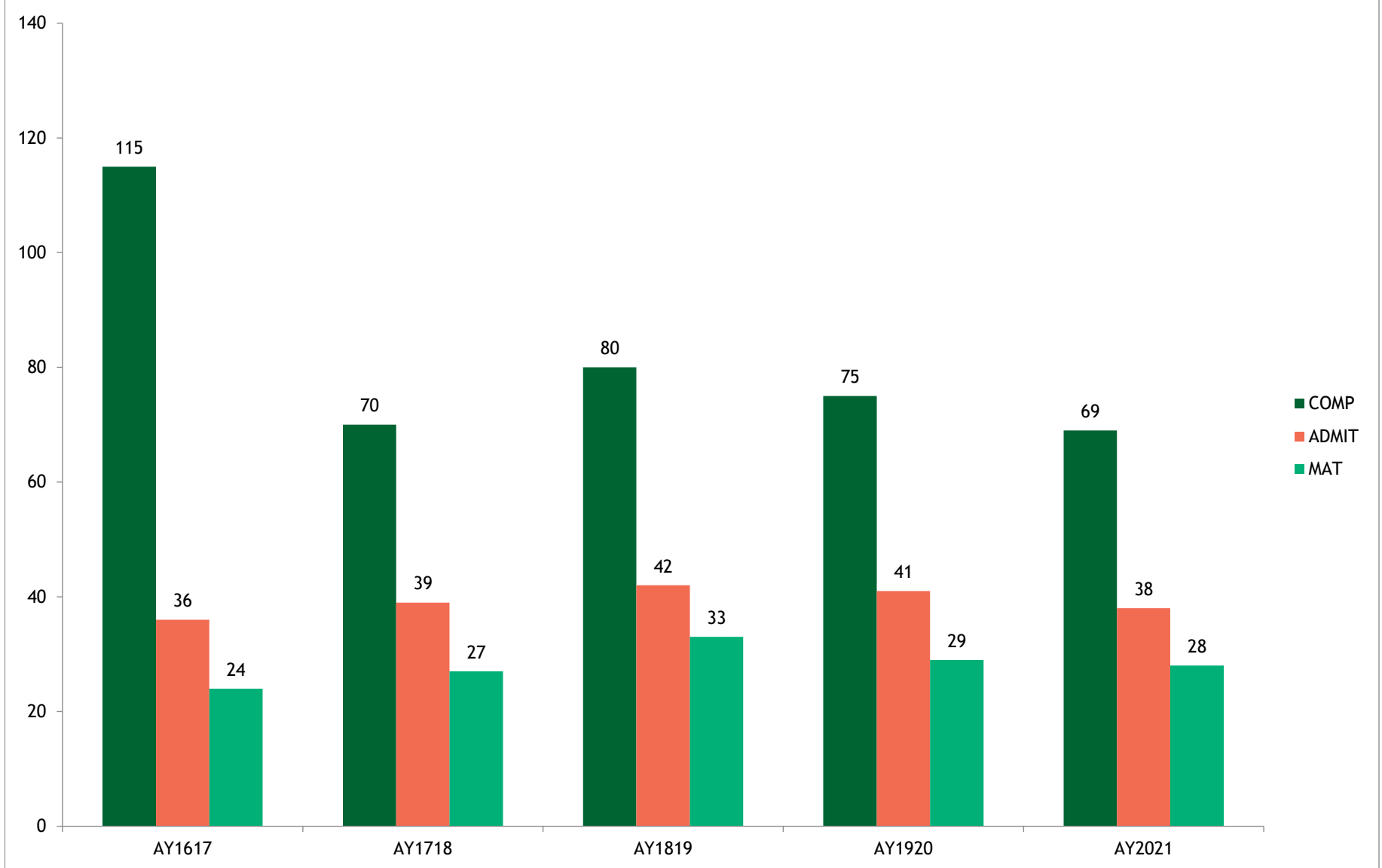

Totals by Status & Academic Year

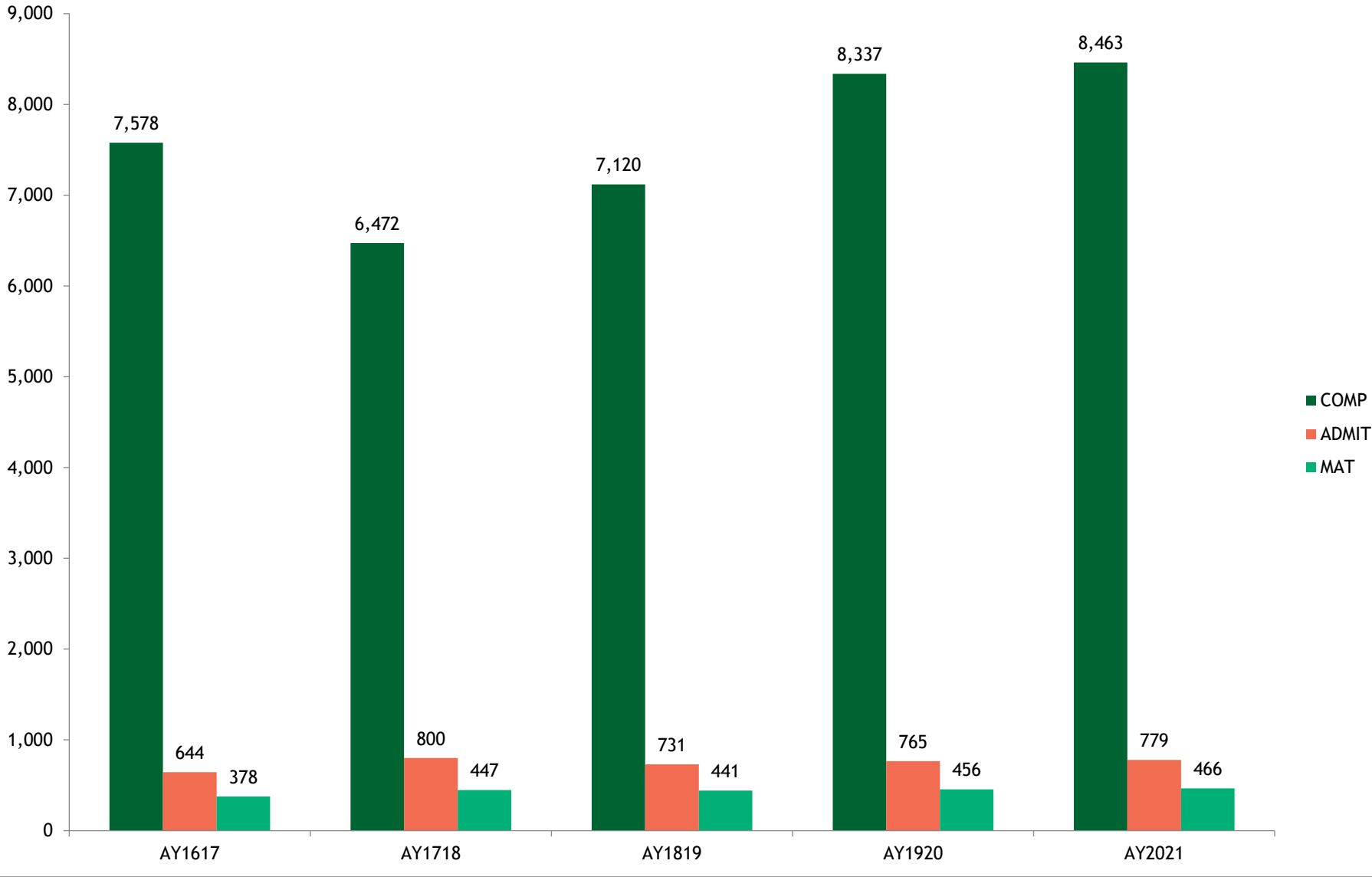

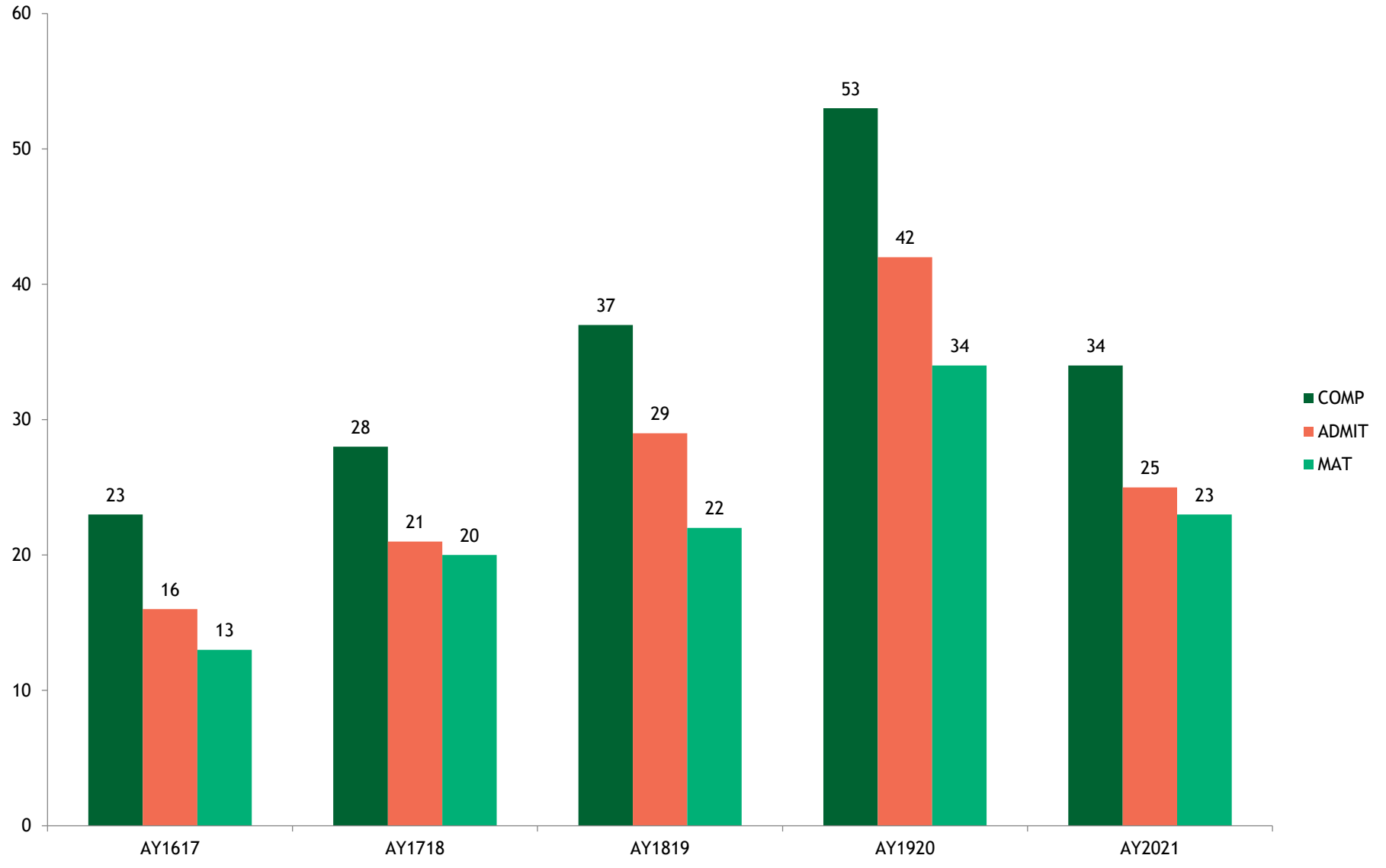

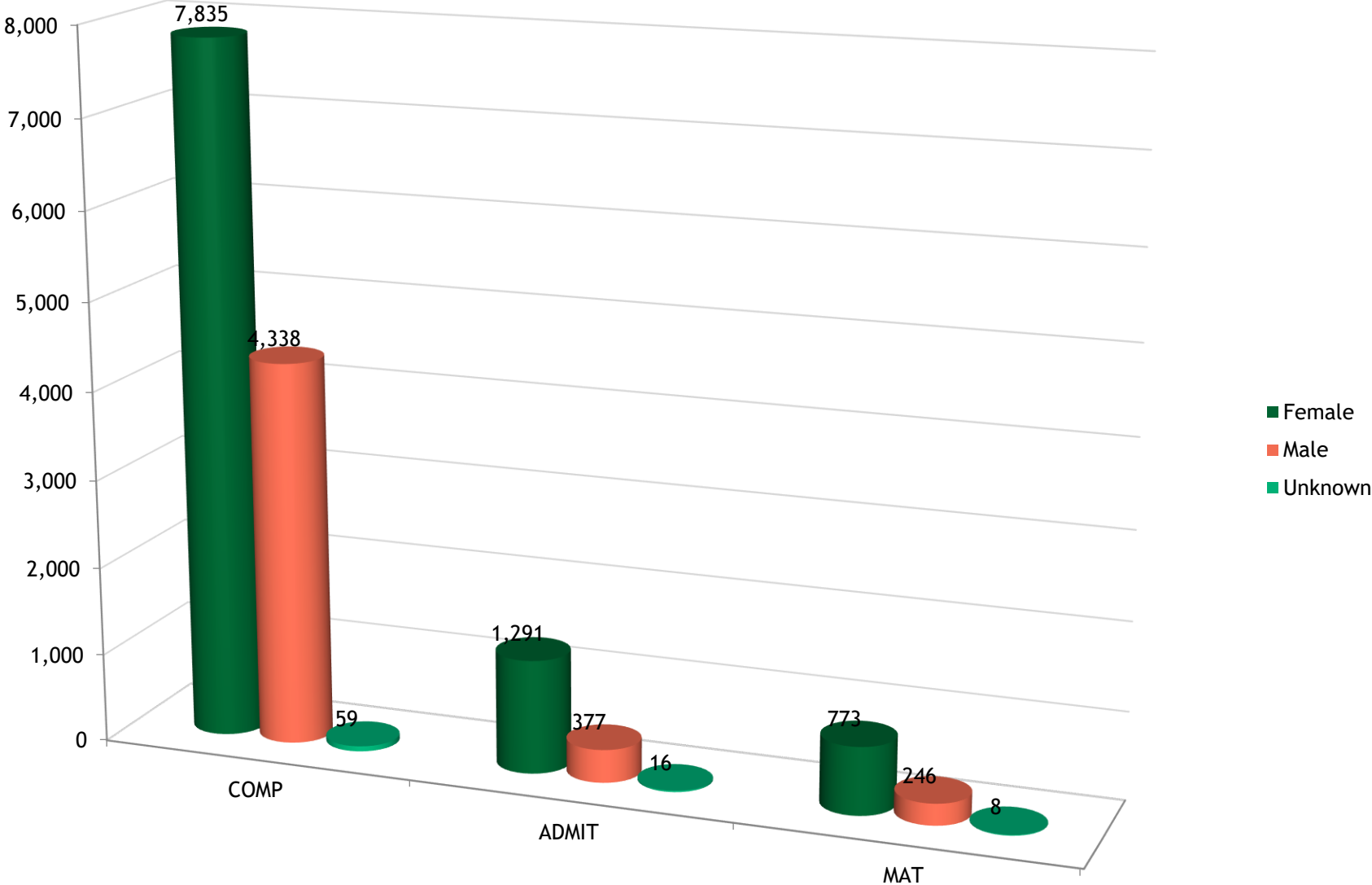

Rush University Admissions Data AY2021 Totals by Status & Race/Ethnicity

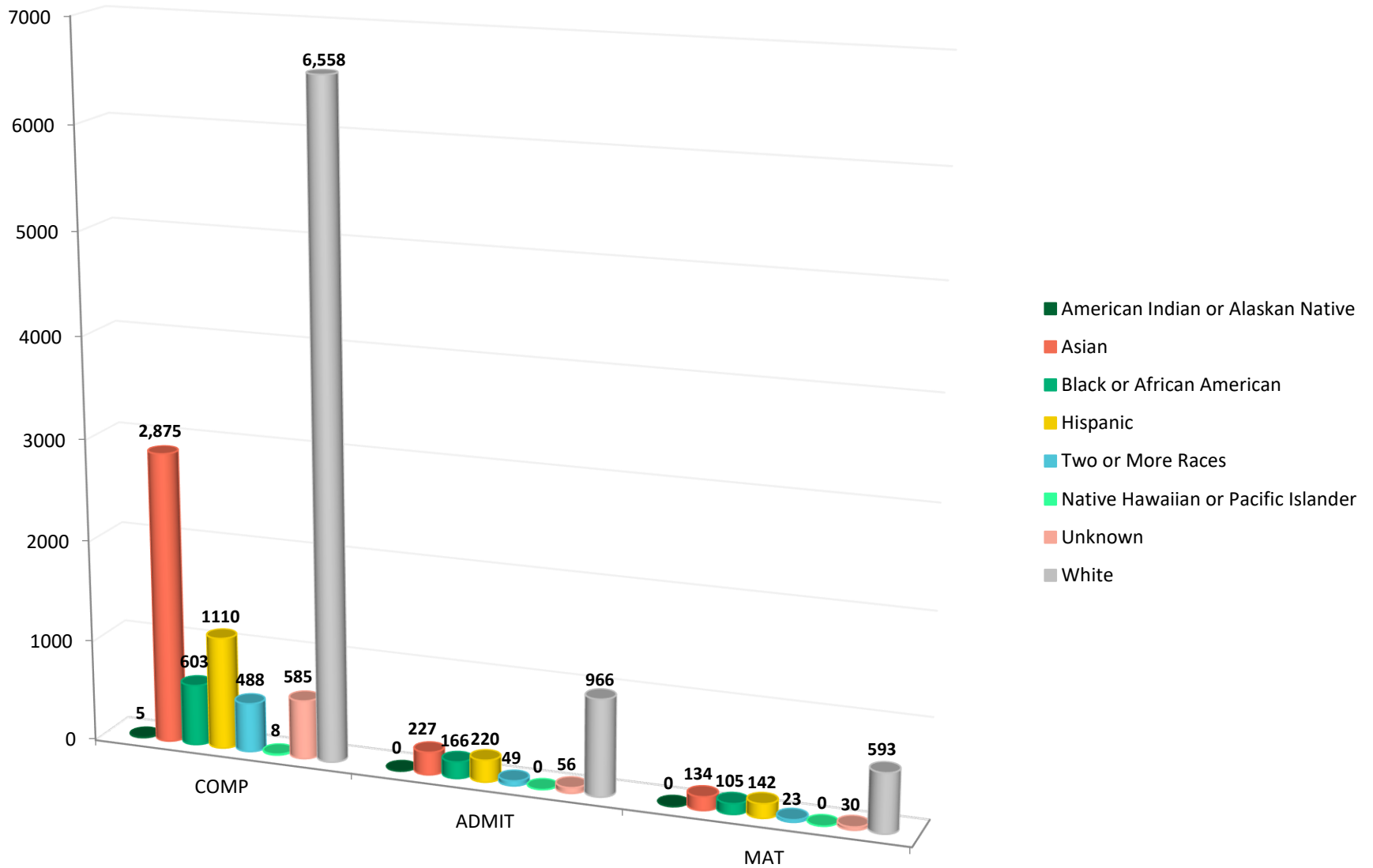

Rush University Admissions Data AY2021 Totals by Status & Minority

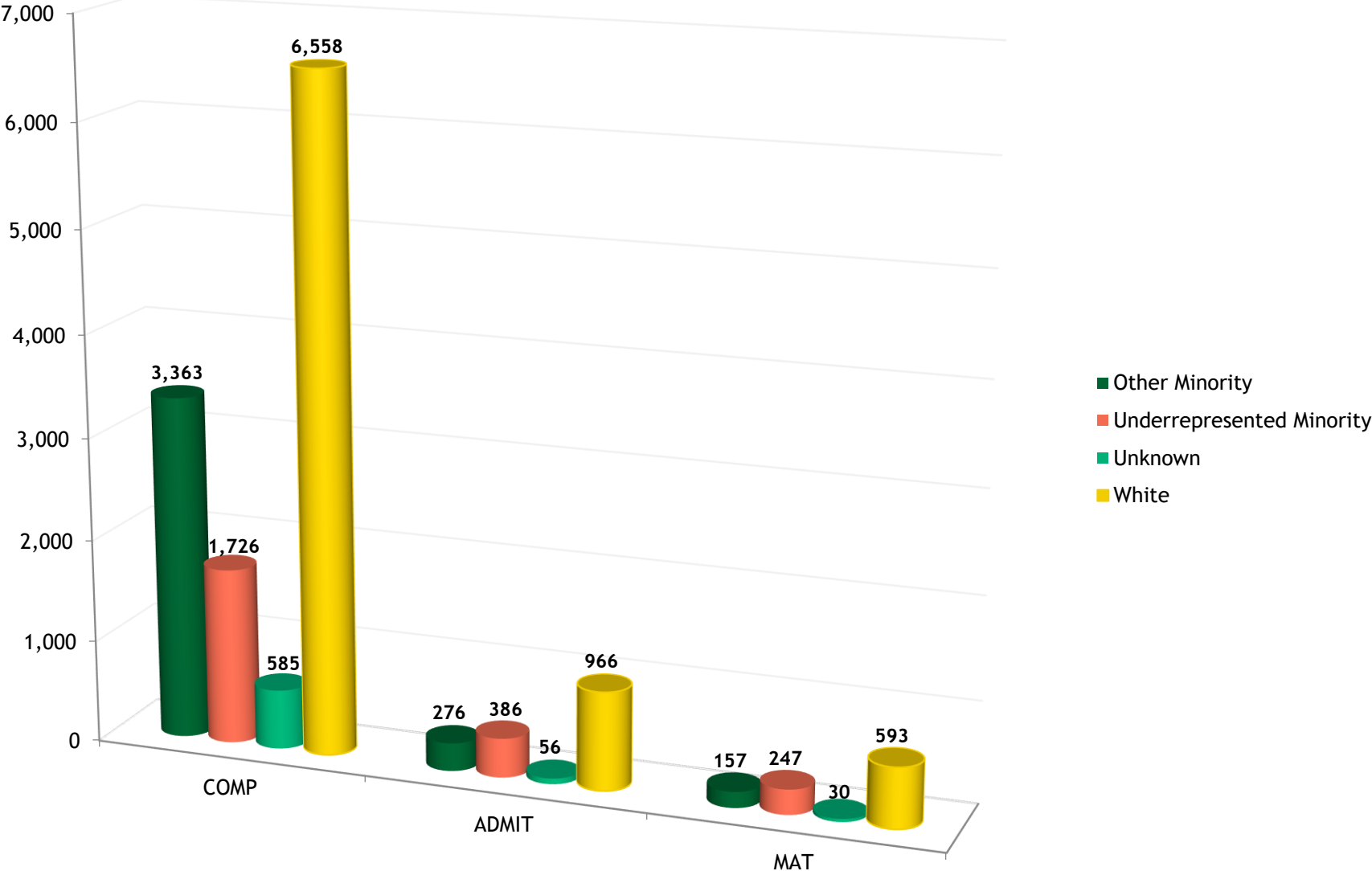

Rush University Admissions Data AY2021 Totals by Status & Age Group

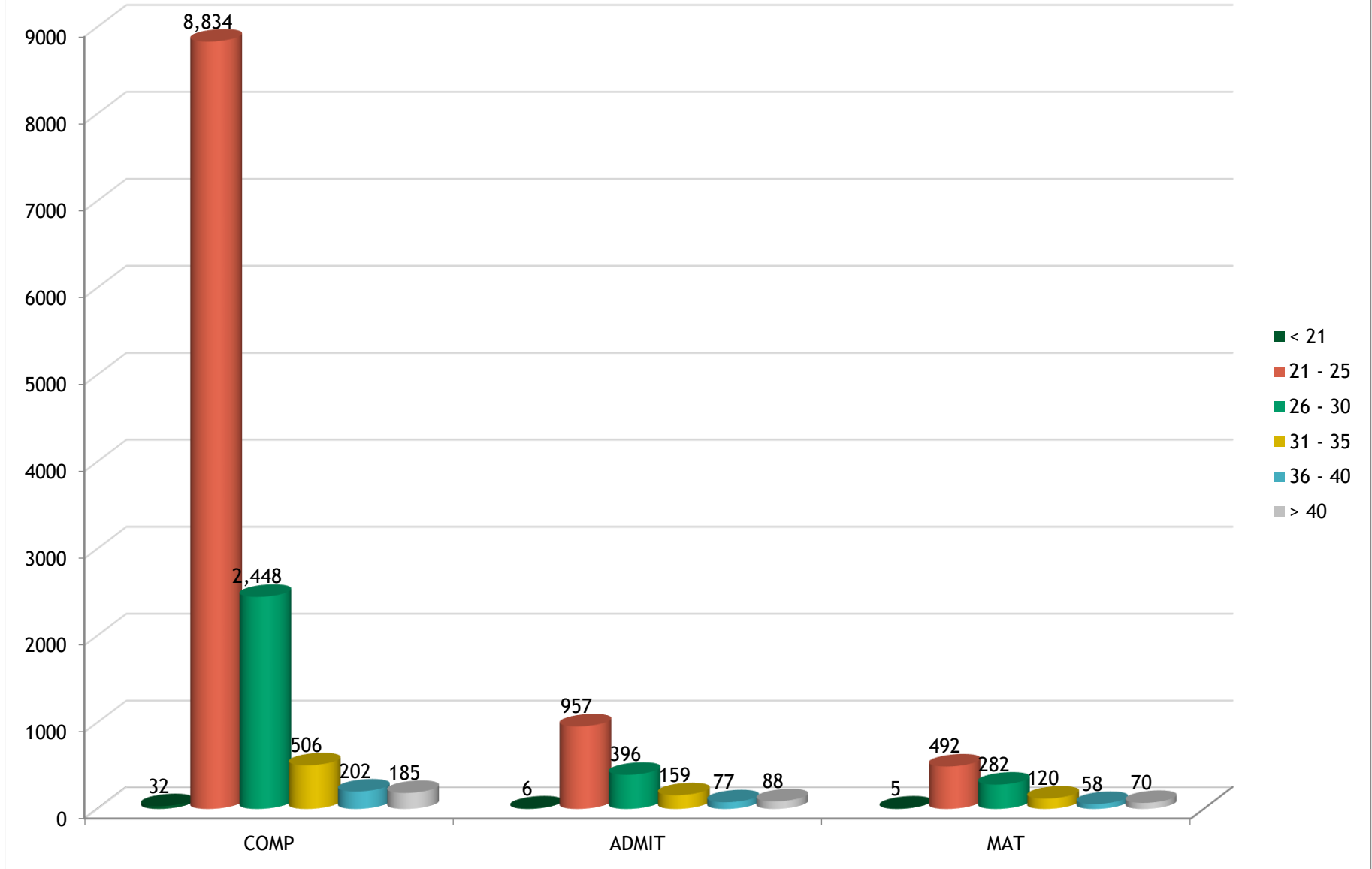

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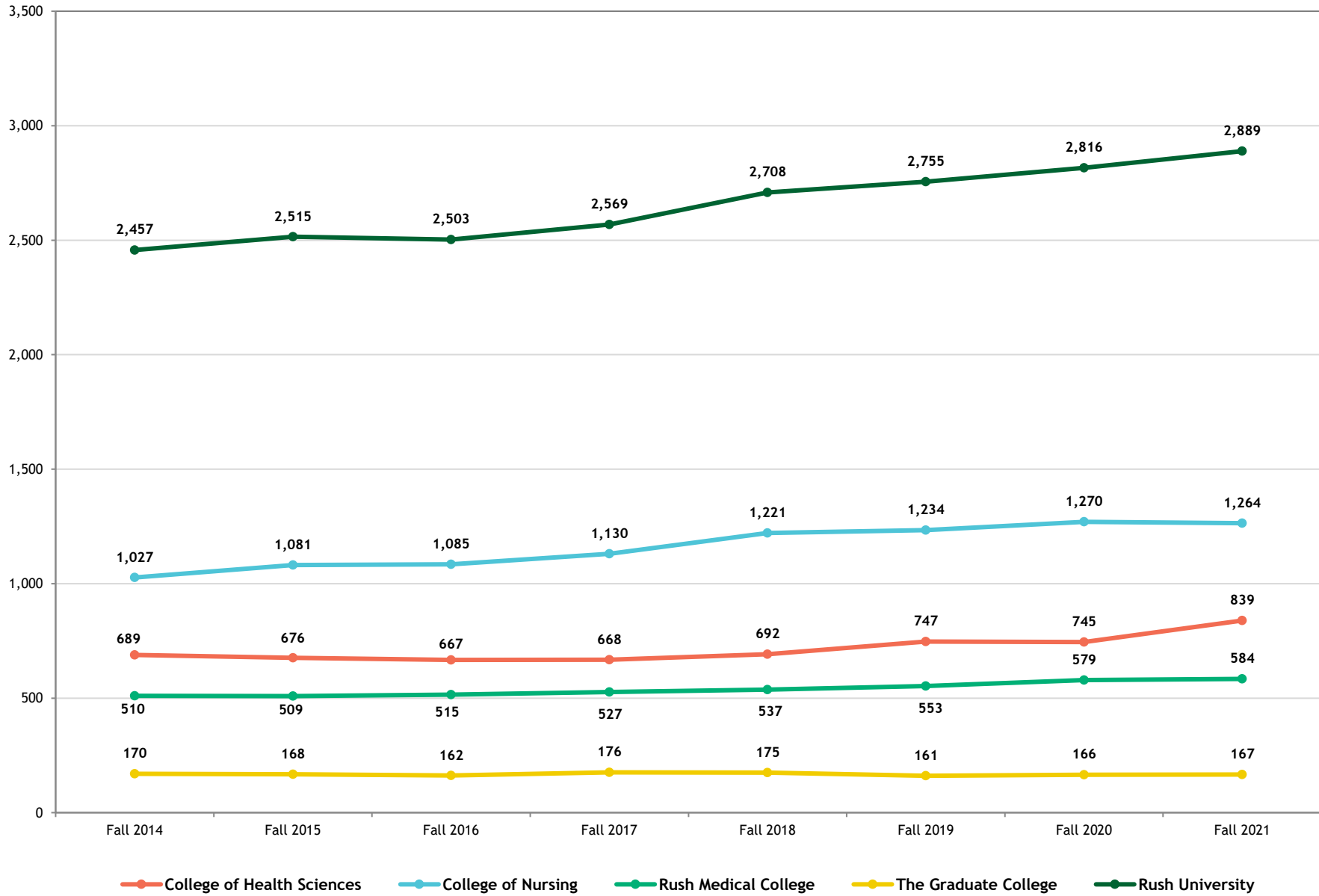

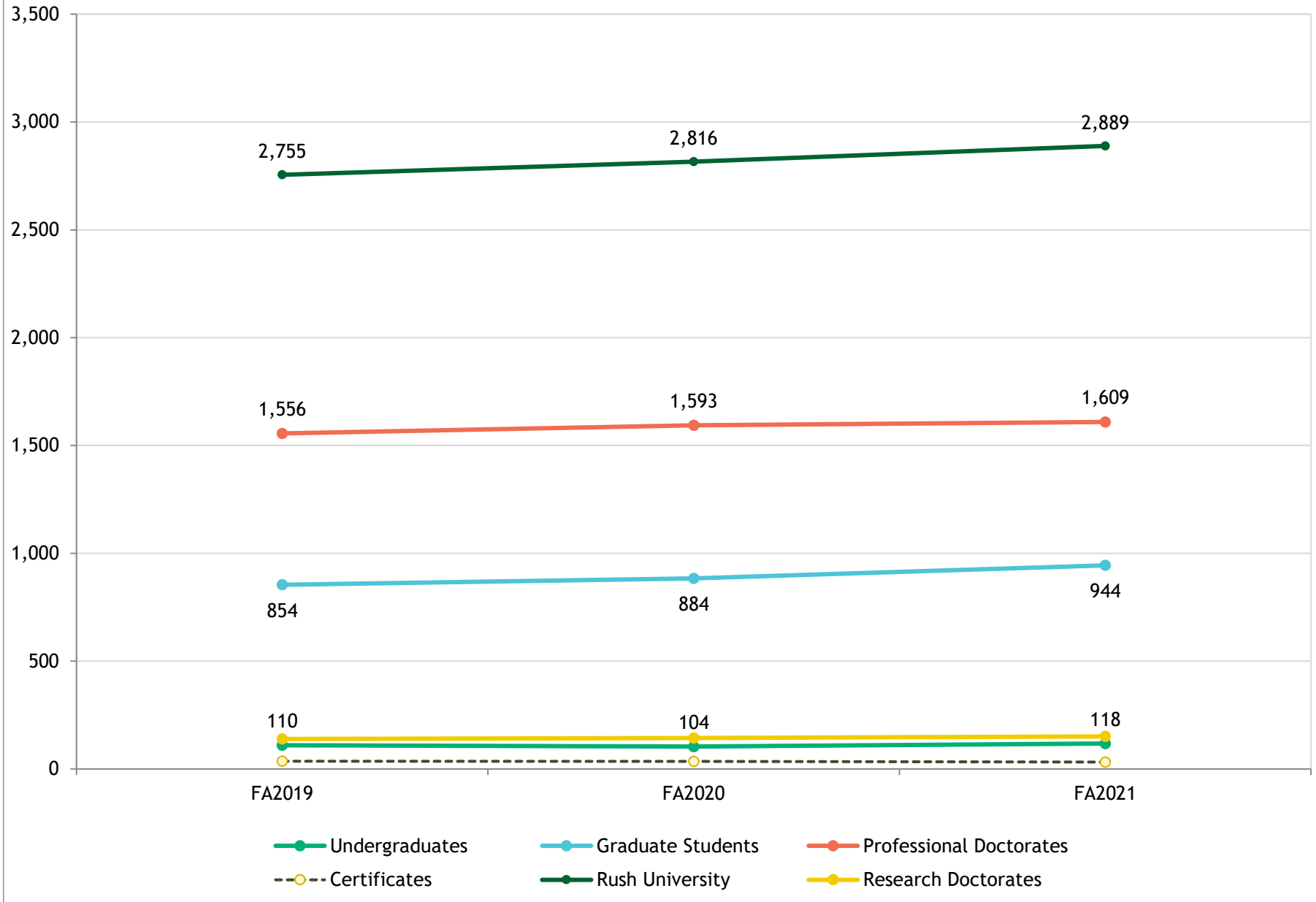

Headcount Enrollment by Degree Level, Fall 2019-Fall 2021



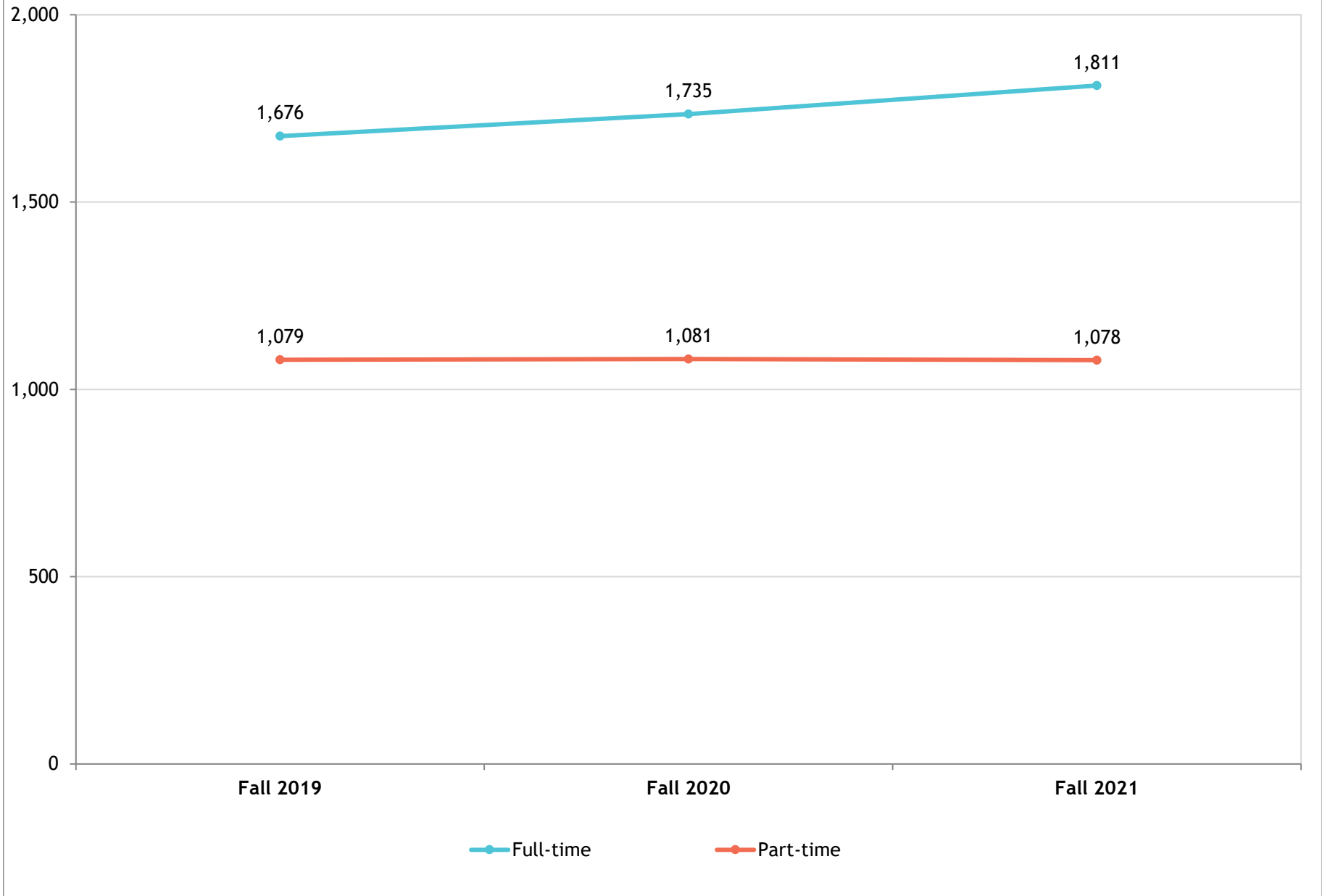

Headcount Enrollment by Full-time/Part-time, Fall 2019-Fall 2021



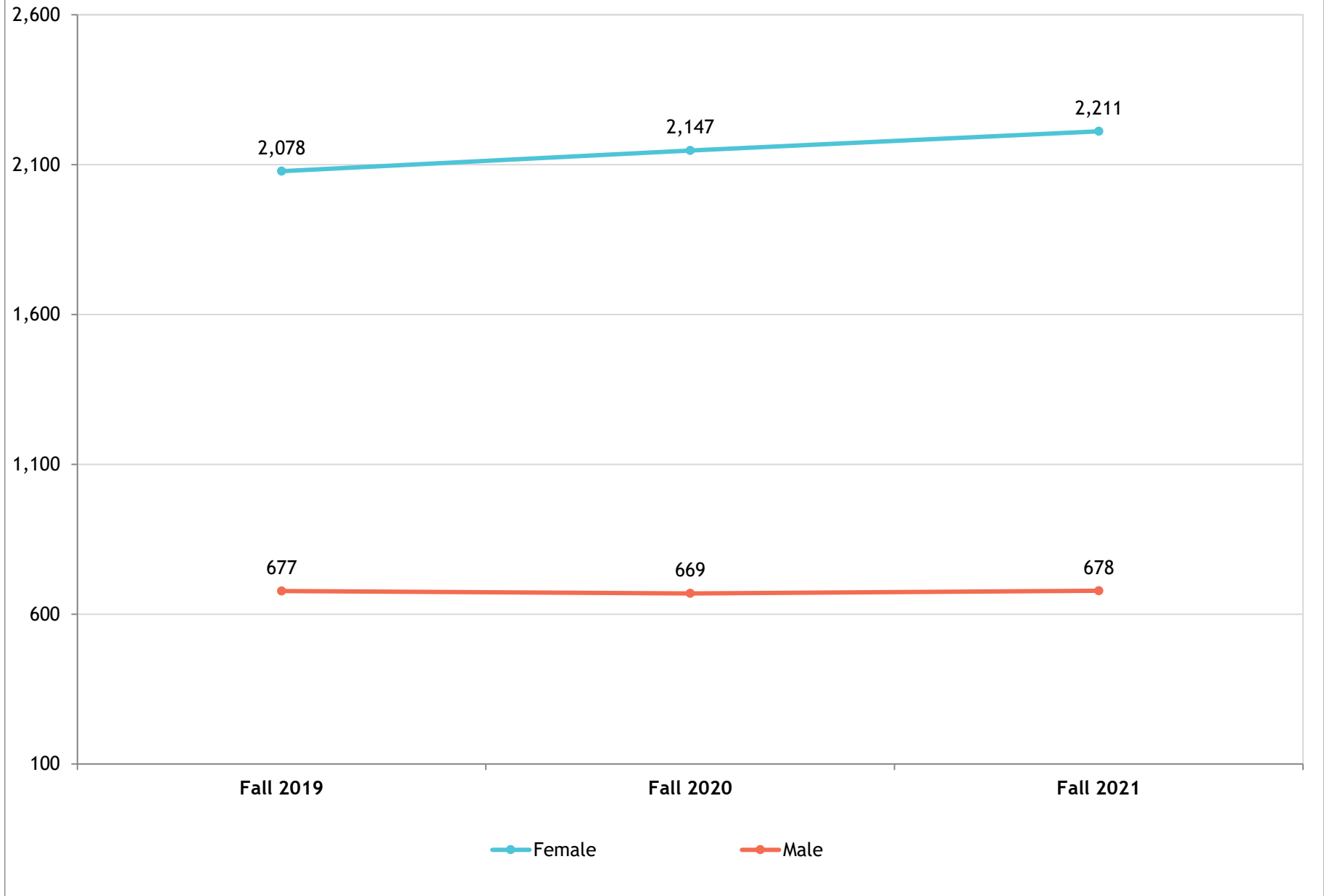

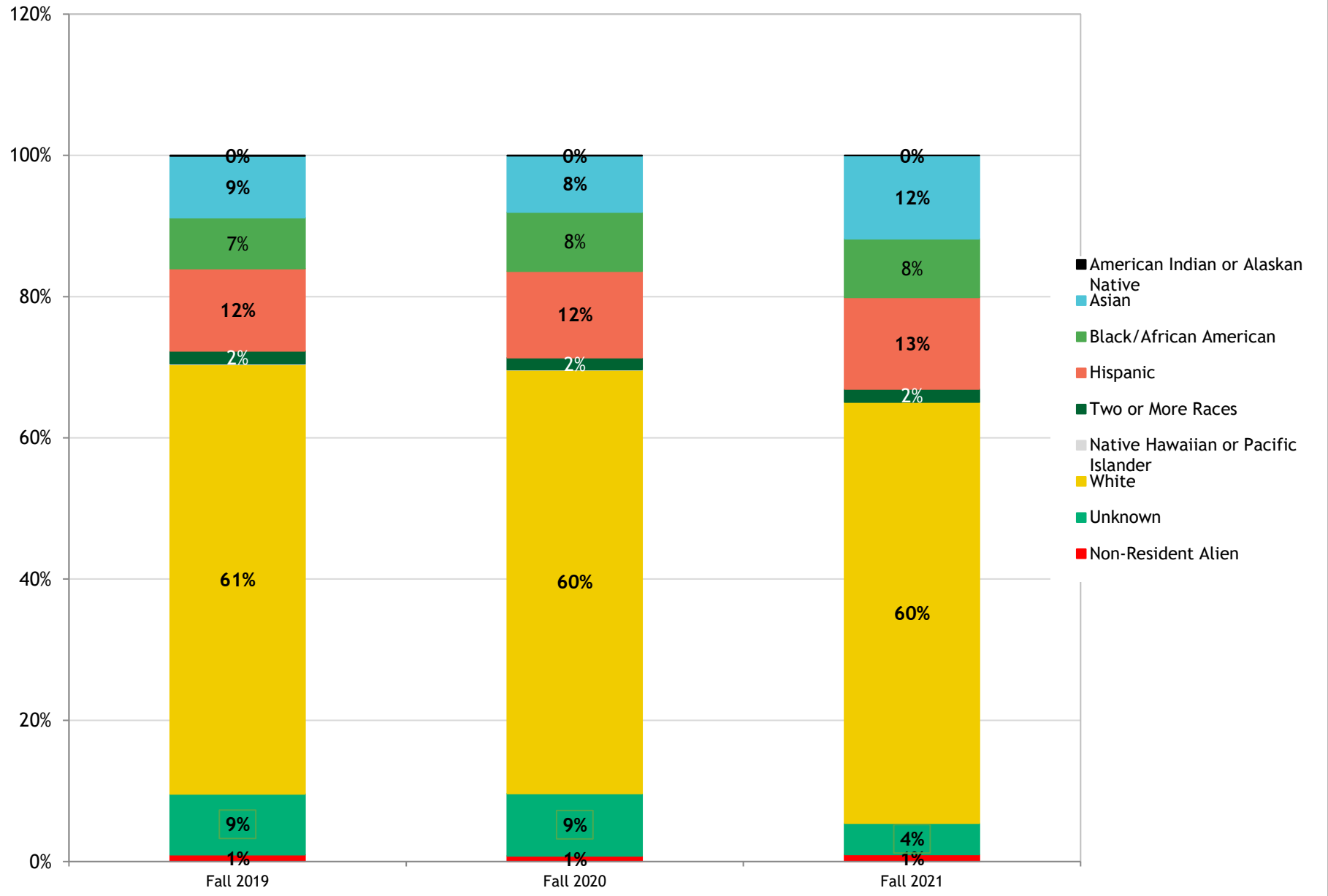

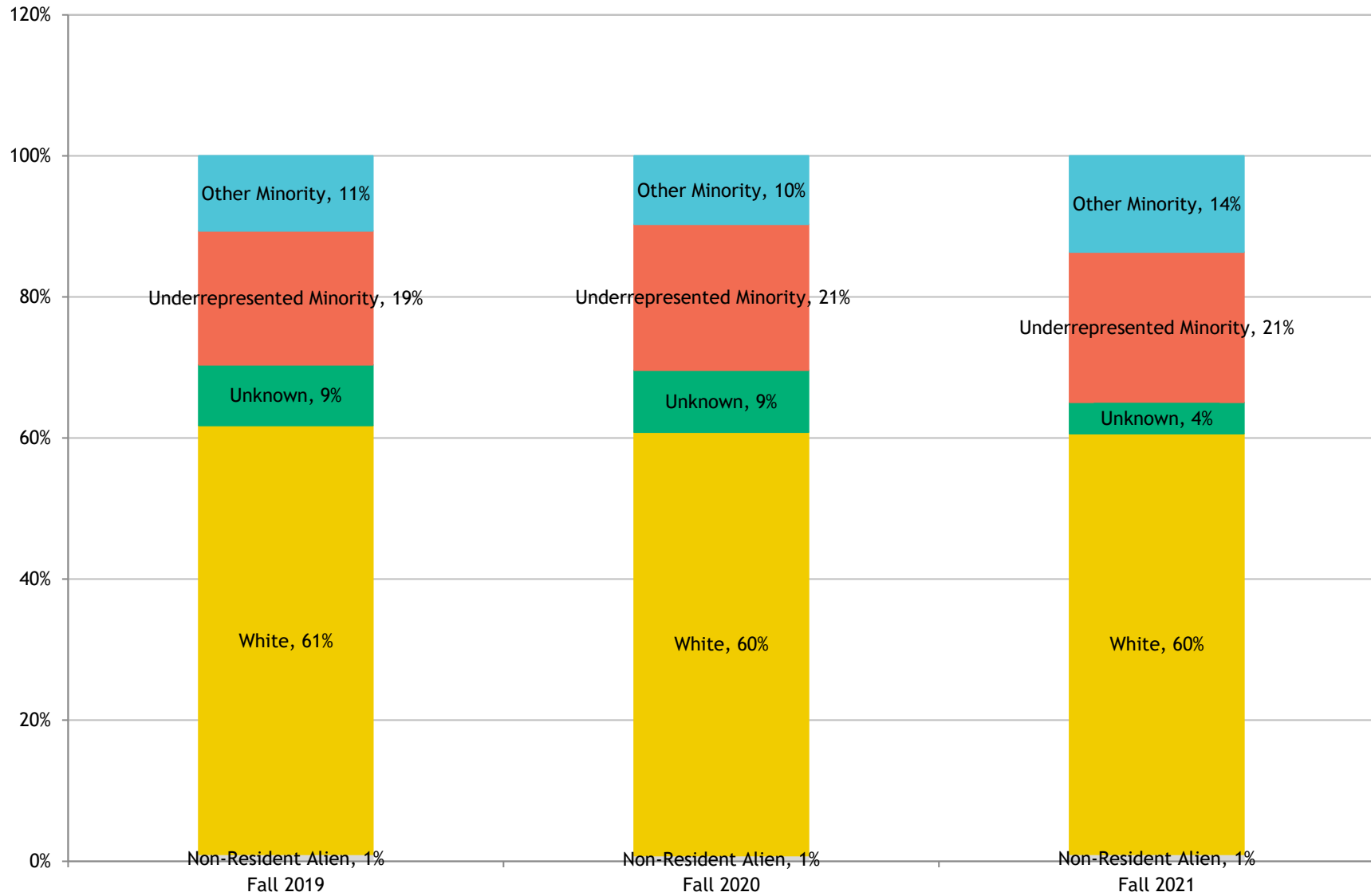

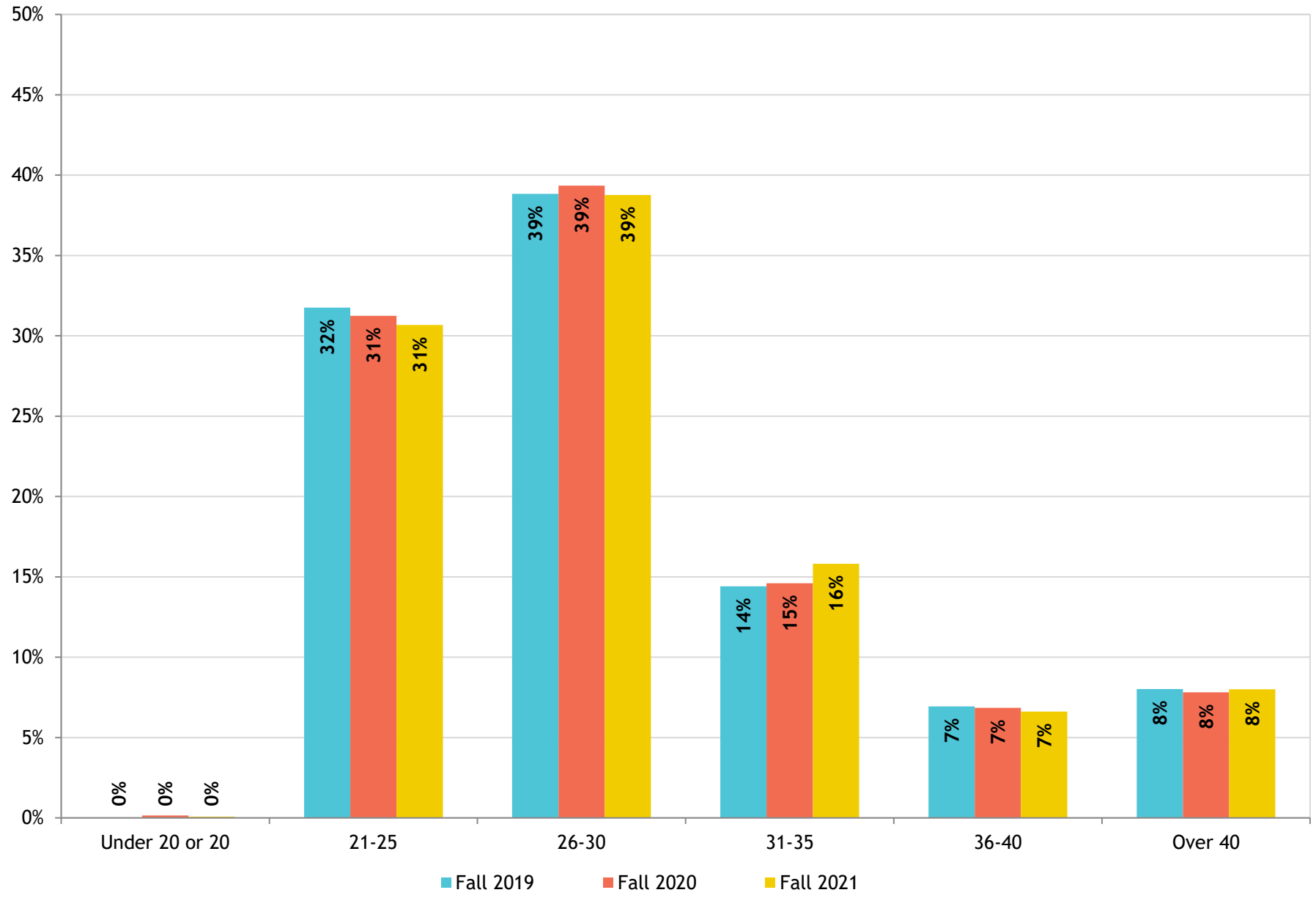

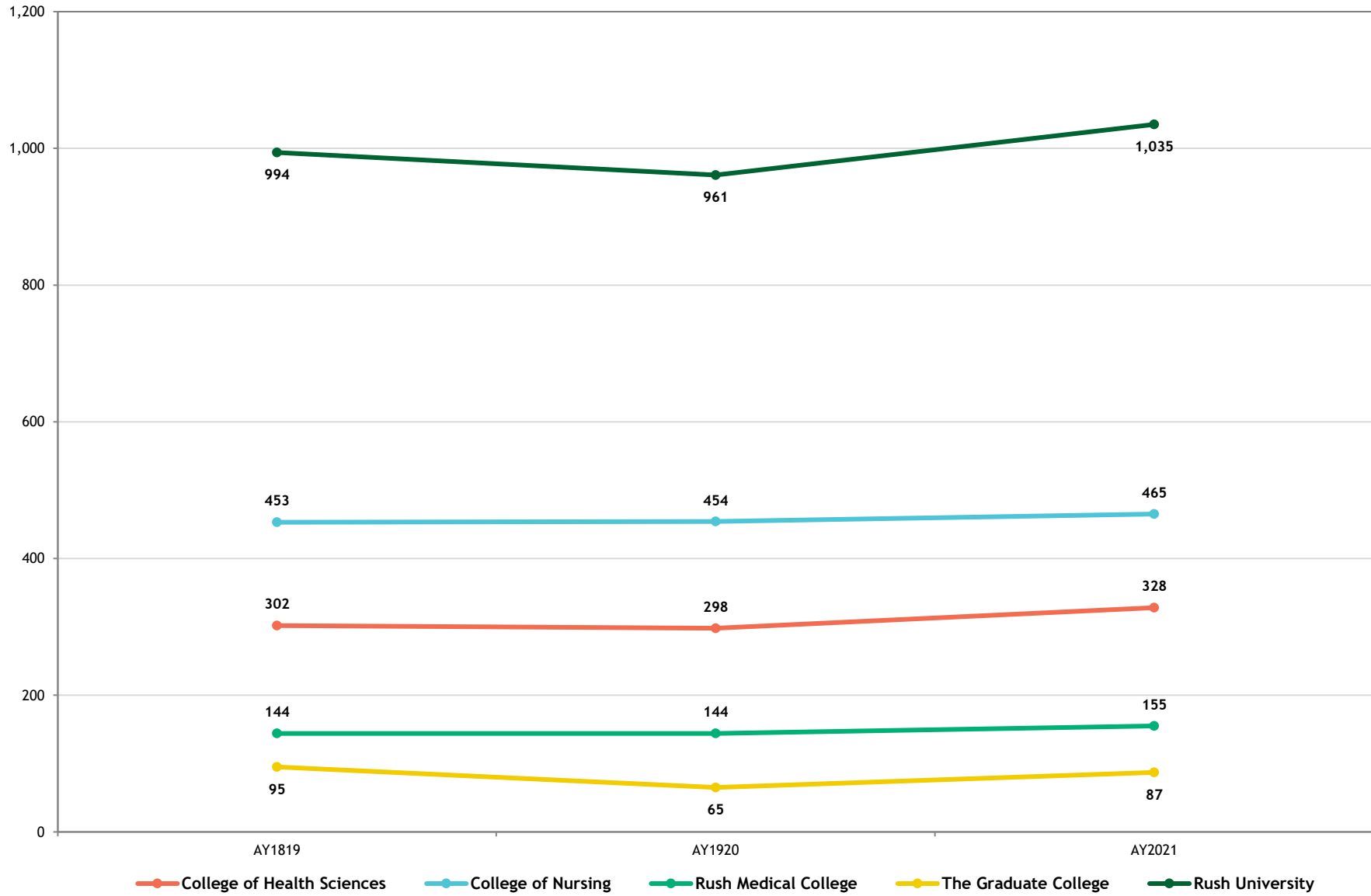

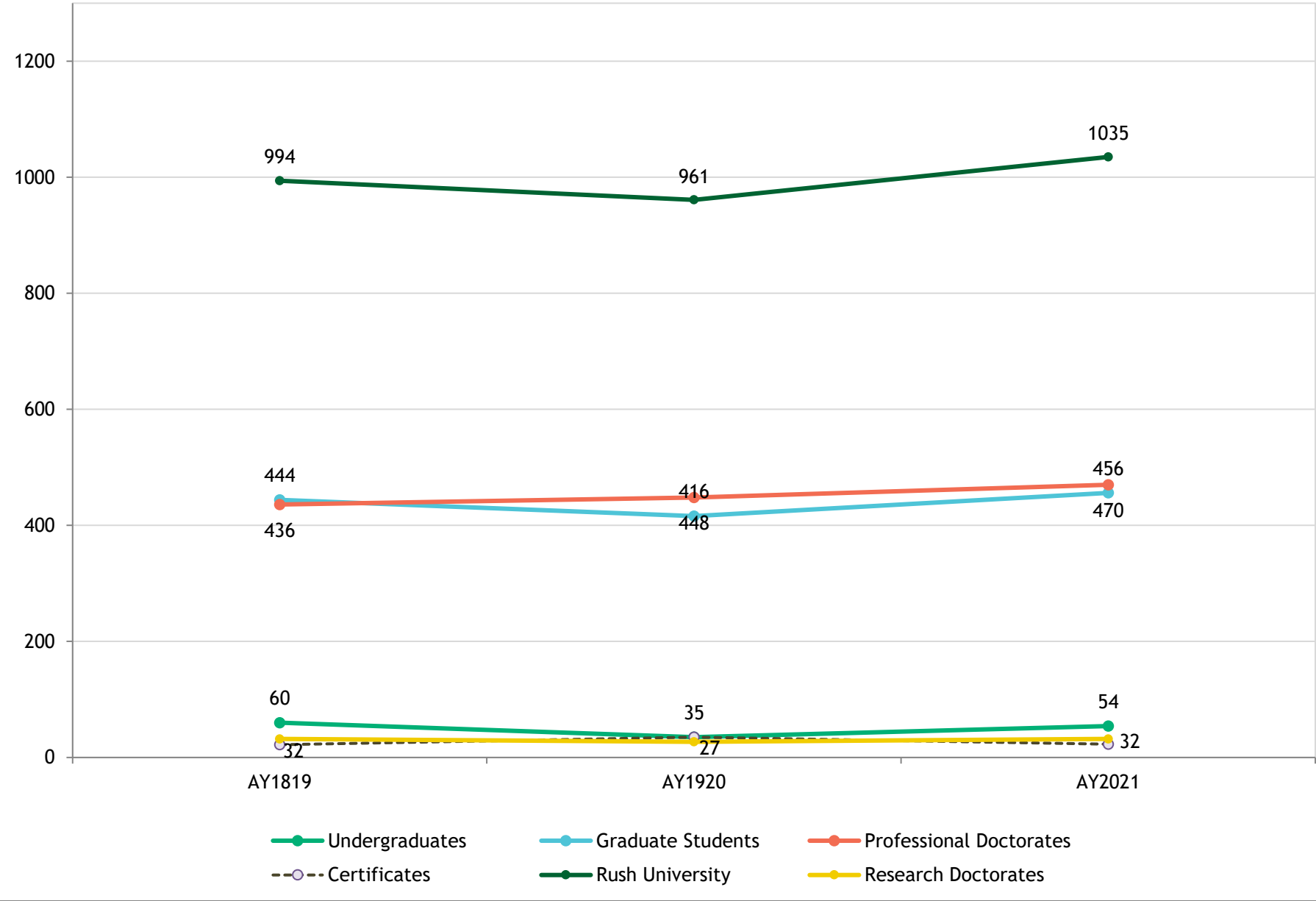

New Students Enrollment by Degree Level, AY 2018-19 to AY 2020-21



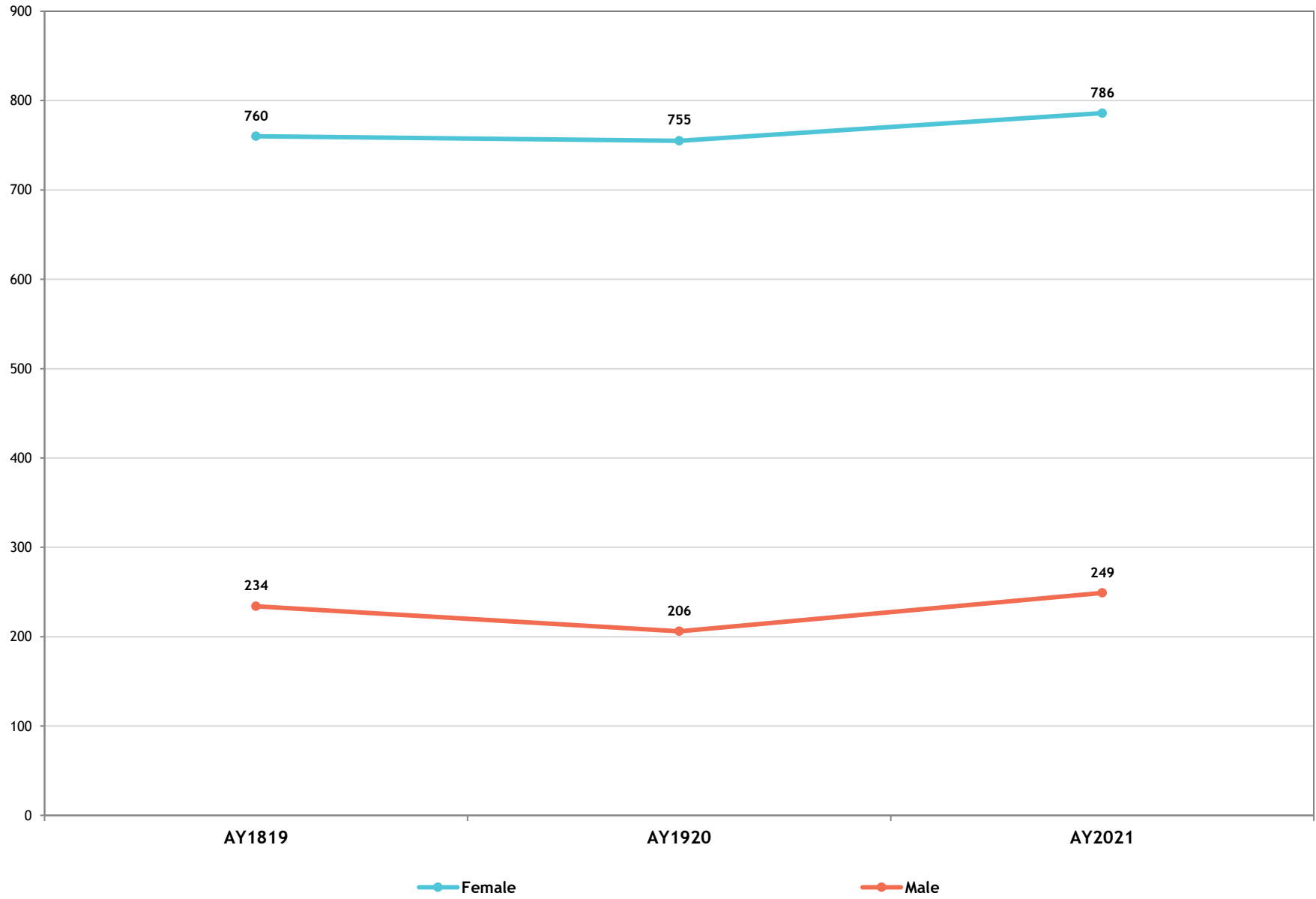

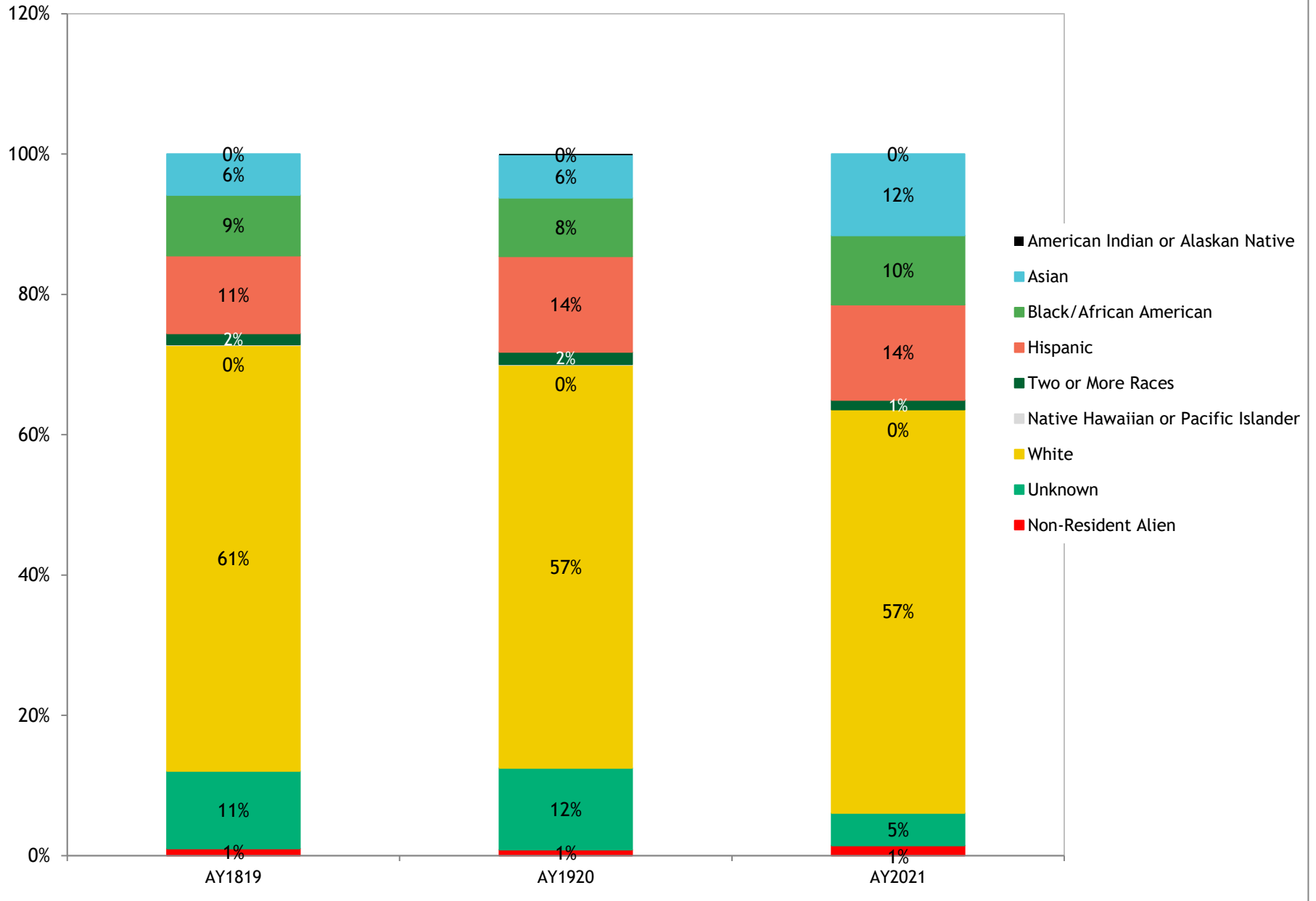

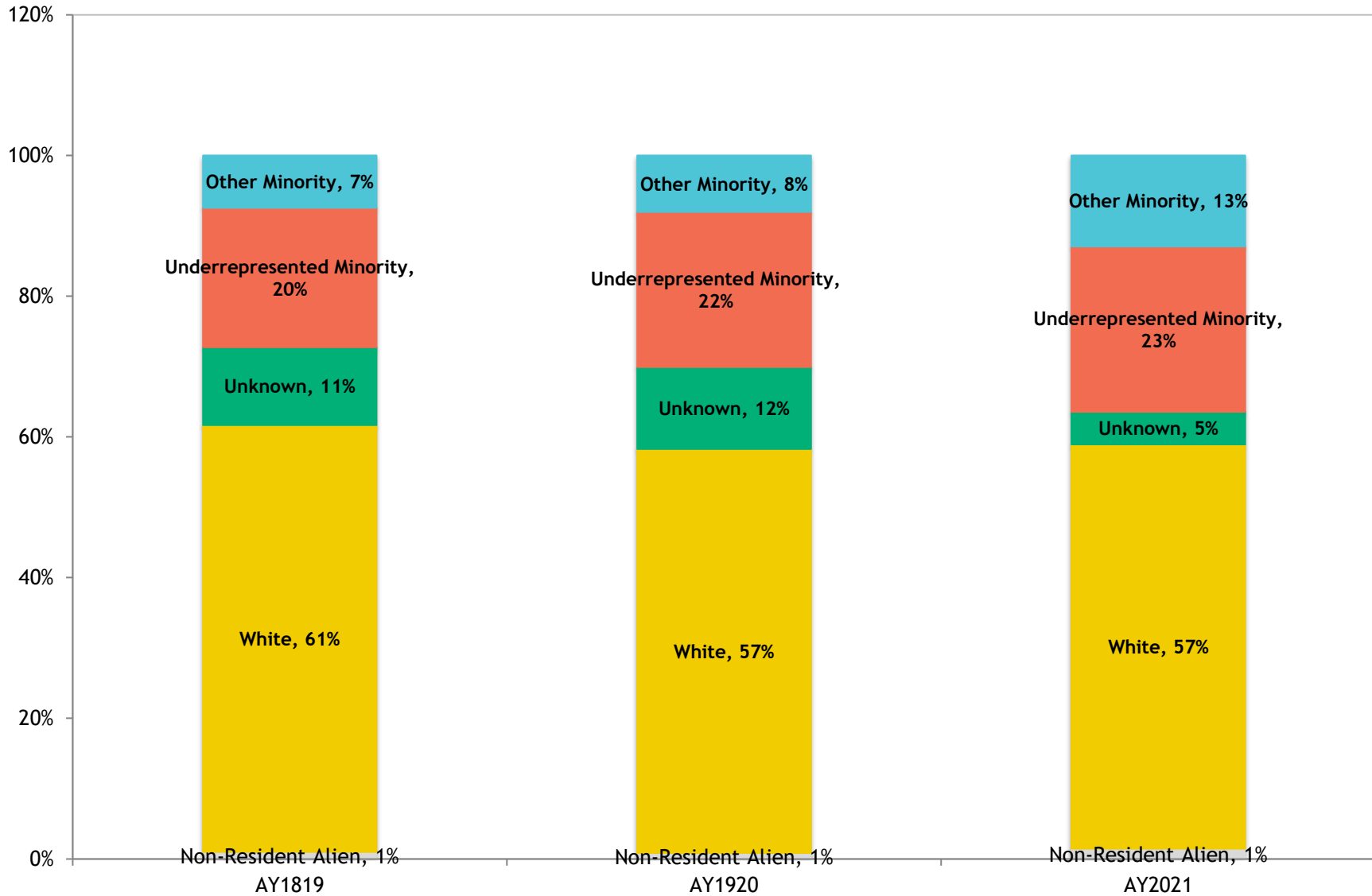

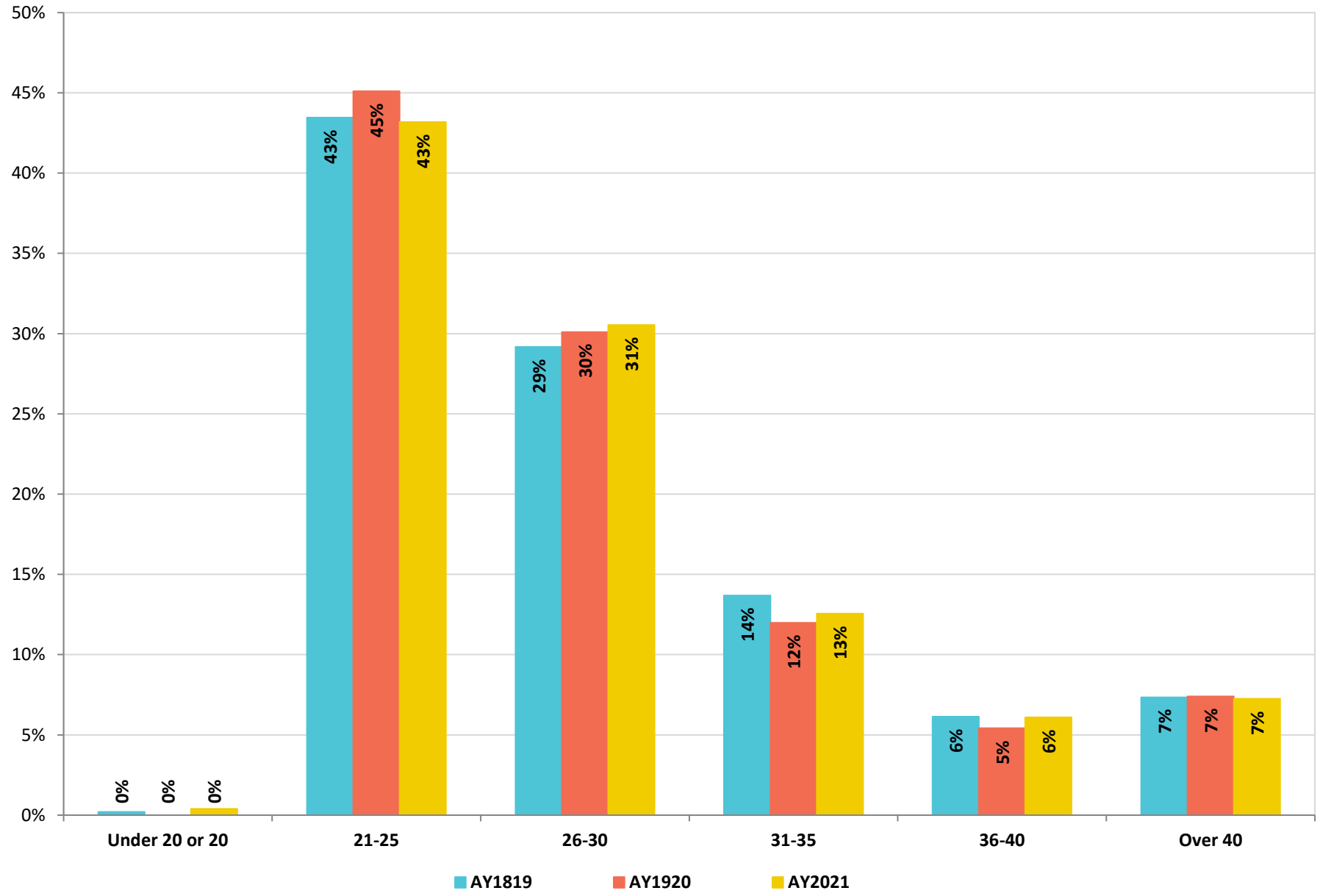

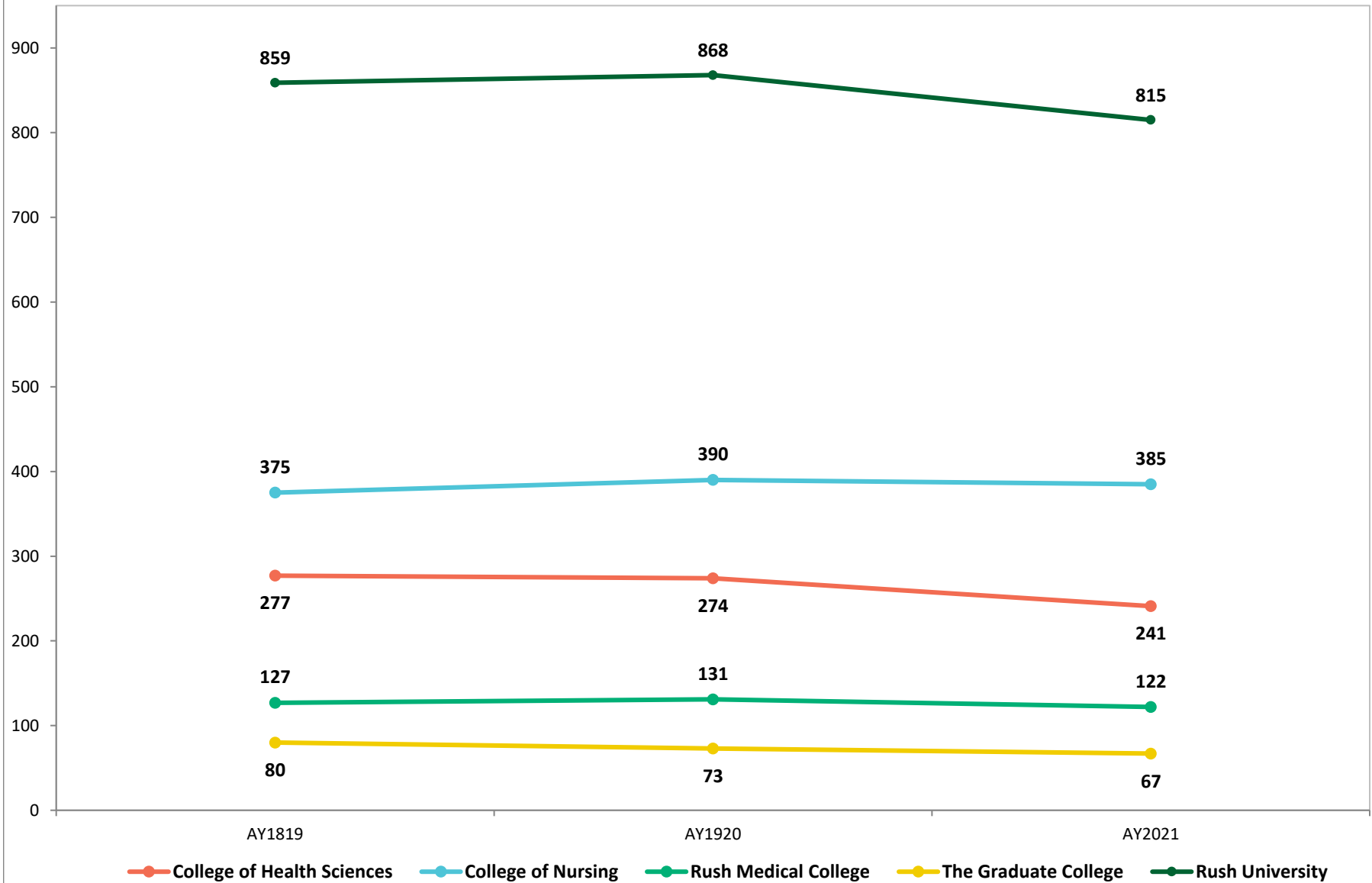

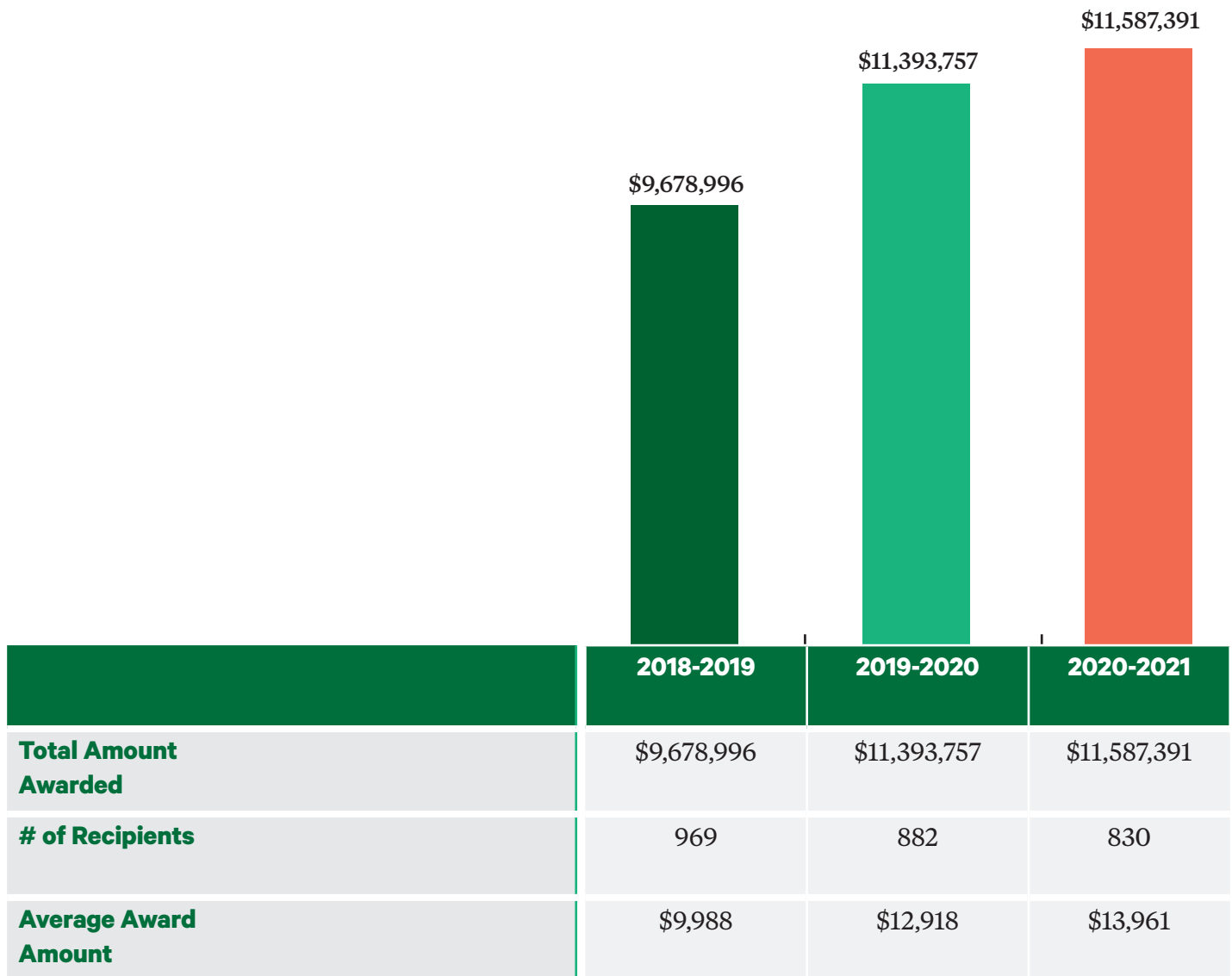

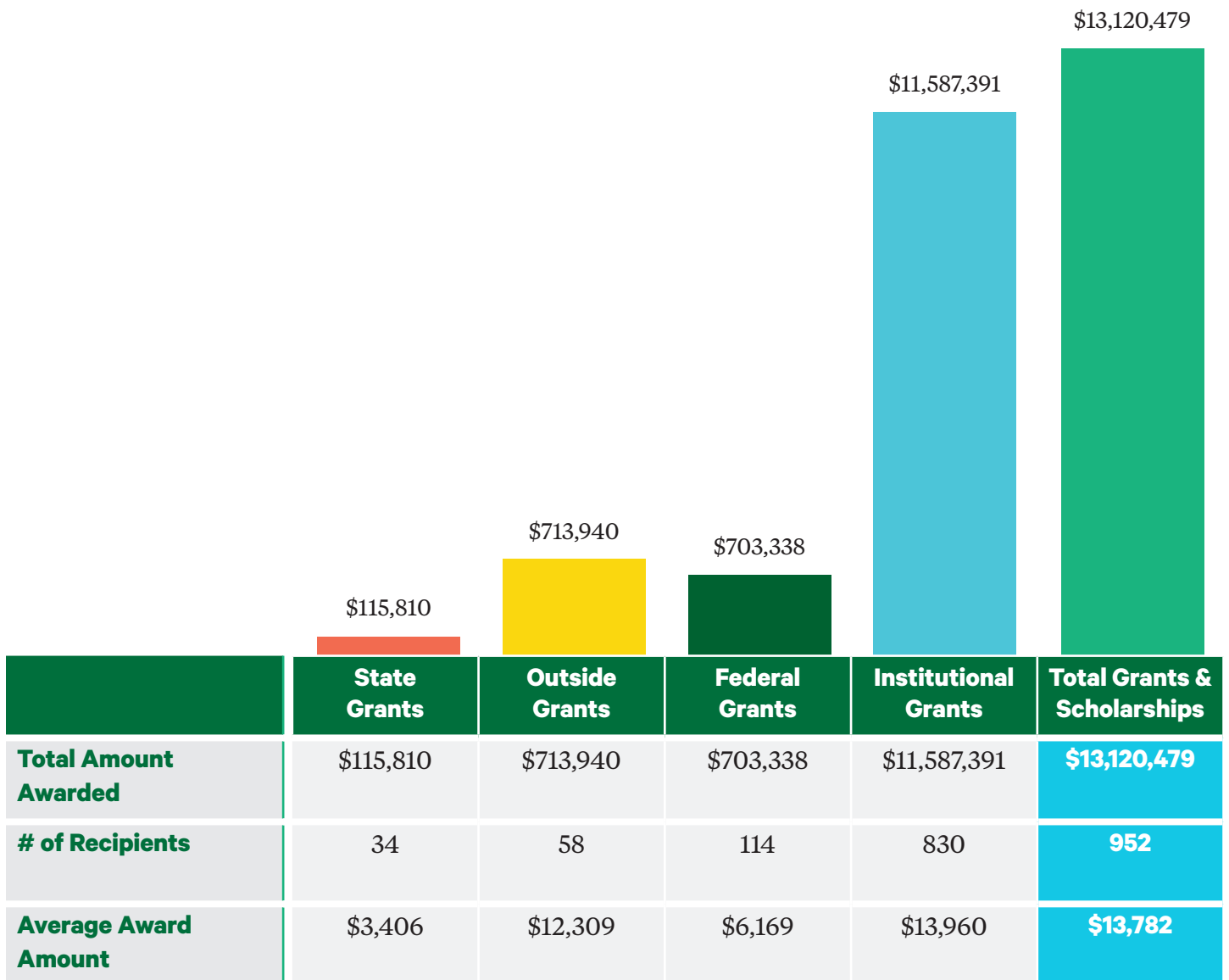

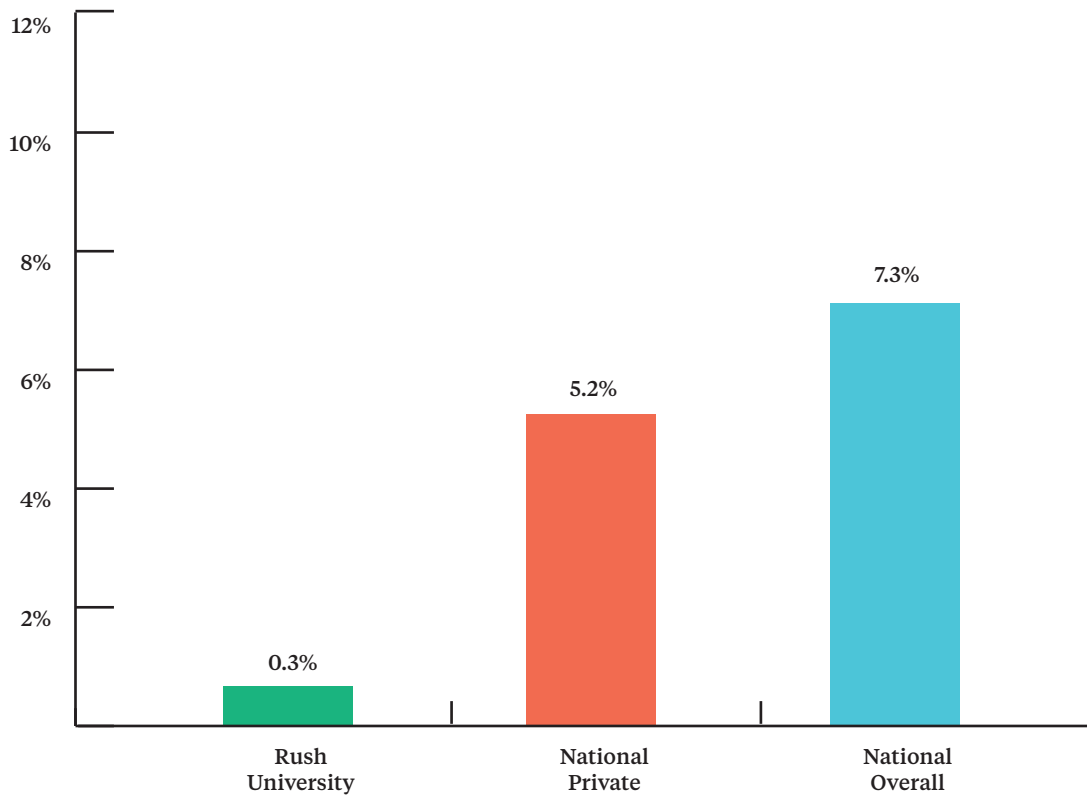

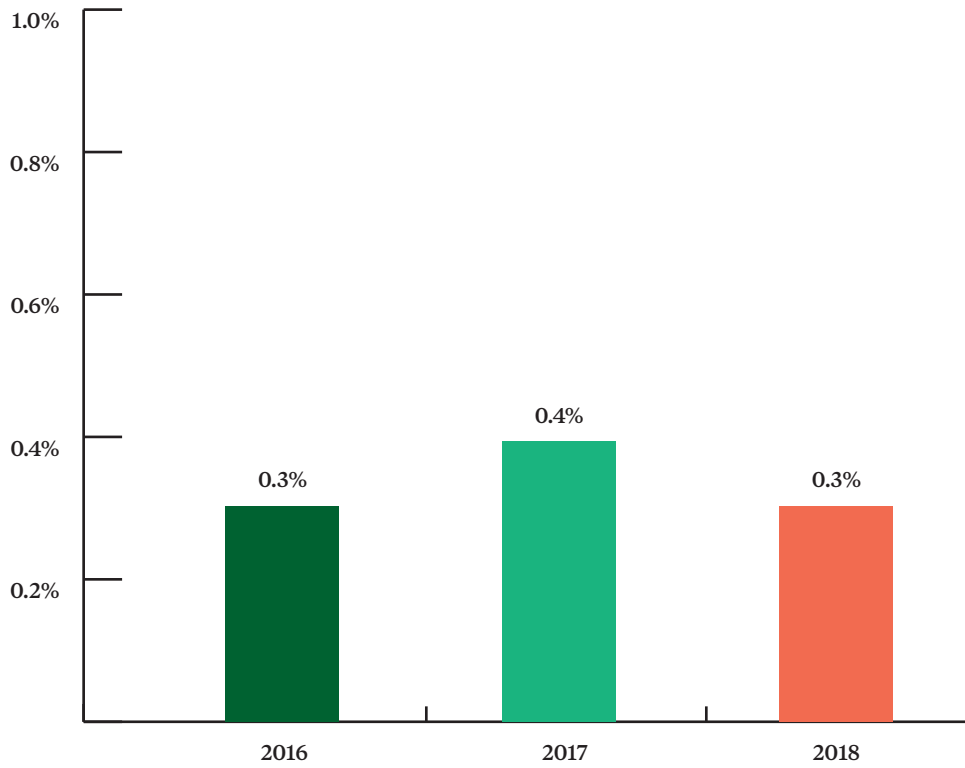

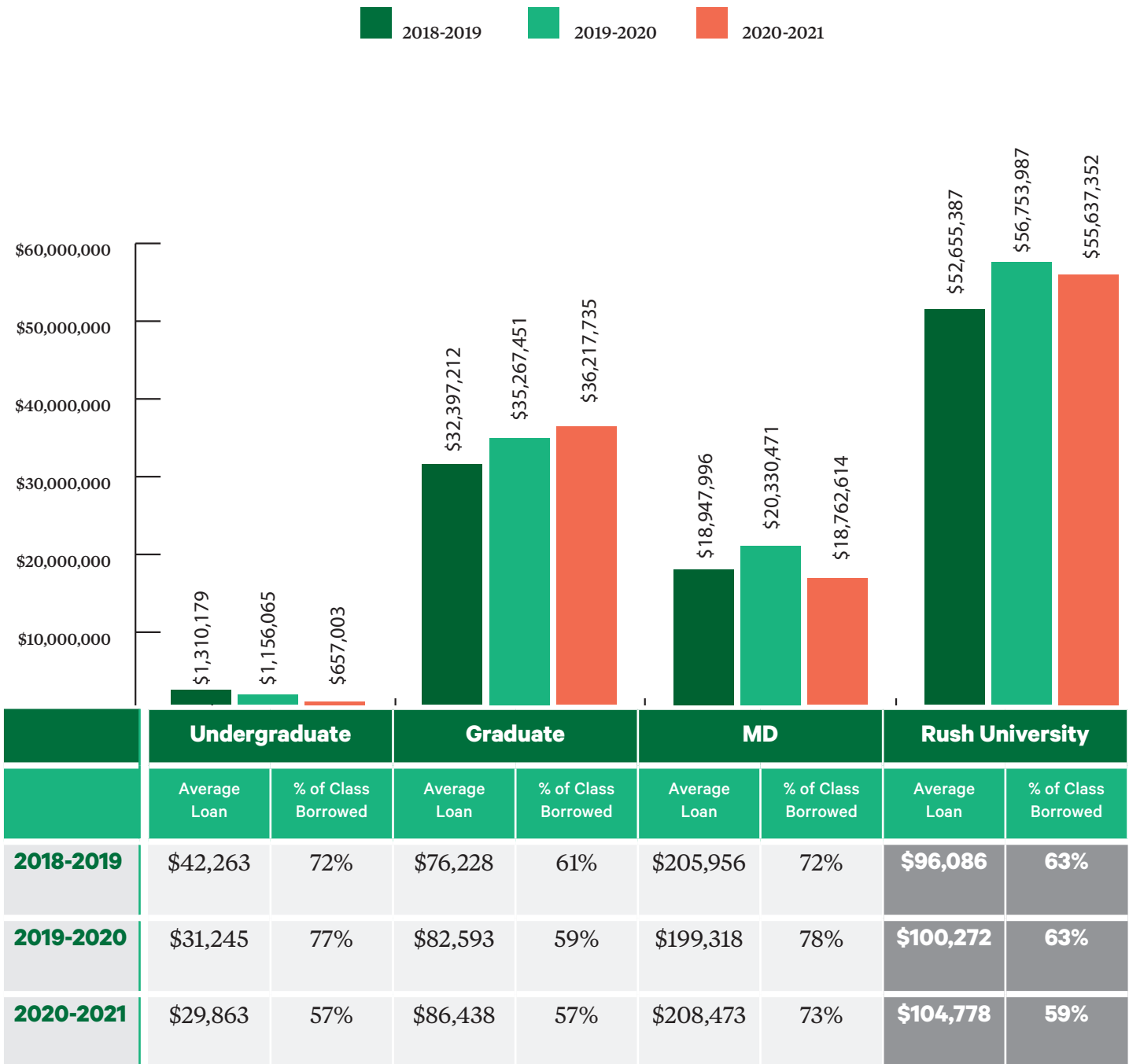

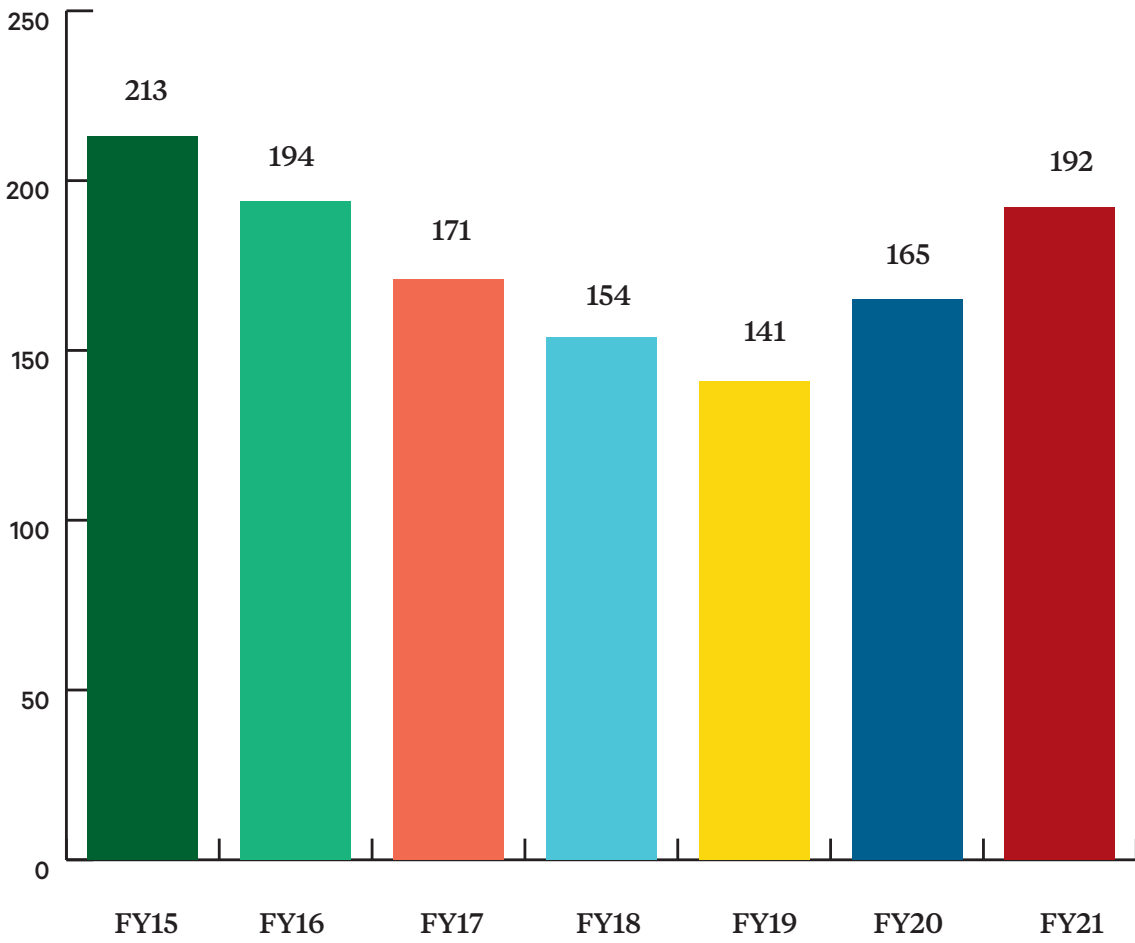

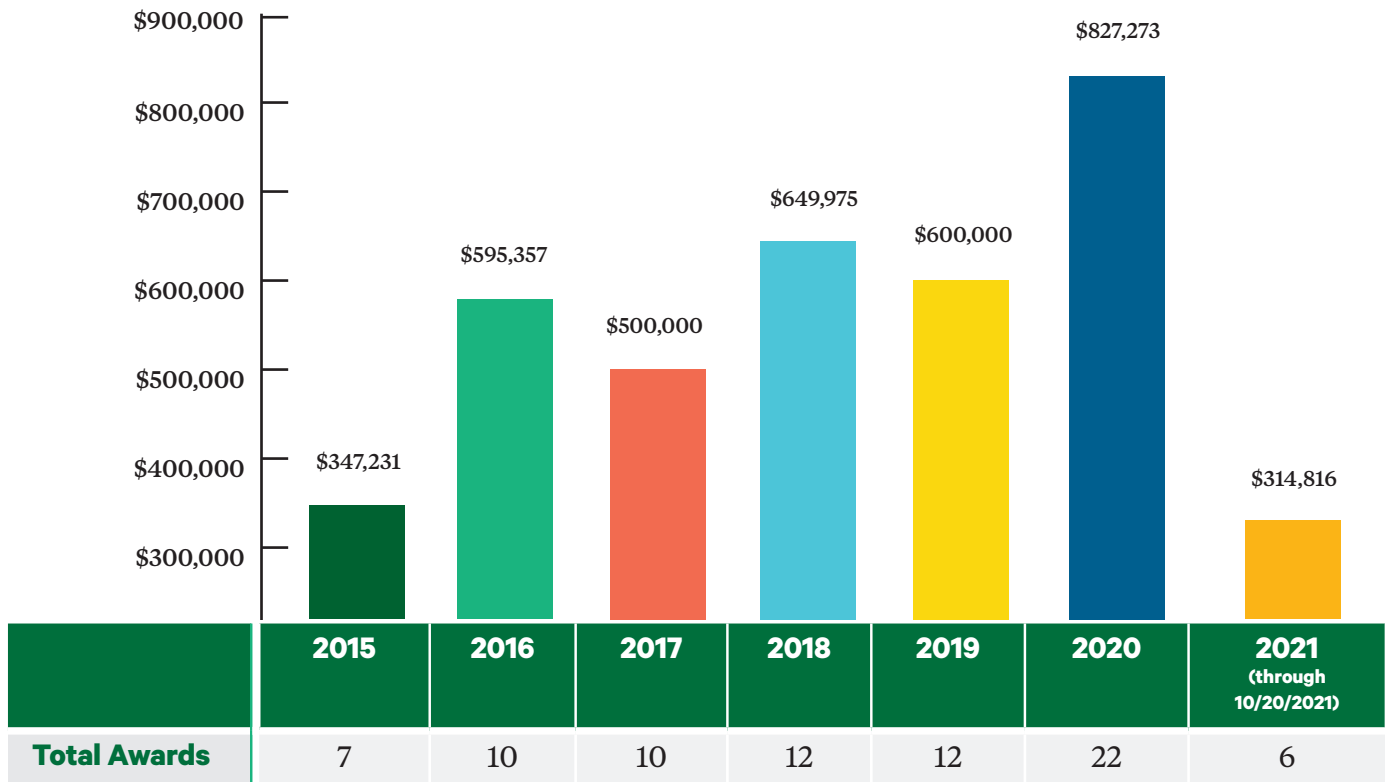

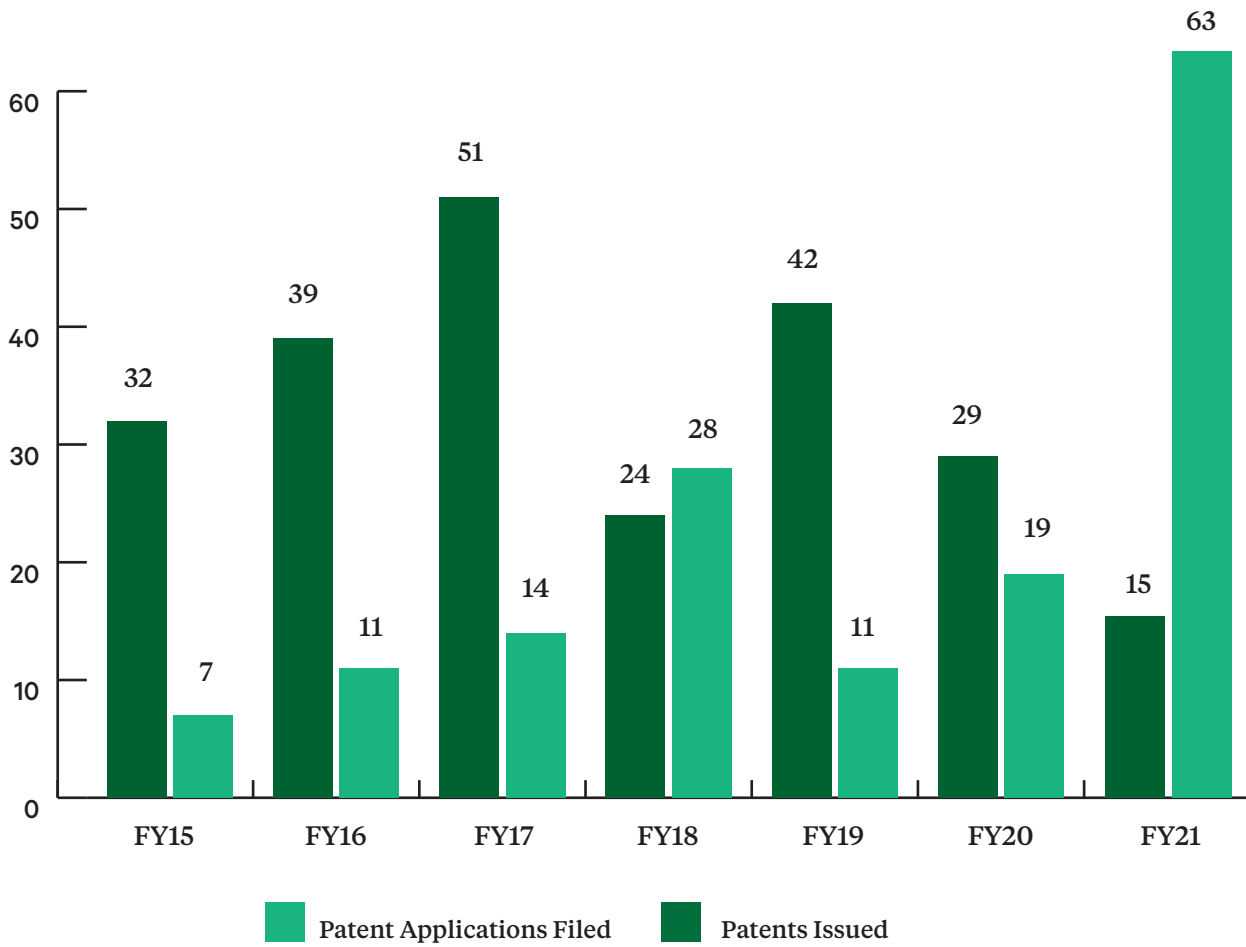
12.2 Pilots Grants Award Amount



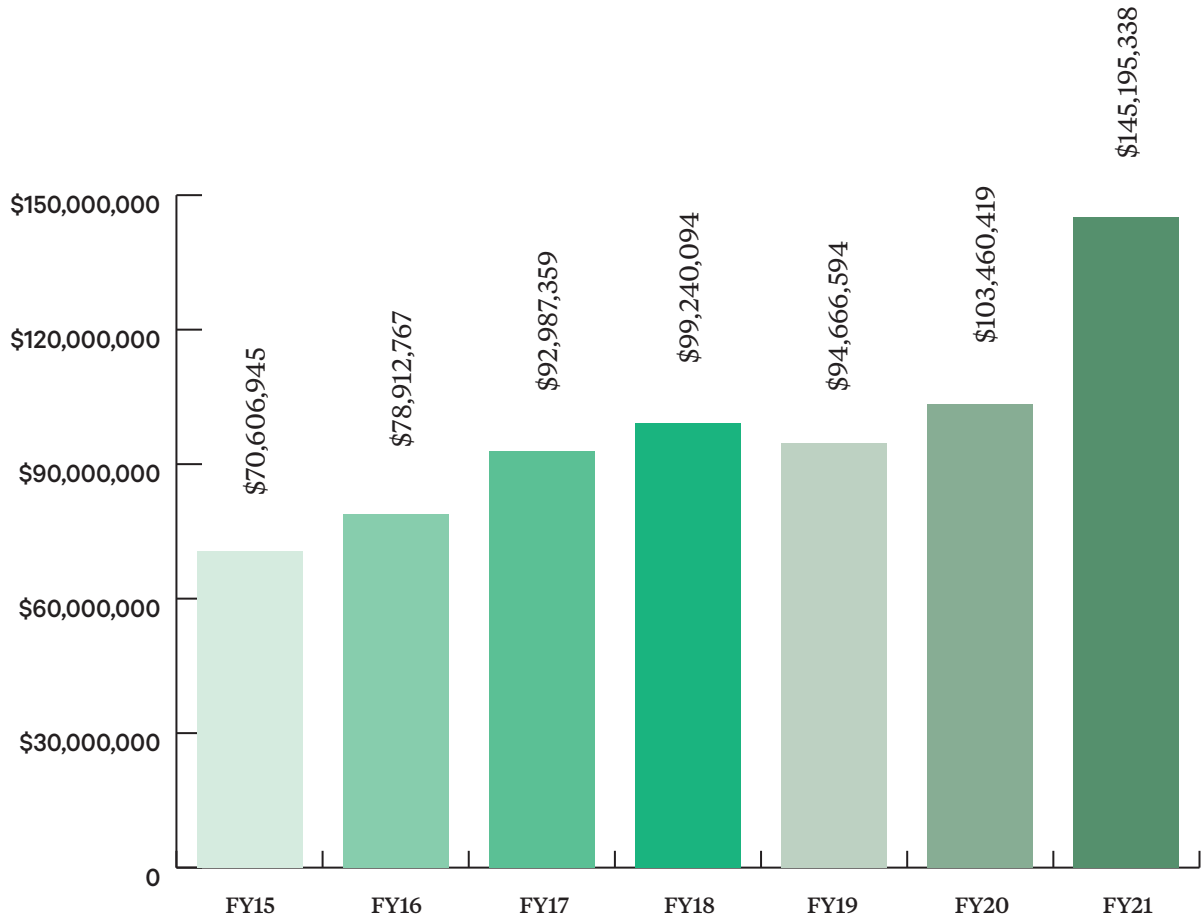
